Guest editorial

It’s hard to say where the year has gone, but here we are. For a small club, we have been busy, running events like the Trolley Derby and the Fun Run, which are now part of the community social calendar. We introduced a photographic exhibition aimed at young people. This was a great success, with 50 entries. We hope to do something similar next year, depending on funding. The competition held in July neatly fits between our other events - October for the Fun Run and March for the Trolley Derby. With all the outside sports events taking place in Beachlands and Maraetai over summer we are squeezed for dates to hold the Trolley Derby during this busy time. As a consequence the Trolley Derby will now be held on the 8 March.

In winter we held a series of open speaker events, which have been well supported. Themes have included sustainability, environment, mental health and motivation. Paintings and environmental talks have been arranged with local schools.

For those that may not know the history, Rotary was founded in America in 1908. One of its primary objectives was to stamp out polio. By working with other agencies, polio is now endemic in only two countries in the world - Pakistan and Afghanistan. Rotary Stamp Out Polio day was held on 24 October, and our club raised \$750 to go towards the cause. Thanks to the Bill Gates Foundation matching the money raised 2:1, this was effectively \$1500.

Our club is one of 51 clubs across Auckland. We can draw on a wealth of experience and the ability to link with other clubs. This means we can work on projects with a similar end. Our club, in conjunction with other clubs in Auckland and the Harold Thomas Rotary Trust, is donating \$24,000 to Hugo Donaldson and his family to help them travel to the USA for medical treatment.

Final accounts for the 2024 year are still being calculated. Once finalised, next year a similar process will be used to distribute funds within the local community. Demands on the fund have grown - last year we dispensed \$20,000, yet the demand was over \$70,000. If your community group is requesting funding this year, please bear this in mind.

I don’t want to sound like a cracked record, but we do need people to step up and come on board as members. Without volunteers, clubs like Rotary will founder and the community will need to think about whether Rotary adds to the richness of our community.

Two long-standing members of Rotary, Brian and Heather Brooke, are sadly retiring from the club after many years of service. We are fortunate that two community leaders are stepping up to the plate to take their place, namely Beachlands Chartered Club President Darryl Good, and Maraetai Beach School Principal Lou Reddy. Their links within the community will be invaluable.

There are a couple of areas where we could do with some more help, including social media and organisational skills, particularly around events. You don’t need to be a member of the club, and the tasks are not onerous.

Coastal Treasures crowned best op shop in Aotearoa

A small, community-run second-hand store in Beachlands has just won ‘Top Op Shop of the Year’.

After making it to the top 6 finalists, last weekend Coastal Treasures was officially announced the Top Op Shop in New Zealand in a national competition run by Op Shopping NZ and Thrift Insider, two online op-shop communities with a combined membership of more than 90,000 passionate thrifters.

Coastal Treasures, which is run by volunteers under the umbrella of the Takutai Charitable Trust, received the most nominations from its local community.

“We couldn’t believe we were in the top 6, let alone to win it,” says Takutai Trust spokesperson Stephanie Pollard. “We absolutely felt our community support and love which is what got us here. Our volunteers are extremely proud that all our work is appreciated. We remain passionate about supporting our community.”

Feedback from voters showed just how much the store means to locals:

“All of the volunteers are amazing and I always feel at home.”

“More than just an op shop — it’s a meeting place, a community space, and everyone is welcome.”

“A gem in our community.”

“Serving the community with kindness and giving joy to their customers.”

“Love the ladies at CT - always there for

a chat and an encouraging word.”

Stephanie says Coastal Treasures belongs to the community, with all profits from the store returned to community initiatives.

“We are entirely volunteer run, able to respond to our community needs at the drop of a hat and work hard to keep donations out of landfill by working with other charities and groups. No big skip bins for us! We currently keep 97% out of landfill, exceeding our 95% target,” says Stephanie.

Second-hand shopping has surged in popularity in recent years due to a number of reasons. The rising cost of living, a desire for more sustainable, conscious shopping, a shift in perception - op shopping is now trendy rather than a sign of hardship, and a new generation of younger shoppers embracing unique styles have all helped bring new customers through the door.

The store boasts a team of around 30 volunteers aged from 14 to over 80. Stephanie says the store’s success belongs to Beachlands just as much as to its volunteers.

