Brigade benefits from Leapfrog Challenge

Locals put on their raincoats and turned out in force on Saturday 20 April, in support of an initiative to raise funds for the Kawakawa Bay Volunteer Fire Brigade.

The Leapfrog Challenge is held every four years, and is organised and hosted by luxury accommodation and venue provider, The McCallum Residence®.

“The challenge is called The Leapfrog Challenge as we do it every four years on leap year. Our goal is to provide financial assistance to volunteer organisations that we couldn’t live without,” says organiser Jan McCallum.

The previous Leapfrog Challenge was held two weeks before the first Covid lockdown in 2020, and raised funds for the Kawakawa Bay Ōre Health Clinic’s first response team.

This year, it was the local fire brigade’s turn to benefit.

“The Kawakawa Bay Fire Brigade, like all fire brigades, handle so much in our community because of the distances involved,” says Jan. “They also look after a coastal community which is exposed to floods. In March they had more call out days than not. They are first on the scene for road accidents for a very long stretch of rural road. We always see them at work. Covid put a lot of community services under pressure, and they were unable to fundraise for a few years which dried up their funds. Frankly, they needed our help to keep helping us, the community, who came out in force to help.”

This year’s challenge brought together 60 participants who competed as teams of 6 in a variety of challenges throughout the day.

One key challenge saw the fire brigade teach participants what to do when you are first on the scene at a road accident. They created a fun exercise which involved a simulated accident scene, complete with car wreck and an injured crash dummy (who earned the job by being the naughtiest participant at the 2020 challenge).

Other challenges included shooting at targets, dodgeball, darts, a golf chipping competition, brain challenge, learning a country hoedown, and hobby horse polo. Competitors also had to choreograph their own two-minute marching routine to music.

Navigating the slalom course of road holes that is the Clevedon to Ōrere Point roadway can be pretty confusing these days.

New holes seem to announce themselves overnight making the road both damaging and dangerous to local users and tourists alike.

However my confusion is that these dangers are still there, let alone multiplying as freely as they are. Over the last Council and Parliamentary elections, potholes were the visible manifestation of all that the previous administrations had screwed up.

The Browns, Mayor Wayne and Minister Simeon, revelled in the misfortunes of motorists, one railing against too much roadwork being done while the other lamented the lack of roadworks at every photo opportunity. They both won, but our roads seem to have lost every day since.

Maybe because many of us seemed to get a little confused too.

Confused into thinking that it would be a bad idea to keep improving public transport options as Auckland spreads and migration numbers soar. Thinking that safety cones (there's a clue in the name) are the problem that must be eliminated. Thinking that AT is some sort of evil empire conspiring against us all.

Salvador Dali nailed it as an election

tactic when he said "What is important is to spread confusion, not eliminate it." Staring at most Dali works shows he was a master.

And it certainly has shown no signs of being eliminated since both Browns (not related, appearances can be deceptive) and their teams assumed the roles they so keenly sought.

You would rightly be confused at different times as to just who is leading our city, the gruff, often dismissive elderly guy or the empathetic deputy mayor who gets pushed forward when ratepayers require rational responses.

Same condition pops up when you try to rationalise why the MP for our electorate seems way more engaged with celestial bodies in her role as Minister for Space than she is with the bodies who elected her. It has clearly been a long time since our MP has driven around her patch, but I'm pretty sure that some of the potholes on her roads would already be visible from space.

There's a whole lot to get confused about at the present, and I'm picking that I'm not alone in this state.


Daily we are watching hundreds of people with training and work ethics and who pay taxes losing what seem to be generally valuable jobs, the impact of which is unknown but probably predictable. We see councils across the

country simply unable to meet the water requirements of their cities and districts after rejecting a seemingly logical solution and being left high and dry by the incoming governing coalition. Many wonder why smoking needs encouraging while school lunches must be cut, both in the name of tax breaks for our poor beleaguered landlords.

Are Aucklanders going to be captive to a downtown port for the next 35 years if Council leases it offshore? Are Auckland's two big assets going to be sold so the mayor can set up a fund that's managed by the big end of town, not the Council? How can a massive housing development be approved against the wishes of the Council and most submitters? Confusing huh?

