## Second slip at Brookby fill site damages environment



P&I Pascoe's managed fill site in Brookby has suspended operations while it cleans up another large landslide.

A second large landslide at P&I Pascoe's fill site on Twilight Road, Brookby, has resulted in what Auckland Council is terming "environmental impact".

The latest slip happened early this month. An Auckland Council spokesperson says:

"We have visited the Twilight Road managed fill site to assess the slip, and spoken with the consent holder. It is a large slip which will have an environmental impact, including on the stream at the edge of site."

The steep filling site experienced an earlier slip in 2018, which was attributed to high water content in the fill material at the site. The site was closed for a number of months while repair work took place and experts recommended a number of measures be implemented to ensure future stability of the site.

In June this year, local resident Brett Maclean alerted Pascoes and Auckland Council after noticing further slippage at

the site. Brett also raised a concern that the fill site seemed to have a steeper gradient than that recommended by geotechnical experts following the previous slip.

Council says it is now working with P&I Pascoe to ensure the effects of the current slip are minimised.

"The consent holder has already stopped filling works, and begun remedial works. We are ensuring they put erosion and sediment controls in place in a timely manner.

"We will be bringing in a specialist to help assess the impact on the stream. The consent holder is also required to get their own geotechnical and specialist assessments.

"We will be increasing visits to the site while this work is in progress, and the incident is currently being reviewed for enforcement."

Guest editorial

If I had been told at the start of 2020 what the year would bring, I would have been disbelieving. Auckland Council was in a strong financial position and was set to deliver a record capital program. We started the year with a pretty good summer. The hot, dry weather was nice for a few weeks, but then the consequences started to bite. Water tanks and bores ran dry, pasture growth slowed and then stopped, and it just wouldn't rain. It took a serious toll on our communities. Tank water suppliers were struggling to meet the demand, making the situation even more challenging. Auckland Council's Healthy Waters stepped in and managed bulk tanker delivery to sites. This peaked at 1.4 million liters a day. Tanker drivers were overwhelmed by the kindness they received from our communities during that time. It meant a lot.

The Hūnua dams supply around 80% of our stored water, and their levels are still 20% below where they need to be to ensure resilience over the summer months.

Water restrictions will be with us for a while yet and are likely to continue throughout summer.

If you are on tank water, as many of us in Eastern Franklin are, please think about adding to your storage capacity. Another tank may be a really good idea.

Council has scrapped resource consent fees for the installation of rainwater tanks at residential properties. The tanks come in all shapes and sizes and can be fitted under the eave of a house or at the back of a garage. Get some advice about filtration systems so that your family stays healthy.

The other challenge brought on by 2020 has of course been Covid-19.

Looking around the world, New Zealand has done well by comparison. Yes, many of us are hurting. Our businesses have taken big hits and unemployment is growing.

No one can predict how this is going to play out, or how long it will last, but all we can do is be vigilant and look after those around us.

We can take strength in our families, our friends, and our communities. Take the opportunity to support local.

There has been plenty said about Auckland Council's Emergency Budget. The decision to increase rates by 3.5% came down to a few critical points.

We saw a \$525 million drop in revenue as a result of Covid-19. And then the cost of building more resilience into the water supply system came in at \$224 million.

We have deferred some of our projects and extended our debt provisioning for one year.

There have been significant reductions in staff numbers, and many of our staff and elected members have taken voluntary salary reductions. We have kept the capital program as complete as possible, as we have an important part to play in Auckland's economic rebuild.

I'm in my seventh year as councillor, my fourth as Deputy Mayor, and this Emergency Budget has been the toughest decision I have had to make. I'm happy to talk through the process with those who might be interested; feel free to get in touch.

Neighbour and Brookby Environment Protection Society (BEPS) chair Rebecca Stirrup says the latest slip is "deeply concerning".

BEPS opposed Pascoe's original resource consent application in the Environment Court, stating concerns about the viability of such a steep site.

"After last year's slip, we were assured that things would be fixed and that the land would be stabilised. That clearly hasn't happened, and now our environment is wearing the impact," says Rebecca.

"It's worrying that this latest slip has occurred in the absence of any significant rainfall - what will happen if we get a decent downpour? We're rapidly losing

faith in council's ability to ensure the site is safe and compliant."