“We rely entirely on local donations and local volunteers. Our customer base has grown year on year, and we consider many regulars as friends. We get so much support managing donations during tricky times.”

Vector begins undergrounding power on Maraetai Coast Rd

Vector has started work on a \$14 million upgrade to the local electricity network, designed to improve resilience and reliability for people in Maraetai, Beachlands, and Waiheke. By putting the lines along the Maraetai coastline underground, Vector says it will make the local supply more reliable and ready to support future growth in the area.

The work will happen in stages through to mid 2026, with pauses over the Christmas period and around local events like the GJ Gardiner Half Marathon on 1 March. Temporary traffic management will be in place to keep crews and other road users safe.

The first stage is underway along a section of North Road near Umupuia, and this will run until 19 December. After pausing over the Christmas and summer period, the work around Umupuia will carry on in January and February 2026.

Following the GJ Gardiner Half Marathon on 1 March 2026, significant work will begin along Maraetai Coast Road, drilling under the road surface in sections and installing the new cable. Vector spokesperson Matthew Britton says they are still confirming traffic management plans with Auckland Transport, but plan to fully close the Maraetai Coast Road to vehicle traffic from March through to mid

2026, to enable the work to be done safely.

“We want to minimise the inconvenience this will cause locals so we’ll provide details in advance so people can plan ahead,” says Britton.

“We’ve also worked with the Franklin Local Board to ensure that, while the road will be closed to vehicle traffic, we’ll maintain safe access past the work site for pedestrians and cyclists, so they can enjoy the coastal road at a time where vehicle traffic will be much reduced.

“Our goal is to make this significant project as easy as possible for the

community, so we’ll share information about what to expect, for example through signage letting people know when and where traffic management will be in place. If temporary power outages are needed for safety reasons, we’ll let people know in advance so they can plan ahead.”

Plan Change 120 - does it affect you?

Public consultation is underway on Plan Change 120, a controversial council proposal which would allow for greater housing intensification, particularly around major transport hub areas.

Government has told Auckland Council it must find a way to build up to two million additional homes in the coming decades and beyond. Auckland Council recently voted to approve a new housing intensification plan - Plan Change 120 - which will allow 10-15 storey high rises to be built around public transport hubs.

While most of the focus surrounds transport hub areas, Plan Change 120 also restricts the development of about 12,000 properties at risk from floods and landslides - affecting some homes on the Pōhutukawa Coast, and in Clevedon, Whitford and surrounding areas.

Franklin Local Board deputy chair Amanda Hopkins says the board is still coming to grips with what Plan Change 120 means for the Coast and surrounds, but that she has already heard from residents whose properties could be affected by the changes.

Amanda suggests the best way for people to check whether their property is affected, is by using the Plan Change 120 (PC120) property viewer tool. The tool is an online

map viewer from Auckland Council that provides a property-specific summary of proposed changes to the Unitary Plan.

To use it, you zoom in on a property, click it, and a summary box appears showing details on zoning, management layers, and any specific qualifying matters or natural hazard risks that apply to that property. This tool helps users understand how PC120, which includes housing intensification and natural hazard rules, might affect their property.

The risk of natural hazards, identified by the PC120 tool, means that properties within natural hazard zones could still be developed, but could need additional assessments and experts to meet new requirements.

Properties newly identified as having natural hazards could also be subject to increased insurance premiums.

There is still time for residents to let Auckland Council know what they think of Plan Change 120 - submissions are open until 5pm, Friday 19 December.

Kawakawa Bay's weka mural to be replaced

Kawakawa Bay locals were saddened last week by the loss of their beloved weka mural from one of the Bay’s public toilets.

The mural was painted in 2021 by artist Natasha King, in association with Kawakawa Bay’s ‘Weka Watch’ group which has now disbanded. The mural was supported with funding from the Franklin Local Board.

Natasha said at the time that the mural was inspired by wanting to give Kawakawa Bay’s weka a voice, and to warn the public about watching out for the endangered birds on the roads.

Last week Auckland Council contractors painted over the mural, prompting outrage from local residents on social media.

Franklin Local Board deputy chair Amanda Hopkins says a new mural is planned for the wall. In a Facebook post comment, Amanda said: “The mural was unfortunately damaged. They tried to find the original artist but had no joy. A new mural will be painted shortly by an artist from Maraetai. It will look pretty special again soon.”