To close though, a hat tip to our Local Board for the effort they put into trying to clarify confusion over the proposed Targeted Rate for Paths in Franklin. Whether you agree with it or not, the Board's team and representatives went to considerable lengths to help ratepayers understand the concept. In doing so, they engaged their community, explained the problem and proposed options. They tried to remove the confusion. Others in powerful positions should do so too.

Olympian honoured at Howick College Alumni Awards ceremony

Beachlands-raised Olympic gold medallist Daniel Williamson was honoured at Howick College's Alumni Awards event last month.

The school's Alumni Awards are an opportunity to acknowledge and celebrate the achievements of Howick College's alumni after finishing their education at Howick College.

The awards also provide current students with a real and personal example of what is possible when you work hard.

Daniel was guest of honour at the awards, where principal Dale Burden described him as an inspiration to all students.

The 6'6" rower grew up in Beachlands where his parents, Simon and Diane Williamson, still remain. He attended Howick College from 2013-2015.

An avid athlete, he played football for Howick College as a junior, winning the eastern zone division. But in 2015 a rapid growth surge resulted in chronic shin splints and he received the challenging news from doctors that he could no longer run.

He turned his attention to rowing, undeterred by the fact that in 2014 there was no rowing team, equipment or facilities at Howick College.

"It was just me, a sole rower, who wanted to give something new a try," says Daniel. "It was my family friend turned coach Raechel Cummins who made everything

possible from there. She lent me her boat and oars, and I trained on her rowing machine in her garage. Every morning at 4.45am she would pick me up and drive us to practice, to whichever rowing club would be happy to have us. It was a really small and personal operation. That first year I jumped in boots and all."

Daniel says that from the outset, all he wanted was to go fast and win every race.

"At the time I didn't realise it was probably unrealistic. Raechel on the other hand had a different idea of what it meant to be successful that year. All she ever wanted was for me to enjoy what I was doing, every single day. So it was while I was at Howick that my passion for the sport was truly nurtured, something I've only realised many years later."

Daniel completed his secondary education at King's College, before heading to Yale University in 2019 where he joined the top varsity 8 crew. He was the first first-year oarsman to ever sit in the stroke seat in a Yale rowing boat, and he and his team went on to win the Rowing Association National University Championship that year.

His on-water performances both at Yale and in NZ saw him selected for the NZ men's 8 team, who rowed their way to a gold medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics (held in 2021 due to the pandemic).

Becoming an olympian has been a dream of Daniel's for as long as he can

remember.

"I'm not sure what logical reason motivated me towards that dream, because I wasn't athletic. I'd come last in every cross country. I'd always struggle to keep up with my mates on the soccer and touch rugby field. Honestly, I think the only reason the Olympics were on my mind from such a young age is because my mother said I was never allowed to get a tattoo - with the sole exception being that if I competed at an Olympic Games I would be allowed to get the rings permanently inked on my body!"

Daniel credits his success to all the people who have helped him develop over the years.

His parents, grandparents and aunt were present at the Howick College Alumni Awards ceremony.

"You're the best support team I could ever have asked for, and I wouldn't have made it far at all if it wasn't for your belief in me and unwavering support in the many forms it came," said Daniel.

Daniel has completed his Bachelor of Arts degree at Yale, majoring in Astronomy. His sights are now set on the Paris 2024 Olympics where he will race alongside fellow 2020 gold medallist Phillip Wilson in the men's coxless pairs event. New Zealand has not entered a men's 8 boat in this year's Olympics.

Clevedon Showgrounds proposed plan draws criticism

The future of the Clevedon A&P Show's ability to operate could be at risk if proposed plans to redesign Clevedon Showgrounds are implemented.

Rural and equestrian groups who use the Clevedon Showgrounds say they are concerned with Showground concept plans which have been released for public consultation.

Clevedon Showgrounds User Group chair Debbie White says that a number of equestrian enthusiasts, including current Showgrounds users, met last week to discuss their concerns about the plans.

The concept plans for Clevedon's public spaces include proposals for re-imagining four key areas which include the Clevedon Hall, playground, District Centre and Showgrounds, to cope with increased demand as the local population grows.

A hiccup in the consultation process means that feedback from equestrian and rural user groups was not factored into the draft concept plan which was released for public consultation.

Consulting firm Isthmus Group engaged with all the sporting and rural/equestrian Showgrounds users at two workshops run in 2023. Following the tabled draft plan at the second workshop, the rural users collectively provided feedback about their operational requirements to Isthmus Group, but crucial aspects were overlooked in the plan that went out for public consultation.