While remedial work is undertaken at the site, P&I Pascoe is likely to rely on its North Road site to collect fill.

Auckland Council says they will be checking truck logs of all movements to and from the North Road site "to ensure they comply fully."

# Referendums to be discussed at information evening

Hear both sides of the argument for the two referendums being voted on at this year's general election, at a community information evening in Beachlands next week.

The Beachlands Baptist Church is hosting the public event on Wednesday 19 August a week ahead of a Meet the Candidates evening on Wednesday 26 August.

As well as choosing a government at this year's September election, people will be asked to vote on the cannabis legalisation and control bill and the end of life choice bill.

"We recognise the seriousness of these issues and wanted to bring them before the community with informed speakers presenting both sides of each topic," says convenor pastor Neil Hamilton.

"These are both really important issues and I believe that the decisions we make regarding the referendums will be an indelible and defining moment in our history."

Counsellor and psychologist Aaron Ironside as well as a pro-cannabis reform representative will speak on the cannabis legalisation bill.

End of Life Choice Society chairperson Dr Mary Panko and GP Dr Michael Drain will speak about assisted dying.

The following week each candidate standing in the Papakura electorate, which now includes the Pohutukawa Coast, has been invited to speak at a Meet the Candidates evening.

They represent five parties including sitting MP and National party leader Judith Collins, Labour candidate Anahila Kanongata'a-Suisuiki, Act candidate Bruce Whitehead, New Conservative candidate David Arvidson and The Outdoors Party candidate Teena Smith.

"It's an opportunity for the community to engage in making an informed choice as New Zealand faces decisions relating to our economic recovery which will be pivotal to our future," says Neil.

The church has hosted Meet the Candidate evenings for every general election held over the past 18 years.

Each candidate will speak and there will be a time for questions from the audience.

Both meetings start at 7pm at Beachlands Baptist Church, 59 Third View Ave.

Throughout August the *PC Times* is publishing interviews with all local candidates.

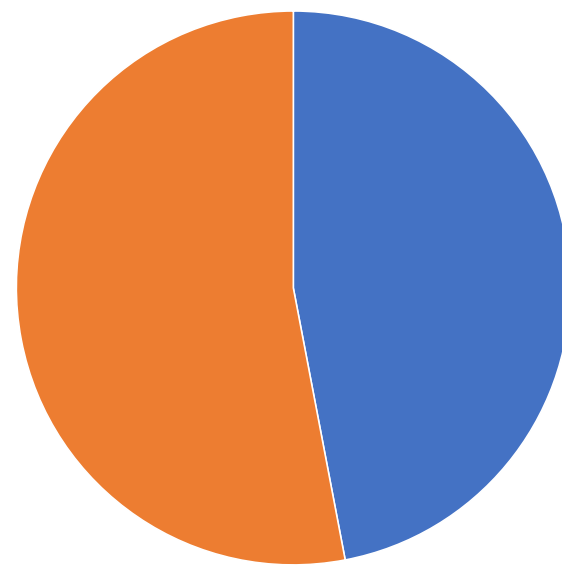
**Right: Results of a Pohutukawa Coast Times Facebook poll, asking if residents planned to vote for or against the legalisation of cannabis.**

# Election Special: an interview with Labour's Anahila Kanongata'a-Suisuiki

## Tell us a bit about yourself:

I was born in Tonga, and moved to New Zealand in 1980. We lived in a state house in Onehunga, and I attended intermediate and high school in Onehunga. I've lived most of my life in Onehunga, and still attend the same methodist church I joined when I first arrived in New Zealand. So you could say my turangawaewae in New Zealand is in Onehunga.

I have 5 children, it's a blended family from my second marriage, and 7 grandchildren. Our youngest child is 15, and she is the only one still at home.

After leaving high school, I started my working life at the ASB. Then I moved to a cadet position within the mailroom at the Department of Social Welfare before being promoted to a clerk.

When I was almost 30, I was offered two scholarships - one to study economics at the University of Auckland, and the other to study social work.

With my experience working at Social Welfare, I knew that was where my heart was so I worked full time and studied after work to first gain a diploma in social work at Auckland Teachers Training College, followed by a Bachelor's degree in social work at the University of Auckland.

I became a Youth Justice manager with Children, Young Person and Families in 2007. In 2008 the government changed from Labour to National and I began to question: "Who makes the laws in this country?"

