Community champion acknowledged with award

Charne Pairama is a familiar face on the local sports scene, and this month her outstanding service to young people on the Pōhutukawa Coast was recognised when she was presented with the I AM HOPE Community Hero Award.

Charne grew up in Beachlands and began coaching at just 14 years old. Since then, her community involvement has included coaching netball and touch rugby at Beachlands School and Howick College, coaching for the Pōhutukawa Coast Netball Club, founding Elementz Coast Sports Club in 2017, co-founding Elementz Motorsportz NZ, and serving on the Pohutukawa Coast Touch Committee which runs the largest single-night touch module in New Zealand.

Charne also sponsors local youth so they can participate in sport without financial barriers and supports local initiatives through her business, Cargo Coordinators.

The I AM HOPE award ceremony was held at Te Puru Community Centre, hosted by Sport & Recreation Manager Shante Cameron and Lanessa Siteine, Secretary of the Pōhutukawa Coast Netball Club. Catering was provided by Whitford's Lime Tree Café.

In a unique tribute, local youth were the only ones invited to take the stage, where they spoke of Charne's mentorship, encouragement and influence on their lives. Speeches were delivered by Laniea Richards, Ty Wade, Zara Dilworth, Breann Higgnett-Morgan, Kyra Matson, Elijah Matson, and Charne's children Carlos and Caitlyn Chesnutt.

During the ceremony I AM HOPE founder Mike King presented Charne with a pounamu (greenstone) in recognition of her service to youth. He also acknowledged her leadership, saying: "I always judge leaders in the community by the way young people speak about them and the way they speak publicly, and you [Charne] have something very special.

"Out of the hundreds of people selected, you were an easy winner."

With the dust settling on the local body elections, normal transmission in regard to council business has quickly resumed. Congratulations to Alan Cole and Amanda Hopkins being elected as Chair and Deputy Chair of the Franklin Local Board respectively. Obviously, I know them well and have worked with them previously on the Local Board and last term so I know we will continue to work closely and positively.

Over the next year in particular there are some transformational things happening in both the delivery of infrastructure and transport so I am really privileged to have been asked by the Mayor to chair the Transport & Infrastructure Delivery Committee, which like the similar committee I chaired last term, is a committee of all councillors and has oversight and responsibility for the nearly \$4bill capital investment budget.

In 2026 the CRL will finally be completed and open for business, work will continue on the Eastern Busway and other improvements to public transport including better buses in areas where the trains do not reach and ferry services.

These changes though are costly and must meet NZTA thresholds for the 51% Government funding, meaning

they can take longer to get in place due to competing priorities. The big piece of work that is going to take up a lot of my time is the proposed changes to Auckland Transport. Recently, the Mayor, myself and senior staff presented to the Transport Reform Select Committee for an hour in response to the initial Transport Reform Bill taken through Parliament. In general we support the Bill and the intent to bring political accountability to transport decision making, however do think the Bill goes a little too far in some areas such as prescribing the roles Local Boards have in transport decisions and the power of the Minister of Transport in certain things which actually removes the ability of those elected by Aucklanders to control some important things.

Using my 12 years on the Local Board and more recent time of the Board of AT, I believe Local Boards must have control over a range of things but those things should be determined by the Governing Body in consultation with Local Boards as we do for other things within Council and not through an inflexible paragraph in the legislation.

Whatever way the Government go, Local Boards and local communities will have a far greater say in what happens in many parts of the transport world in Auckland. One of the features of the change will be the creation of an Auckland Regional Transport Committee with some important responsibilities. The ARTC will have an independent Chair appointed by the Minister and Mayor and equal representation from Government and Council. I will be one of those members and am looking forward to that. Despite the rhetoric, not all is broken at AT and we now have a responsibility to ensure what comes next is an enhancement of what we have. That will ultimately be determined by the Government and final legislation. I just hope they have listened carefully and understand the risks involved.

Coast community pitches in to raise funds for Hugo

The Coast community has shown up in full force for the Donaldson family, helping raise funds for 11-year-old Hugo Donaldson to travel to the USA to participate in a special CAR T cell therapy clinical trial to treat a rare and aggressive

Pop up art galleries, a designer clothing sale and a market day have all contributed to the kitty, and recently it was Beachlands Maraetai Rugby Club's turn to show their support.

BMRC president James Gemmell says: "After hearing about the updated funds our mate Hugo required for treatment overseas it got me thinking what we as the local rugby club could do to help."

Earlier this year NZ Rugby sent some All Blacks to BMRC to interact and meet with local players. While they were there, the All Blacks presented the club with two signed jerseys - a framed one for the wall, plus one other.

