Clevedon Presbyterian shares redevelopment plans

Big changes are on the horizon for Clevedon Presbyterian church building is constructed. Church, which is set to undergo a major transformation over the next two years. A sizeable redevelopment project will include a complete rebuild of the Clevedon Kidz Early Childhood Centre, along with the main worship space, community facilities and administration block.

The relatively small site makes expansion a challenge, but Rory says that with thoughtful design, he believes they can make good use of the space.

It has been a long time since the Ōrere Community & Boating Club (OCBC) has submitted a guest editorial article to the Pōhutukawa Coast Times. Over the last three years the OCBC has been through a number of changes, and this is now my third time being elected as Chairman. It is an honor to represent our community, in any capacity.

A lot has happened in Ōrere Point in the last four years. Our community has changed a lot for the good, with new residents, new houses and a new shop keeper.

Reading through some old minutes from the OCBC dated 2012, it is very frustrating to see the issues we raised all those years ago are still present. Nothing has changed. We have reported the issue about the condition of the public toilets at the bottom reserve on many occasions and still no action has been taken. Orere Point must have the only long drop toilets in Auckland. Our efforts to get the support of Auckland Council have ended in disappointment. Why should our community have to feel embarrassed about a public toilet that visitors, residents and travelers have to use that is not up to standard? Also on our list of needs: lighting on the bottom reserve and sealing the ring

It has been a long time since the Ōrere road, which becomes a dust bowl during Community & Boating Club (OCBC) summer and a race track for night visitors. Enough is enough.

Auckland Council have a responsibility to look after these areas and their residents, but it feels as though we are at the bottom of the table. When I read that toilets at Kawakawa Bay have been upgraded, painted and kept in good order this really demonstrates how we are treated. Through our rate system Ōrere Point residents contribute to the upkeep of Auckland City infrastructure, while our location means we are the lowest priority.

The big question is how much money has been raised through the targeted rate that all rate payers are contributing to? Is there an actual figure, who decides how the targeted rate is spent, are we expected to pay for the things we need instead of Council using the different budgets which are available from different departments within Auckland Council?

Over the years Franklin Local Board have been great supporters of our community but while having support is one thing, having actual results is a win. I know there is a lot of work to be done and I will be putting a lot of my energy into working through the list of items which have been outstanding for 13 years.

Person dies in Clevedon crash

One person died after a crash on Papakura-Clevedon Road on Thursday 24 April, when a vehicle left the road and entered a creek.

The Serious Crash Unit has examined the scene, and enquiries into the circumstances of the crash are ongoing.

I am pleased to mention the great work being done by Ōrere Point Dotterels, a group of caring and knowledgeable people who have taken up the challenge to help to increase the local dotterel population. The increased community interest in our resident New Zealand dotterel 'tuturiwhatu' here in Ōrere Point over the last 5 or so years has been the beginning of our story about "JCY" aka "Juicy", our first ever banded chick. About 5 years ago there was just one breeding pair on the main beach at Ōrere Point. Now we have 3 breeding pairs and 5 individuals.

A small volunteer group has been busy working behind the scenes, helping these birds not only survive but against all odds, successfully breeding a chick to fledgling stage the last 3 seasons. This may not sound a great deal, but with dotterel being pushed out of the shoreline habitat by human, dog and vehicle disturbance, growing populations of beach goers and a large array of predators including gulls, stoats, cats, rats and the like, successfully breeding one chick is a big deal.

These volunteers trap predators, erect fencing, make signs, educate the public and involve our school children, help with banding of chicks, keep records and report to Department of Conservation and Auckland Council. Without these community volunteers giving their time for these precious endangered taonga, dotterel numbers would certainly be declining.

Ours has been a success story, and we hope to continue our work together with our community members and volunteers, painting a brighter future for not only dotterel, but many other shorebirds that are finding it tough to survive.



Pohutukawa Coast Youth Choir founder takes a final bow

Beachlands is poised to farewell another community legend, with Rhianon Philpot moving away from the area in May.