I felt strongly connected to Labour's values of respect and dignity being afforded to all people.

My parents are migrants. They came here to work, but also expected they would be shown respect for who they were.

My family is now living the kiwi dream, owning their own home and pursuing careers. We need to make sure others have the same, that they can also live the kiwi dream.

**If you win the Papakura electorate seat in this year's election, what are your broader goals for the electorate over the next 3 years?**

My goal is to be more informed about what the government is doing, and making sure that the Papakura electorate can benefit from the government's policies. It's about saying "what does

it look like locally?". Being on the government back bench, I have access to the government ministers which is something that can really benefit the people within my electorate. For example I was in church recently and we were discussing how the church could implement Covid tracing - I texted the prime minister with a suggestion, and she rang me back to say she was discussing it with her team. Having that immediate access to decision-makers means that if I'm elected, I'm really in a position to help people.

**What are the key issues you think are important to residents living in the eastern rural and coastal settlements of the Papakura electorate?**

I don't hear a lot from people in the Pohutukawa Coast or rural Clevedon areas. The issues there are not as immediate as some other areas of the electorate. But the government is doing a lot to help all the people of the Papakura electorate.

**How do you see yourself making headway with these issues?**

Now our focus is on the economic response to Covid 19, which is a 5-point plan that aims to support people, create jobs, support small to medium businesses, setting New Zealand up as a trading nation and positioning ourselves globally. All this is underway already, and we plan to continue to do this.

**The issues experienced by residents of Papakura township are likely to be quite different to issues experienced by Pohutukawa Coast and rural residents. How do you plan to keep everyone happy?**

We all go to the same hospital - and Labour has invested in developing Middlemore. In our support plan we talk about creating jobs. Locally that means we are looking at jobs for migrant workers, fruit picking etc. We are implementing retraining programmes, and we are focussed on shovel-ready projects to create jobs for people living within the Papakura electorate. We know the new Mill Road extension will provide easier access for people to jobs, as well as the electrification of rail to Pukekohe.

**A high school is something our area needs. Hundreds of local children travel along our dangerous roads each day to access secondary schools in east-Auckland and the city. Do you think you can convince the MOE that it is time to secure land and start**

# Election Special: an interview with Labour's Anahila Kanongata'a-Suisuiki

## planning a high school for our area?

I have discussed the issue of the need for a high school with Papakura High School principal John Ross. His view is that the support of the Clevedon and Hunua communities can help lift the school. I've also enquired with the Ministry of Education about their future plans for a high school somewhere within the Pohutukawa Coast/Clevedon areas and I'm waiting to hear back from them. I really encourage locals to meet with their local MP - either the incumbent [Judith Collins] or bring your issues and solutions to me, and I will take it to the minister.

## How would you describe your relationship with Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki, and how do you plan to honour the principles of Te Tiriti by working with them in future?

I haven't engaged with Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki yet, but I spoke on the second reading of their settlement bill. When we came into government, Jacinda Ardern and Kelvin Davis created a new portfolio for Maori-Crown relationships, aimed at creating opportunities for mana whenua with Maori-led

solutions. This means I'm committed to engaging with local iwi, and I want to visit the 16 crucial sites Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki got back as part of their \$12.7m redress.

## What Labour policies are most likely to provide opportunities and benefits to residents of the Pohutukawa Coast, Clevedon and Hunua areas?

Labour's responsible economic management prior to Covid-19 means we've been able to act swiftly and decisively to make considerable investment in our health response, support businesses, cushion the blow for households, and open the economy more quickly than expected. We went in with lower debt and we'll come out of this with lower debt than comparable countries.

## Should residents expect to see you door-knocking in the area any time soon, and/or are you offering any opportunities for people to meet with you?

Yes I'll be door knocking! We door knock as part of a team of volunteers, so people might get to meet either my-

self or another Labour representative. There are also 3 meet-the-candidates meetings planned.

## Can you give a brief outline of the key measures the Labour Party is adopting/would adopt to address one of Aotearoa's largest immediate challenges - Covid-19 and climate change?

### Covid-19:

Just as we did with our strong health response, we went hard and early with our economic response to Covid 19. This means our economy is doing better than expected and is more open than nearly anywhere else in the world.