"I thought this could be a great thing to raffle off to generate some money for Hugo," says James.

On the very same day, Shane from Pro Water, a sponsor of the club's Mako Touch team, phoned with another idea: why not run one of the club's popular community car washes and donate the proceeds? Pro Water offered to supply the water and services at no cost.



Watercare wraps up record Hūnua planting season

About half a million native trees have gone in the ground this winter as Watercare's Hūnua Regeneration programme ramps up with its biggest planting season to date.

Watercare headworks manager James Talbot says the programme is one of the country's biggest native planting initiatives.

"We're progressively restoring around 2200 hectares of former forestry land in our dam catchments and planting millions of native trees.

"The Hunua Ranges are home to some of Auckland's most important water sources. Our four dams here supply about two thirds of the city's drinking water, so back in 2017 we acquired the forestry right to give us more control over the activities in our catchments."

James says forestry activities on the slopes of the catchment area make the land more vulnerable to slips, which can affect reservoir water quality.

"We really felt the impact of this during the Tasman Tempest storm in 2017, when hundreds of landslips sent clay into our water supply dams and made the water much more difficult to treat."

While no more pines will be planted, some areas of the forest will be harvested as the existing pine trees mature. Watercare then regenerates the harvested area with natives over the planting season in winter.

"This has been our biggest planting season to date by a long way. Up until this season, we had planted around 570,000 trees in total, but no more than 300,000 in a season.

"This year we have had a far bigger area to cover – about 70 hectares – so it's really exciting to have planted half a million trees in one push. This takes our total so far to over a million trees planted.

outstanding job – planting about 75,000 plants a week."

The plants include mānuka, kanuka and a mix of other species including hebe, māhoe, karamū, makomako, tī kōuka (cabbage tree), puahou (five finger), rewarewa and kahikatea. The plants were grown from seeds eco-sourced from the existing native vegetation growing in the area, and were cultivated at a west "The planting crew has done an Auckland nursery until they were ready

to go in the ground.

"This ensures we are replicating the natural state of the forest as much as possible," says James.

The regeneration programme is expected to continue until about 2035 when the last remaining pine trees in the catchments are expected to have been harvested. The area will then be opened to the public for everyone to enjoy.

Advice from Franklin Vets: avoiding heat stroke in dogs

Throughout the summer, our clinic sees several dogs from the Pōhutukawa Coast with heatstroke. This condition occurs when a dog's body temperature climbs beyond safe levels, and it can no longer cool itself effectively. Dogs can't sweat, so they rely on panting and some heat release through their paw pads. When this isn't enough, their overheating can quickly become lifethreatening. Organ failure, neurological damage, respiratory distress, and death can occur within hours. Quick recognition and intervention saves lives.

Prevention is far easier than treatment. People should avoid leaving their dogs in cars, even on mild days. As we get into summer, midday walks are risky. Strenuous play or running in hot, humid conditions should be avoided, and dogs should never be confined in poorly ventilated spaces such as garages or sheds.

Owners often ask when it is too hot to walk their dogs. As a general rule, exercise should be limited once temperatures exceed 25 degrees Celsius, and above 30 degrees it is unsafe for most dogs. A simple test is to place your hand on the pavement; if it is too hot to touch for five seconds. it is too hot for paws.



Some breeds are particularly vulnerable. Short-nosed breeds such as bulldogs, pugs, and boxers struggle to breathe efficiently and are at higher risk. Large breeds like labradors, golden retrievers, and German shepherds, as well as thick-coated dogs such as huskies and Malamutes, are also more susceptible. Overweight or elderly dogs are at much greater risk.

If heat stroke is suspected, immediate action is critical before coming into our clinic. Recent research now recommends rapid cooling with cold water immersion as the first and most effective step, if you can. Studies show that cooling before transport to the vet significantly improves survival. Owners should move the dog to a shaded area and immerse or soak them with cool tap water, ideally between 15 and 22 degrees. This approach is now considered the gold standard, replacing older advice that warned against cold

water baths. Small amounts of cool water can be offered to drink, but vet care should be sought urgently, even if your dog appears to improve, as internal damage may already be present.

By avoiding hot walks, knowing which dogs are most at risk, and acting immediately if symptoms appear, owners can protect their pets from one of the most preventable yet deadly emergencies.



- If it's already happened, use 105.
- 105 incidents can be reported online, which can save you time. Go to 105. police.govt.nz or you can call 105.



These reports can be directed to Police, Customs, Corrections or Immigration. Please note that remaining anonymous can restrict some action that Police may or can take.