Summer holidays sorted at Te Puru Community Centre

Te Puru Community Centre is getting ready for a summer holiday programme designed to keep children active, social and involved in a wide range of experiences. 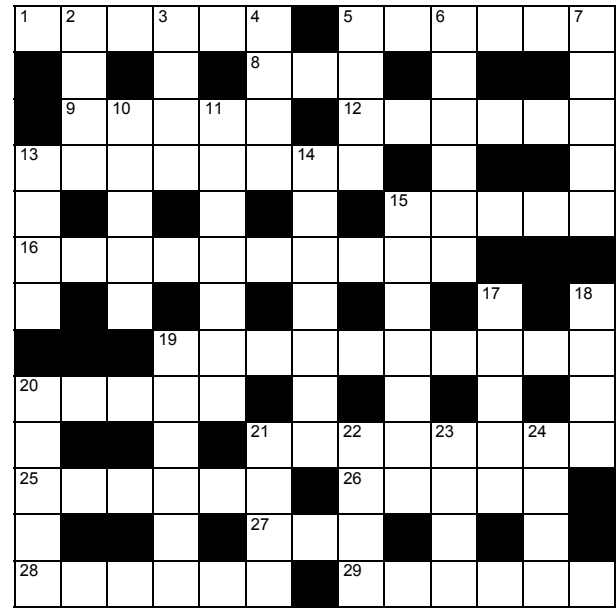

Full-day hours run from 7:30am to 6:00pm, with part-day care available from 8:30am to 3:30pm.

Local families who attended previous programmes have shared positive feedback about their experience. One parent said: “It was the first time at a holiday programme and I was worried about how they would find it. They were so happy and loved it. Staff were amazing and welcomed them in ... win win!” Another caregiver shared: “My kids came home very excited to tell me about their day. They wished they chose more days. We will definitely be back next holidays.”

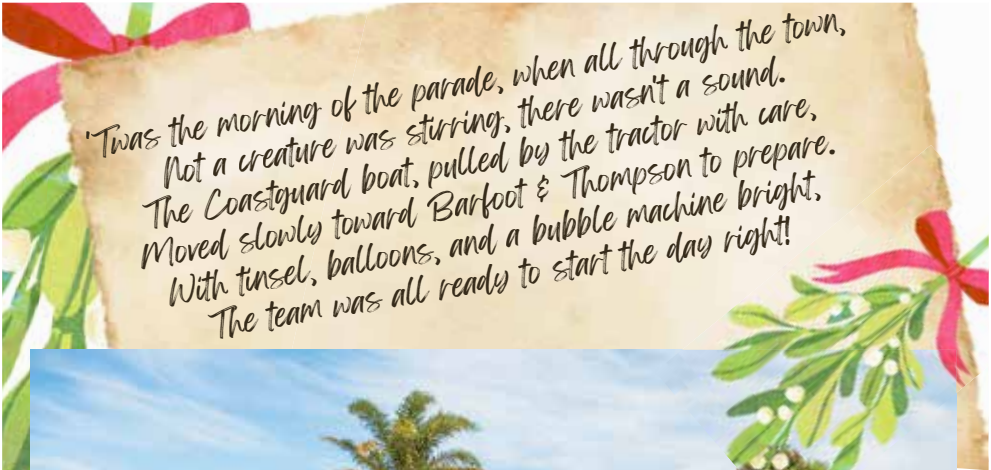

Hauraki Gulf enters fire season

All islands of the Hauraki Gulf will move to a prohibited fire season from 8am Monday, 1 December 2025 until further notice.

This includes the populated islands of Waiheke, Great Barrier, Rakino, Kawau and Ponui as well all other islands in the Gulf.

A prohibited fire season means no fires are allowed in the open air and all fire permits are suspended.

Declaring the prohibited season, Fire and Emergency New Zealand’s District Manager for Counties Manukau, Geoff Purcell, says forecast dry north westerly winds and above average temperatures could combine to significantly escalate fire dangers on the islands.

“With the temperature increasing, scrub and grasses will start drying out quickly. Combined with periods of extended warm, dry spells, there’s a high risk of wildfires occurring and spreading fast.”
