Guest editorial by Franklin Ward Councillor Andrew Baker

I hope everyone has had the chance to enjoy some quality time with family and friends over the summer, hopefully we have some of the best weather still to come.

Towards the end of last year Council undertook public consultation for what we called PC120 which is a proposed plan change to our Unitary Plan in response to Government requirements for addressing where and how Auckland is to grow over coming decades.

The consultation certainly threw up both support and disagreement with the proposals. One of them being that people are generally skeptical of consultation in the belief that we won't listen anyway and that we don't like change.

In recent days the Government has announced they are making changes to the target number used to underpin the model. This has come under a bit of fire from some but for me, I am not going to get involved in the politics, I prefer to think they have actually listened to some of the feedback we received and appreciated that there was some discomfort around that target and that reducing it won't mean the end of the earth is upon us.

We will now set the independent panel formed to consider the submissions, free to do just that.

Over the break I have been pondering not only where we house people but where people end up after they move on from this life. One of our real challenges is finding sufficient land to create new cemeteries as we fill our existing ones. It is more complex than some may think. I have been wondering if it would be more efficient from a land use perspective if we buried people vertically rather than horizontally, something some countries actually practice. I would also like to see us look at creating what are called "Legacy Parks" where ashes are buried under trees and a whole new forest is created with those trees acting as growing headstones. The area of Logan in Queensland has recently embarked on this and it has been incredibly well received.

I will be interested in what barriers might exist as I believe we need to be thinking about such issues instead of just doing what we have always done. This requires change so obviously there will be some reluctance.

Finally on a completely different note I assure you, I want to acknowledge the

Hon Judith Collins who has announced her retirement. She has been my M.P for many years and someone I have grown to know well. Whether you agree with her politics or not, she has contributed a huge amount to the area and the country. Anyone who has got to know her, and it has been recognised by politicians of all flavours, will know she has been a fighter, willing to help and give advice to anyone including her political rivals and has a magnificent sense of humour. Her family, after twenty four years of sacrifice, now get her back. Thanks you Judith for everything you've done.

Road closures impact local businesses

The closure of Alfriston and Alfriston Ardmore Roads while road repairs are undertaken has led to frustration and loss of income for local businesses.

Clevedon Strawberries, which operates a site on Alfriston Ardmore Road, was forced to close its doors last month when the Alfriston Ardmore Road closure meant that customers could not access the store.

"We're a seasonal business, so this early closure has really affected our bottom line," says Clevedon Strawberries owner-operator Diana Gallagher.

"We're really disappointed that we didn't receive any notification from Auckland Transport about the road closure. We only found out the day that the road closed."

While electronic signage erected by Auckland Transport warned of the Alfriston Road closure, no mention was made of the Alfriston Ardmore Road closure, says Diana.

While it wasn't sustainable to keep the Alfriston shop open, Clevedon Strawberries' Monument Road site remains open for business.

Local kennel facility Brookby Lodge, on nearby Brookby Road, has also lost business due to the closure and poor signage.

A Brookby Lodge employee told the *PC Times*: "The road closure has affected our business and has stopped customers coming in because of the long detours, and the road that people are meant to use not being properly signed to indicate the business is operating as usual."

Windross Farm Golf Course is another affected by the road closures, telling the *PC Times* that although they are still open, visitor numbers to their cafe and driving range are well down, "significantly affecting business".

Auckland Transport says the work being undertaken is a pavement rehabilitation project, and that a letter drop to residents and business owners affected by the work was undertaken in early January. AT says that electronic boards were also installed at various locations to inform public about the upcoming road closures.

Phase 1 of the work - the Brookby Road, Alfriston Ardmore Road and Alfriston Road intersection rehabilitation - was completed last month.

Phase 2 - pavement rehabilitation along Alfriston Road - will continue until 23 February with the road remaining closed until then.

Clevedon hosts North Island Pony Club Champs

The problem with outdoor events is that they are, well, outdoor - and this year's North Island Pony Club Championships held at the Clevedon Showgrounds late last month posed challenges for organisers and riders when the event was hammered by heavy rain and strong winds.

