Date set down for public hearing re Formosa

Auckland Council has announced the date of a hearing which will give the public a chance to have their say on Beachland South Ltd's (BSL) Private Plan Change 88 application, which seeks to develop land on and surrounding the existing Rydges Formosa Golf Resort.

The public hearing has been set down for Monday 27-Wednesday 29 November 2023 at Uxbridge Theatre, Howick. At the hearing, those who have lodged submissions supporting or opposing Plan Change 88 are invited to have their say in front of a panel of independent experts.

Private Plan Change 88 asks Auckland Council to rezone the land to enable residential development. In its application, BSL proposes that approx 160 hectares of the land would be developed immediately, while a further approx 150 hectares be rezoned as Future Urban which could be developed with lower density housing in the medium to long term, subject to future consultation and plan changes.

The development proposed under the current plan change application would more than double the size of Beachlands over the next 10-15 years.

At its most recent meeting, the Franklin Local Board documented its views about the application, which it will share with Auckland Council.

Acknowledging the application has some merits such as the potential for a local secondary school, the board also listed its concerns with the application including:

legacy council deficiencies in the area with no council managed facilities, kerb/channel and footpath gaps, and

no secondary school or emergency medical facilities. The board said that Beachlands is predominantly reliant on tank water and has grown in an ad-hoc manner with residential development, a service centre and a retirement village.

road infrastructure, noting that the application does not adequately address the increased traffic which would be generated along Whitford Maraetai Road, through Whitford Village and on to Whitford Road. The board

said "the assumptions used [in the application] are not credible." The board also pointed out that the Coast is often cut off by road closures which can also lead to power outages. The board suggested the proposed plan change should include "significant upgrades"

to Whitford Maraetai Road, as well as construction of the long-shelved Whitford Bypass. Intersection upgrades were also suggested for safety reasons, with the board saying it did not believe intersection safety had been adequately addressed in the application.

- public transport, noting that the application did not clearly articulate how new and increased ferry infrastructure and services would be provided
- water, with the board requesting that, if approved, the development connect to the Watercare wastewater treatment plant at Okaroro Drive rather than developing its own treatment plant. The board said that if approved, the plan change might offer enough scale for Watercare to complete a centralised water and wastewater scheme to benefit the wider Beachlands area. Concern about the new development relying on bore water was also noted, with further investigation recommended. The board said that providing drinking water for the additional 10-15,000 people living at the new development should require

Watercare to "lead and provide the service".

- ecology, with the board saying the effects of the development upon Waikopua Estuary and nearby native bush blocks had not been fully addressed by the application.
- visual impact of the proposed development which would be seen from a considerable distance, including the Hauraki Gulf. The board suggested that setting the development further back from the coastal edge should be considered.
- other infrastructure, such as considering how a more reliable power supply could be provided if the development goes ahead
- the development's economic benefit was scrutinised by the board, who queried whether the light industrial aspect of the application would provide enough local jobs for the increased population.

The board appointed chair Angela Fulljames to present the board's views at the November Plan Change 88 hearing.



Kindy bounces back following near-closure three years ago

Three years ago the future of Kawakawa Bay Kindergarten was uncertain, with the Counties Manukau Kindergarten Association (CMKA) wanting to close the kindergarten or turn it into a community playgroup.

Thanks to the efforts of some invested parents, the kindergarten was saved - and now it is a thriving success story.

"We are completely full with a growing waiting list," says head teacher Lisa Carlin.

Lisa says the turnaround has come from a number of younger families moving into the area, and with the majority of parents returning to work.

A new housing subdivision, currently under construction, will add further demand to the kindergarten, at which point Lisa says they may have to change the kindergarten's age group acceptance criteria from two-year-olds to three-year-olds.

"The future is now secure. We feel confident that we will continue to stay at full capacity and there will be no concerns from CMKA."

Over the last couple of years, the kindergarten has expanded its grounds to include a grassed running/play area, vegetable gardens and Wharenui. Parents have fundraised to build a new outdoor kai/food area that overlooks a stream, as well as some new swings.

Twenty children attend the kindergarten each day, and Lisa says there are always lots of great learning opportunities as children engage in the play-based programme. The four-year-olds enjoy regular nature walks to the nearby beach, and on the day the *PC Times* visited, the children were keeping a close eye on an egg incubator where a clutch of eggs was due to hatch. Later that day, a 'Keep Me Safe' programme was scheduled to teach children about stranger danger.

The kindergarten still operates as a kindergarten, finishing at 3.30pm each day. Lisa says they surveyed the community to see whether there was a demand for extended hours to 5 pm but the overwhelming response from the community was to see the kindy retain its 3.30pm closing time.

Newly-appointed Counties Manukau Kindergarten Association CEO Adam Berry says the vision for the centre is simple. "We are working hard to improve what we do each day, and aspire to create new knowledge in our community, to the betterment of current and future generations."

Lisa and her team are delighted to see things going so well. "Three years ago we would never have thought we'd be here today. Now we're full and we're all very happy."

"Every position holds pressure as each position has a different job. I definitely find goal shoot carries a lot of pressure and on court you just have to do your job, relax, and play your own game. That pressure is always going to be there, but I

find playing netball fun and I really enjoy it so I try to not focus on the pressure, and just to take deep breaths, and play my game, because at the end of the day I will try my absolute best."

Amelia says she feels honoured to be selected for the Silver Ferns.

"It is now up to me to work really hard and put my best foot forward. I am really looking forward to the challenge."


