Pop-up gallery fundraiser to support Hugo's treatment

The Pōhutukawa Coast community is rallying to support eleven-year-old Hugo Donaldson, a Beachlands schoolboy currently facing a heartbreaking and lifethreatening battle with cancer.

In January 2024, Hugo was diagnosed with Stage 4 Alveolar Rhabdomyosarcoma, a rare and aggressive childhood cancer. After enduring nine rounds of highdose chemotherapy and 28 sessions of radiation, he was declared clear in August

However in March this year, while still on maintenance treatment, Hugo relapsed. Despite further chemotherapy and radiation, recent scans have shown his cancer continues to progress. In a matter of days, Hugo went from feeling sore to being unable to walk, reliant on a wheelchair, and in constant pain.

With treatment options in New Zealand now extremely limited, Hugo has been accepted into a promising CAR T cell therapy clinical trial in the United States - a therapy that may offer him the chance at remission and a future beyond hospitals and cancer wards.

Hugo's dad, Aaron Donaldson, says they have already seen encouraging signs from similar trials. "We know of at least one child with the same type of cancer who received a similar version of this treatment at the same hospital and is now in longterm remission. It gives us hope that Hugo might have that same chance."

While the treatment itself is funded, the associated medical and living costs in the U.S. total around \$500,000, which must be paid upfront. Hugo's parents, Sam and Aaron, are drawing on their KiwiSaver, selling assets, and working through every

avenue available, but they cannot meet the costs alone.

In response, the local community has stepped up to help run a fundraising Pop-Up Gallery Exhibition this November. Held at the Ray White Shed, the exhibition will feature a curated display of photographic works created by Hugo's mum, Samantha, who is a professional photographer. The

works will be divided into three themes: New Zealand landscapes, New York City street scenes, and floral still life compositions. All pieces will be available for purchase, printed on high-quality fine art photographic paper and

Country Fair provides much needed fun for Hunua, Ararimu and Paparimu valleys

The rural communities of Hūnua, Ararimu and Paparimu have been through a lot lately, fighting two proposed managed fills in recent months. But a new Country Fair at Y Camp Adair, Hūnua on 2 November brought plenty of smiles, with hundreds of families turning out to enjoy the fun.

The free event featured a large classic car display with WWII jeeps and a range of shiny American and UK vehicles plus farm tractors. There were market stalls, a live band, a baking competition, and free bouncy castles. Historic photos and memorabilia belonging to local schools, halls and community groups were displayed in the old schoolhouse.

There was a strong environmental aspect to the fair with Friends of Te Wairoa Catchment members demonstrating bait and trap methods for pests. Y Camp Adair sold native seedlings grown in their own nursery and took requests from lifestyle block owners wanting crack willows to be eradicated from their stretches of the Wairoa River, as well as replanting.

Emergency response groups were also well represented and provided advice about how to prepare for and respond to major weather events.



The Hūnua Volunteer Fire Brigade took on the Pōhutukawa Coast Community Response Team in a tug-o-war at last weekend's Country Fair.

Y Camp Adair instructors operated a giant Flying Fox and dozens of youngsters swooped over the playing field, providing an exciting backdrop to the whole event. Old fashioned games such a gumboot tossing, sack races and three-legged races were popular, but the real highlight was the tug-o-war competitions. Hūnua Volunteer Fire Brigade beat Pōhutukawa Coast Community Response Team in the best of three matches. Then they versed a mixed team of community members before the kids got into the action (aided by a couple of firefighters).

Hūnua, Ararimu, Paparimu Valley Residents Association (HAPVRA) co-chair Geraldine Schnauer says the fair was a huge success and a good distraction while residents wait to hear from Auckland Council as to when managed fills hearings will take place: "We are thrilled the Country Fair ran so well. We wanted to inject some positivity into the community, and we achieved just that thanks to the assistance of Franklin Local Board who provided us with a grant to help fund the event.

"We've had a very stressful time this year fighting the managed fills. We're very proud our small communities sent more than 500 opposition submissions to both the Paparimu and Hūnua proposals, now we're waiting to hear from Auckland Council when the hearings will take place next year."

Ararimu Residents & Ratepayers Association is also supporting HAPVRA's Paparimu anti-fill campaign which could see around 87 trucks per day travel from SH1 through the region for the next 15 years.

After so much action, HAPVRA committee members are taking a well-deserved break for a few weeks. As for talk of making the Country Fair an annual event ... it could happen. Watch this space!



New footpath planned for Rewa Road

After receiving feedback from the Maraetai community, Auckland Transport has announced it will build a new footpath on Rewa Road.

