Major pipeline renewal underway on the Coast

Beachlands and Maraetai are getting a major wastewater network upgrade as part of a \$12 million project which Watercare says is aimed at improving Auckland's ageing wastewater infrastructure.

Since mid-April, Watercare crews have been working in the area to renew pipelines, manholes and household connections. The work is part of a wider programme to strengthen Auckland's 8800km wastewater network and reduce future issues.

Watercare project manager Isileli Aholelei says advanced CCTV technology has helped identify cracks, leaks and damaged joints in the local system.

"Real-time footage has given us a clear picture of what's happening underground here in Beachlands and Maraetai,"

he says.

"We initially planned to rehabilitate 1.9km of pipeline, but after assessing the footage, we realised a more extensive upgrade was needed. The scope has now expanded to 5.8km."

To get the work done efficiently, Watercare has two teams working in tandem - one team investigates and the other carries out the repairs.

"So far, we've completed upgrades on nearly one kilometre of pipeline, 11 household connections and two manholes," says Aholelei. "By the end of May, we aim to complete

Editorial

What’s good for Auckland, is good for New Zealand

There is a persistent and annoying myth about Auckland that requires addressing: that somehow, we are a drain on the rest of the country.

I get where it comes from. I’ve had an apartment in Ponsonby for the best part of 25 years - and if anywhere deserves the “JAFA” label, it’s probably here. For the shedhand in Southland starting their day at 5am, it must be infuriating to hear a Grey Lynn middle manager complain about returning to the office clutching an oat flat white.

While this makes for good talkback fodder, the truth is, Auckland isn’t a drain - it’s the engine room. We’re a third of the country and generate 40% of the GDP. That’s not entitlement. That’s output.

Auckland is the front door to our nation - for trade, for tourism, and for talent. We’re an incubator for deep-tech start-ups, a centre for innovation, a city of sails, and world-class boatbuilders. We’re also home to major stadiums and legendary teams - the Blues, the Warriors, and now Auckland FC.

But pride alone doesn’t pay the bills. Aucklanders - like the rest of New Zealand - are feeling the squeeze.

Unemployment is rising, household costs are up, and living standards are slipping. If we want to reverse this slide into economic stagnation, we need to act - not talk about it for another decade.

The Prime Minister recently announced his intention to “go for growth”. I support that ambition, but it won’t work unless local and central government are pulling in the same direction.

For too long, successive governments have relied solely on immigration to prop up the numbers - so they can say “GDP has gone up” — while avoiding the tougher task of fixing our dreadful productivity. To be clear, immigration can be a good thing. It brings specialist skills and entrepreneurship, capital, fresh energy and scale. But historically, most of the gains, like additional tax revenue, are swept into central government coffers, while local government is stuck with the bill.

More people require more housing, infrastructure, and services. That means new roads, pipes, fibre, public transport, bin collection, and everything in between. So, who pays for it? Existing ratepayers? If we’re not careful, we’ll end up with a city that’s more congested and more expensive, and people will reach for the pitchforks.

Auckland Council’s own projections show us set to grow by more than a quarter of a million people in the next 10 years - that’s more than the entire population of Wellington city. If the government wants to plan for growth, it needs to start by listening to the city where it’s actually happening.


Good growth relies on partnership between local and central government. That’s why I’ve been calling for an Auckland Deal. After all, we’re not some district council from Horowhenua; we’re a city of 1.7 million and should be treated like it.

The deal should include long-term infrastructure funding, a fairer share of the revenue Auckland generates, and more local control over things like housing, transport, and immigration settings. That’s how you unlock growth - not from the Beehive, but from the places where people actually live and work.

Auckland has the potential to be a global hub for innovation, technology, and trade - the kind of place where businesses solving real-world problems choose to grow.

Companies like Rocket Lab, Halter, Daisy Lab, and Neocrete are already showing what’s possible. That’s the future I want for Auckland: a high-value, high-wage economy that lifts living standards and pays its own way.

My message to the government is simple: fix Auckland, fix New Zealand.

Logan Kemp honoured for Te Puru Community Centre legacy

Te Puru founder Logan Kemp’s contribution to the Coast community was recognised on Saturday 10 May, when several of Logan’s close family joined Te Puru staff and the Board in unveiling a plaque to open the new Logan Kemp Conference Room.

From as early as 1975 Logan was involved in efforts to see a recreational facility established for locals. In 2001 he went on to become a founder of the Te Puru Community Charitable Trust. The Trust secured the Te Puru Community Centre and sports grounds that locals know and enjoy today.

The Te Puru Community Charitable Trust say Logan was always hands-on and had the community’s best interest at heart, advocating for improvements and changes that made Te Puru a community hub.

Logan frequently went in to bat for his local community at council meetings in his role as a member of the Clevedon Community Board from 1998 to 2010. He was deputy chairperson of the board from 2007 to 2010.

To celebrate, the Whitford Community Charitable Trust is hosting a community screening event at The Stables, Wharf Road on Monday 9 June from 6pm. All are welcome to attend the event, where the video will be shown and filmmaker Dale Bradley will be on hand to answer questions and hear more stories from locals.

The Whitford Stories initiative aims to capture the rich history of the village through a series of short films based on real memories, photographs and footage contributed by local residents.

The first documentary in the series explores the early days of European settlement in Whitford, focusing on the families who settled here, early farming practices, the development of the village, and treasured community landmarks. Using a combination of archival imagery, personal anecdotes, and cinematic storytelling, the film paints a vivid and personal portrait of life in Whitford during the mid-20th century.

Dale hopes to also film a pre-European series.

Supported by the Whitford Residents & Ratepayers Association, CrossNet Community Trust and the Howick & Districts Historical Society, the Whitford Stories project is bringing local history to life in a modern and engaging way.

1.3km of pipe, 25 household connections, and 10 manholes.”

The work is being done using a trenchless method called Cured-In-Place-Pipe (CIPP) — a minimally invasive technique that repairs sewer pipes without needing to dig them up. A flexible resin-soaked liner is inserted and cured inside the old pipe, sealing cracks and forming a strong, leak-proof inner tube.

Aholelei acknowledges the local community’s patience during the works, which are mainly taking place in public reserves, berms, roadways, and some private properties.

“There may be some short-term odours and traffic disruptions, but we’re doing our best to minimise these and work closely with residents,” he says.

The upgrade is expected to be completed by August.

McNicol Homestead reopens following building repair project

Clevedon’s historic McNicol Homestead has reopened following months of closure while renovations were undertaken to allow the heritage-listed building to meet the building code and seismic and asbestos compliance requirements.

The building now boasts a new roof, footings and a toilet and utility room. All of the windows have been repainted, a new accessible ramp installed, and drainage gardens to keep moisture from entering the house. The flooring on both upstairs and downstairs front verandahs has been replaced, and a new fire alarm system installed.

Clevedon Historical Society spokesperson Judith Narbey says

the society is very pleased with the improvements, and acknowledges the help of the Clevedon Venturers who helped clean the upstairs areas.

The 1878 homestead was originally the home of the McNicol family who emigrated from Scotland and settled in Clevedon. Thesedays it is managed by the Clevedon & Districts Historical Society who run it as a house museum, offering visitors a glimpse of what life was like in the nineteenth century for early European settlers. The building houses a treasure trove of information about Clevedon families and Clevedon life over the years.

McNicol Homestead also hosts local activity groups.

by a free sausage sizzle thanks to Fletcher Living.


Byron says that perfect weather has allowed construction of the new track to progress well.