### Climate Change:

We have set a target of net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050, with legally binding emissions reduction targets, and carbon budgets to keep New Zealand on track to this goal. We will establish an independent Climate Commission to recommend interim emissions reduction targets and provide advice on the ramifications of not achieving them. We want to encourage young people to take part in the effort to end our climate pollution though a

Youth Climate Change Challenge. And we'll show government leadership by requiring state-owned enterprises and other government organisations to actively pursue low-carbon options and technologies, including all future purchases of all Government vehicle fleets to be electric vehicles unless there is an exceptional reason otherwise.

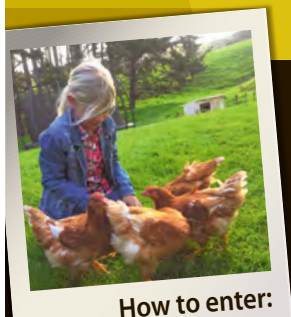

# Foodie Guide

## Mmmmmmm... Moussaka

- foodbox.co.nz

Moussaka is well worth the effort, and it easily freezes too. A large jar of pre-prepared tomato pasta sauce can be used to replace the homemade version below - obviously homemade is best! Serves 6.

### Tomato sauce reduction

- 1.5 onions
- 2 garlic cloves
- 3/4 cup olives
- 4-5 diced tomatoes (or 2 cans of tinned tomatoes)
- 1 Tbsp tomato paste
- 1/2 glass red wine
- 1 tsp cinnamon, 1/2 tsp nutmeg, 1 tsp oregano
- 2 eggplants
- 500g lamb mince
- 1/2 cup of breadcrumbs

### Cheese sauce topping

- 50g butter
- 1/4 cup of flour
- 3 cups of yoghurt
- 1 cup of tasty cheese
- A pinch of nutmeg
- 3 beaten eggs

### Method

1. In a heavy bottom pot fry onions and garlic. Add diced tomatoes and reduce over medium heat for 30-40 mins
2. Meanwhile prepare the eggplant by slicing lengthways into 1 cm thick slices. Lightly dab oil on the slices and sprinkle over a little salt. Grill for 5 mins each side until lightly brown (don't use more than 1 tsp salt for 1 eggplant)
3. To the tomato reduction add olives, spices and tomato paste
4. Fry the lamb mince in a separate pan for 2-5 mins and add to the tomato reduction then add the red wine to taste
5. Now it is time to start layering: In a casserole dish start with a layer of eggplant then lamb tomato, eggplant, lamb, tomato and finally eggplant.
6. Prepare the cheese sauce - melt butter and whisk in flour, then add yoghurt, cheese, salt & nutmeg then fold in the beaten eggs.
7. Pour the cheese sauce over the whole dish.
8. Sprinkle over bread crumbs and a layer of grated tasty cheese.
9. Bake for 40-50 minutes at 180°C.

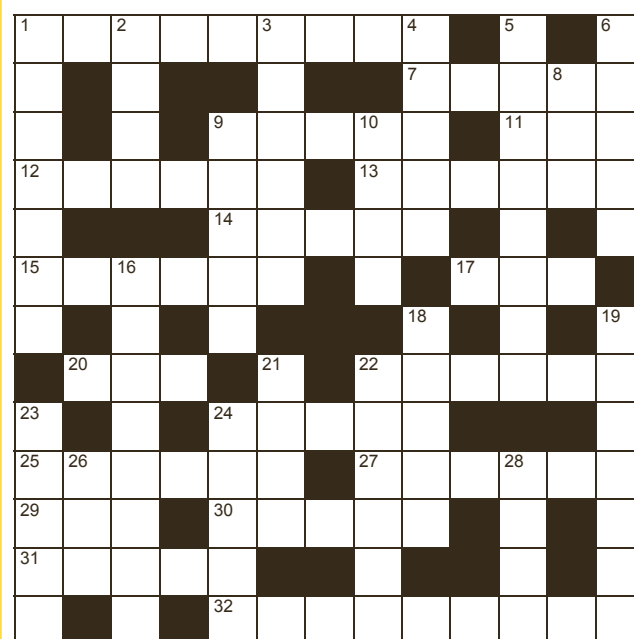

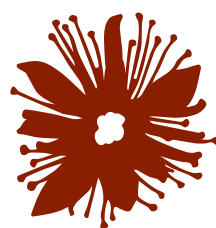