Currently, only one side of Rewa Road (from Carlton Crescent) has a footpath, which AT says can be inconvenient and unsafe for pedestrians.


AT says its plans include building out the existing kerb, with the width varying between 0.5 metres and 1 metre, to accommodate the new continuous footpath while minimising the need for significant modifications to driveways.

No trees will be removed and there will be no changes to retaining walls, however parking restrictions have been included to allow for vehicle passing opportunities.

Parking restrictions will also improve visibility at the bend near the Maraetai Hall, says AT.

AT says the changes will result in a number of community benefits, including pedestrian safety and improved access to shops, public transport, the beach and community facilities.



Letters losing priority as NZ Post scales back delivery service

The government has approved changes to a document which will allow NZ Post to reduce the number of days it offers a mail service.

The Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment said last month that changes to the Postal Deed of Understanding between the Crown and NZ Post had been approved.

The new Deed requires mail to be delivered a minimum of two days a week to urban addresses, post office boxes and private bags, and a minimum of three days a week to rural addresses, spread throughout the week.

The previous minimum was three days for urban areas and five days for rural and PO boxes.

Parcels and courier packages are not included as part of the Deed change.

The changes also mean the number of postal outlets will drop from 880 to 500, and then to 400 over four years. There will also be an increase in communal collection points over individual mailboxes.

NZ Post has faced increasing challenges operating a commercially viable business over recent years as mail volumes have declined.

The new Deed will allow NZ Post to remain commercially viable.

"Mail is an important service that we are committed to continuing to deliver," says says NZ Post Chief Executive David Walsh.

"Mail is part of our DNA, and will continue to be as long as New Zealanders continue to send letters. The changes announced to the Deed provide us with flexibility to continue making changes to bring the mail service in line with today's communication needs," says Walsh.

Walsh says the Deed change will not automatically result in operational change to NZ Post's services.

"Any operational changes will include appropriate engagement with our people and stakeholders in the first instance," says Walsh.

"For now, there is nothing that Kiwis need to do differently and their mail delivery will continue as usual. NZ Post will proactively communicate future service changes to the public, to ensure that Kiwis know exactly what they can expect from their mail service."

Rural Women New Zealand (RWNZ) says it is "deeply disappointed" at the decision to approve significant changes to NZ Post's minimum service obligations, believing it will disproportionately affect rural communities.

"These service cuts are a step backwards for rural New Zealand," says Rural Women New Zealand National President Sandra Matthews. "They will make life harder for rural people who already face longer travel times, reduced access to services




Under a new agreement, NZ Post can scale back the number of days it delivers mail each week.

and unreliable digital connectivity."

"Rural New Zealanders rely heavily on postal services, not just for mail but for medication, paying bills, receiving essential deliveries, and maintaining business operations. For many, frequent, accessible post services are a necessity."

Omana's much-loved Norfolk pine gets a careful trim, not the chop

tree, estimated at 50-80 years old, is looking a little less sad following a recent facelift.

Sited on the beachfront reserve at Omana, the pine has provided shade for picnicking families for many years - but it seems not everyone loves the triangular

In 2021, Omana resident Marcellé Roth contacted the PC Times after noticing a deep horizontal cut stretching around the tree trunk. She came to the conclusion the tree had been ringbarked. "Obviously someone didn't like it blocking their view," says Marcellé.

Marcellé's suspicions were confirmed by Auckland Council contractors who inspected the tree in February 2021 and said the long viability of the tree was uncertain.

Almost five years on, the health of the tree has further declined.



Omana's once-majestic Norfolk pine Arboriculture and Ecology Manager David Stejskal says council-appointed arborists recently removed hangers and deadwood from the tree, though the rest of the tree remains in place.

> "The tree has sustained damage in the past, through vandalism, having been ringbarked in February 2021. At the time, council arborists decided to retain as much of the tree as possible. The tree was topped by council contractors in October 2024, and the recent work was focused on ongoing maintenance and public safety," says Stejskal.

> The tree was originally a Christmas tree, dug up and gifted by a neighbour to local resident Judy Kemp's family when Judy was a child. The family used it as their Christmas tree that year, then planted it down at Omana.

> Speaking to the *PC Times* in 2021, Judy said: "I've got two sisters and the tree is special to all of us ... I'm so sad to think that someone has done this deliberately."





Council will update park users as soon as all the tracks have been cleared and checked and the park is ready to reopen.



Some of the biggest attractions of the day were definitely the rides. From spinning teacups to huge bouncy castles, screams of joy and laughter could be heard from miles away!