Rhianon has voluntarily run the Pohutukawa Coast Children's Choir since 2021, and the Pohutukawa Coast Youth Choir since 2023. She has also organised and run local talent shows for children to showcase their abilities in a non-competitive atmosphere.

She says she started the Children's Choir because she could.

"I had the time, energy, expertise and support. I set out to make a fun, inclusive, accessible choir. We've always served afternoon tea, and run at no cost to families. My goal was to show kids the absolute joy of music, and how powerful that can be."

In the early days of its inception, Rhianon did not know how the choir would be received - or even if anyone would show up. She could not have predicted how it would evolve, with over 20 members each week.

She says the choir is a constant source of joy and pride.

"There have been so many memorable moments. I guess one that stands out was Christmas 2023. I wrote a song called "Meri Kirihimete" specifically for the Children's Choir, and we performed it with the combined children's and youth choirs and the adults' choir. I remember tearing up hearing the audience react when we were done."

Rhianon says she likes to think the choir has positively impacted many lives in the community, and that there is an obvious growth in confidence and skill for the choristers themselves.

"I know we've made lots of people smile at our performances. We've helped raise money for the Takutai Trust, and sung carols with the elderly in our community. I have parents tell me about moments where they've sung with their kids, and that is so precious to me."

One of those touched by Rhianon's community spirit is local resident Val Furness, who spoke to the PC Times on behalf of parents whose children attend the choir.

Val says she has seen first-hand Rhianon's passion and dedication over the past five years.

"She has a unique way of teaching the children music and singing and has brought out joy and enthusiasm in them. She has given her time voluntarily to our children each week and has brought music and singing alive allowing them to express themselves in drama and to be able to perform singing confidently at the concerts they have performed. She will be missed by us all so much and it is sad to say but she will not be replaced easily with her excellent musical talents which she has imparted so willingly each week. Thank you, Rhianon from us all. We have appreciated you so much."

As Rhianon prepares to leave the community, she hopes that the music doesn't disappear with her. The group has been searching for someone to take over, with no success so far.

Even so, Rhianon remains upbeat about her students' ability to continue. "I'd encourage everyone to keep singing, even just in the car, or with a friend. I'd also love to organise a little 'Summer tour' for the choirs. Hire a bus, and spend a few days in the central North Island working on choir skills, singing and performing." She says she is going to miss the community terribly.

"I didn't know what community was before I lived here, but I know what I want to create wherever I go because I had the privilege of living on the Coast. I will miss the kids most of all. It has been such an honour and a joy to work with you. Thank you, from every part of me, for embracing and encouraging the things that I love and want to put into this world."

Rhianon would like to leave Coasters with the lyrics of one final song she has written for her choirs:

"If there's a song in your heart Don't be afraid to sing out. If there's a sound in your soul Lift your voice and let it grow. Music is love -It connects us.

Please know that, whatever you do, It's such a joy to sing with you!"

Social group sees widowed locals find joy in new connections

The response to the group has been so good that two groups now meet monthly.

A new group aimed at connecting people The 50 to 70-year-old group meets on the first Sunday of the month at 10am at Ambrosia Cafe in Beachlands, while the 70+ age group meets the first Wednesday of the month at 10.30 at Ambrosia. The 50-70 year old group has welcomed 16 members who regularly get together for outings. So far they have attended a hypnotist comedy show, been hosted by the Maraetai Bowling Club for a game of bowls, and met at Sunkist Bar for drinks. "It's worked out really well," says the group's founder. "The more numbers we get, the more we can support local

businesses." The 70+ age group has four members so far, and welcome anyone else who is keen to join.

"We don't have to solve each other's problems, but we do learn from each other."

A mid-winter Christmas dinner is already planned, and future outings are likely to include a games night and line dancing. The group is open to ideas, and says people from out of the area are also welcome to come along to any of the regular meet-ups or events.