One key concern was the proposed removal or re-siting of existing infrastructure.

"Much of the existing Showgrounds infrastructure was built fit for purpose, using fundraising, volunteer labour and community grants. Therefore the [proposed] removal of key infrastructure, including internal roading and culvert crossings poses an unnecessary cost. The existing internal roading provides access and one way traffic flow options during events," says Debbie.

Debbie says the plan that is out for public submission lacks understanding of the requirements of the various usage logistics, and the ability for the Clevedon A&P Show and equestrian events to be able to function.

The proposed plan is an opportunity to ensure the Clevedon Showgrounds rural/equestrian end is designed to embrace Clevedon's rural heritage. But the opportunity to create an integrated multi-usage area has been missed on the plans, says Debbie.

"Isthmus have tried to create a large open green space in the middle of the grounds. In doing so they have removed a future sports field training area that has been agreed to in all previous plans and seen as providing space for sports club growth in the years to come. The Isthmus plan doesn't account for the equestrian cross-country course, it even places a picnic area right in the middle of the equestrian cross-country track, and it reduces the number of all-weather parking

areas that currently exist on the park."

Clevedon A&P Show spokesperson Keith Galvin says their group is also concerned that their feedback was not incorporated before the plans were released publicly.

"This new plan will make it unviable for the A&P show to continue," says Keith.

The A&P Show group has an understanding with Council which gives them continuous rights to use the Showgrounds. They own buildings on the grounds which are leased to the Farmers Market, providing A&P with a vital revenue stream.

The new concept plans propose moving the Farmers Market to a new building, which Keith says is unnecessary and contravenes a commercial agreement the Farmers Market has with the A&P group. A covered equestrian arena building is on the plan and this facility will be available for multiuse. The proposed separate new events building has drawn criticism, with rural groups saying the building is unnecessary and that it will result in reduced all-weather parking.

Both A&P and the equestrian groups are concerned that internal roading has been eliminated on the plan, in favour of a road along the southern boundary.

Debbie says that while the proposed new road has some merit in terms of connecting housing developments and providing access into the rural end of the Showgrounds, questions remain whether the roadway, parking bays, bridle trail,

green space, buffer and fencing will even fit into the 25m gap available.

Given the lack of Council funding for local projects, Debbie says Showgrounds users are reluctant to see money spent on new infrastructure, and that they approached the plan consultation process with realistic expectations as to what is achievable.

The current amphitheatre space (the area with sheep yards, used for dog trials) has been removed from the plan. Debbie says that this area could become a long-advocated outdoor concert area if drainage is improved.

There are some positives to the plan, says Debbie. "It's good to see aspects on the plan include the structure pathways around the Showgrounds perimeter and crossing the Showgrounds, and the bridle trail."

The Auckland Manukau Dressage Group (AMDG) says it is pleased to have been included in the consultation process.

AMDG president Fiora Au says: "Although we are grateful that some of our suggestions have been taken into consideration, we do have significant concerns about parts of the proposal such as the roading at the Hunua end of the grounds. We look forward to additional consultations to arrive at the best outcome for all involved."



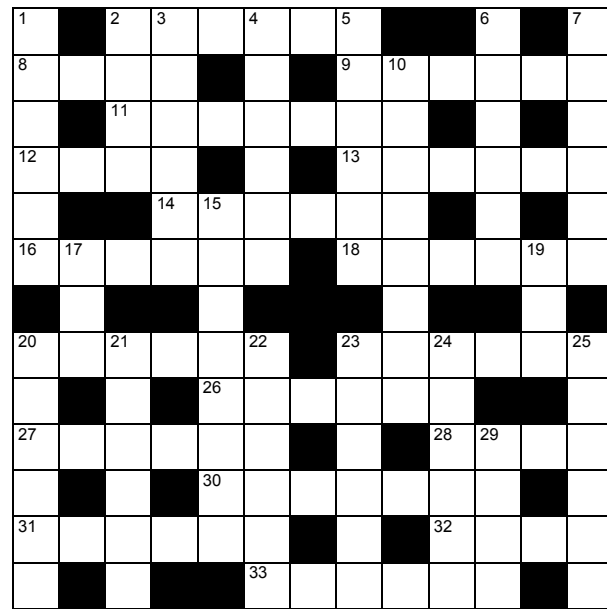