The dressage component of the competition went ahead despite the rain, and was won by the team from Franklin Thames Valley, whose combined scores saw them also claim the national title.

Riders also managed to compete in the mounted games section, but whilst a few non-championship showjumping classes went ahead, the championship classes had to be cancelled after rain made the jumping surfaces too unsafe to continue.

"We ran the event under very trying conditions," says Auckland Area Pony Club representative Kate Keane. "Unfortunately, for the safety of riders and horses, we had to cancel the showjumping component of the champs. However everyone was great, and still managed to have a good time despite the weather."

One hundred and ten horses travelled to Clevedon from around the North Island to take part in the event which was sponsored by Pet n Sure.



Have your say on proposed changes to Auckland's waste rules

Auckland Council is inviting Aucklanders to have their say on proposed updates to the council's Waste Bylaw and associated controls, with consultation now open to the public.

The Waste Bylaw sets the rules for how waste is stored, collected, transported and disposed of across Tāmaki Makaurau. These rules help keep footpaths clear of bins, reduce contamination in recycling and ensure Council collects the data needed to plan for the future of waste in our growing city.

Regulatory and Safety Committee Chair Councillor Josephine Bartley, says the proposed changes won't affect most people's day-to-day routines, but are important in ensuring Auckland's waste is managed effectively.

"It's important we have clear and robust rules around how and where people can dispose of their waste and who can collect waste in our growing city," says Cr Bartley.

"The proposed changes are largely administrative and will not affect kerbside collections. However, they will help ensure waste is better managed across the region and that we have the data we need to achieve our long-term waste minimisation goals."

The proposal includes improvements to the Waste Bylaw that would:

- Expand the range of waste facilities requiring a licence to include cleanfills, and resource recovery facilities such as e-waste facilities, food and garden waste facilities, and scrap metal dealers, while limiting the focus of the licence to data collection.
- Streamline rules for waste collectors requiring a licence from the council, including removing the current 20-tonne licensing exemption and adding exemptions for incidental waste services (such as waste generated by landscape gardeners).
- Expand approved options for waste disposal, such as supermarket soft-plastic drop-off points.
- Add clearer rules to ensure waste is properly stored and contained on site, including for waste collection on private properties.
- Remove unnecessary or duplicated rules, for example, where matters are already regulated through the Auckland Unitary Plan.



The proposal also recommends clearer explanations about approved containers, what can be placed in each type of bin, prohibited items, food scraps, use of public bins and private-property collections.

The proposal retains key existing requirements, most importantly, that waste collectors and facilities must continue to obtain a licence from the council to operate in Auckland.

The review does not propose specific rules for construction and demolition waste at this stage, with further investigation planned before any decisions are made.

Aucklanders are invited to have their say from now until 11.59pm on 22 February 2026.

Easy garlic butter naan

No great curry is complete without some delicious naan bread on the side. This easy 4 ingredient naan will make the perfect addition to your next curry night. Serves 6.

Ingredients:

Naan bread:

1 cup all purpose flour
1 cup greek yogurt
2 tsp baking powder
Pinch of salt

Garlic butter:

2 Tbsp butter
1-2 cloves crushed garlic

Method:

1. Combine all naan bread ingredients in a bowl and mix until a sticky dough forms, you may need to use your hands to bring it all together. Add a little more flour if need be until it becomes kneadable.
2. Sprinkle flour on a clean benchtop and knead dough for a minute to bring it all together.
3. Divide dough into 6 even pieces. Roll each piece out with a flour dusted rolling pin until about 5mm thickness.
4. To make the garlic butter, heat a small saucepan on medium heat to melt the butter, add in the crushed garlic, cook until fragrant, then remove from heat.
5. Heat a frying pan on high. Once hot, cook the rolled dough for a couple of minutes on each side, until golden brown spots appear and the naans puff up. Remove from heat and brush garlic butter onto each side. Enjoy!






