Guest editorial by Friends of Te Wairoa

Friends of Te Wairoa are closing off on a highly successful year. We have continued to work with landowners to collectively improve the health and life force of the Wairoa River. Bit by bit we make a difference, as we provide education opportunities and physical resources to arm landowners with the tools needed for local ecosystem restoration projects.

Alongside this, in the background, we have been working with other agencies to seek funds and resources to assist our largely volunteer committee, and ensure we are providing communities with as many useful resources and opportunities as possible.

Our crack willow eradication programme has begun, and we are encouraging residents to deal to any trees on their property. Crack willows can regrow from any broken pieces. Fallen branches block the waterways and continue growing, creating dams and diverting waterflow, leading to erosion and increased flooding risk.

We will have a 'how to' eradication video on our social media and youtube shortly for the visual learners, and flyers are heading out to properties bordering the river. Next year, we hope to progress on the project and amp it up

in scale, getting some further assistance for residents.

The Hūnua Halo is going from strength to strength, as more and more properties that border the Hūnua Ranges undertake predator control in order to protect the taonga species that reside within the forest. We have been working with other community groups to extend this concept around the entire Ranges, to avoid reinvasion of predators from surrounding farmland.

We are working towards restoring the mauri of the awa. A healthy Wairoa River will contribute to healthier bays along the Pōhutukawa Coast, so we appreciate the support shown to our efforts from outside our catchment area.

We're excited for what 2024 has in store for us, and look forward to continuing to provide the services that have become our core business, and adding another layer of normalised everyday conservation to that.

Enjoy the season, and we'll see you again next year for more positive outcomes for our whenua!

Ōrere bus driver flies to Sydney to receive Community Champion award

Ōrere Point school bus driver Edward Pram has been officially recognised as a community champion.

Edward (Eddie) was nominated for a community champion award by his employer, Transdev, for going to the aid of a group of children trapped at Camp Adair during a flood event on 9 May this year.

On the day of the event, a severe rainstorm hit the area. Eddie was stuck in Clevedon due to flooding, unable to undertake his usual after-school bus route from Clevedon to Ness Valley and Kawakawa Bay.

“I was just sitting around Clevedon waiting when I got a call from the bus depot saying to standby as they were having issues with getting some buses out to Camp Adair,” he says. “Everybody was stuck in town and nobody could move and they couldn’t get the buses out here... then I had a call from the operations manager saying ‘we need you’.”

A group of about 300 young students were waiting to be evacuated from Camp Adair where the adjacent river was rapidly rising and local roads were flooded.

With Monument Road access to Hūnua cut off due to flooding, Eddie travelled via Papakura to get to Hūnua Road and made his way to the camp where he was met by a couple of other drivers.

“The river was coming up fast, and we also knew our legal driving hours were nearly up for the day. It was dire straights. When I got there nothing was happening. We needed to load the buses and get them out of there. I got there and said, ‘Don’t worry about the dirt, don’t worry about the mud, just get the kids on the bus, get all the gear in there, we’ve got five minutes to get out of here.’”

They managed to get the students loaded onto the buses and out of the camp before the river breached its banks, and with enough time to transport the students to a hostel in Mangere before Eddie’s driving hours were up for the day.

It was an incident which Eddie put down to just another day in the office, until a few weeks ago when he received a call from his employers telling him he was nominated for the company’s annual Community Champion Award.

“The fact of being nominated is an award in itself,” says Eddie.

He was flown to Sydney for Transdev’s Journey Maker Awards ceremony, a suit and tie function at Darling Harbour where he enjoyed dinner and drinks alongside Transdev’s “top brass”. He was also named Community Champion category winner - a big deal considering Transdev is a large Australasian transport company with over 4,600 employees.

Eddie began bus driving 9 years ago, and says his favourite part is the interaction with people.

“There are a lot of protocols around transporting children. A lot of the kids are a bit hesitant at first, but then they get to know you, they interact and generally have good manners. You meet a lot of parents too.”

Safety is always top of Eddie’s mind, and he says he is “fussy and strict” about children crossing the road, and will even cross the road with them himself to ensure their safety. His bus has seatbelts, which he credits to Transdev’s focus on safety for rural bus students.

Thinking of others is a common theme in Eddie’s life. He was chairperson of the Ōrere Community and Boating Club for many years, only stepping down last year. During Covid his phone was on 24/7 so that people within the community could contact him if they needed assistance with

anything, and he received an award for helping arrange and deliver food supplies to those in need. He is now in the process of becoming a Justice of the Peace so that he can serve the people of Ōrere Point, where he has owned a home for 60 years.

He doesn’t do it for the accolades, he says. “You do it because you want to. There’s reward in everything you do.”

Christmas spirit dampened by scam at Hūnua Village Market

Police are on the lookout for a woman who stole hundreds of dollars worth of goods from two stallholders at the recent Hūnua Village Christmas Market.

The two stallholders, who are sisters, had joined the Christmas market after one of them enjoyed a positive experience at the Hūnua market in March.

In the weeks leading up to the Christmas market, one of the sisters says she worked while her children slept, staying up late each night to create new clothing to sell at the market, in the hope that a good day's sales might help fill her children's Christmas stockings.

On the day of the market, one of the affected stallholders was visited by a customer who purchased a large amount of food. The stallholder says she was a little uncomfortable about the quantity of food bought, and as a precaution took a photo of the visitor's car registration.

The same customer then visited the second stallholder, purchasing several hundred dollars worth of clothing.

The customer used her phone to pay for both transactions, briefly flashing her phone at the stallholders to show 'proof' of payment.

A while after the visitor left the market, both stallholders checked their bank accounts and realised the money for the goods had not been deposited into their accounts.

"We're so used to the trustworthy good people around us, we let our guards down," says one of the scammed stallholders who did not wish to be named.

Vehicle check website CarJam showed the registration plate number recorded by one of the stallholders did not match the vehicle, suggesting the car was stolen.

Hūnua Ararimu and Paparimu Valley Residents Association (HAPVRA) organises the twice-yearly markets. HAPVRA co-chair Jane Berney says their committee is

shocked at the brazenness of the theft.

"In all the years of this community market, we've never had anyone scam stall holders, many of whom we know see this as their primary income," says Jane.

HAPVRA Co-chair Geraldine Schauer says they have provided Police with a description of the offender, a women

wearing a blue top and blue bandana. "The reports were completed, and local knowledge of the 'visitor' was shared with the police, but the two affected stallholders are still devastated, as are we."

Jane and Geraldine say the incident is a reminder to all market stallholders to be vigilant about transactions.

The Hūnua Traverse cycle trail opens in full

The Hūnua Traverse cycle trail opened in full on Friday 1 December, with riders from across New Zealand expressing enthusiasm for the new Ngā Haerenga Heartland Ride connection between Auckland and the Waikato.

The 44.5km connects Clevedon and Kaiāua via the Hūnua Ranges Regional Park and, with its inclusion in the official Tour Aotearoa Cape Reinga to Bluff cycling route, it is set to become a key bikepacking connection.

The two-way ride utilises existing sealed and unsealed public and private roads. While it has been partially open as a limited preview ride these past five months, a slip in the centre of the route meant that the full end-to-end experience can only now be enjoyed for the first time.

“We’ve been thrilled to see so many riders and walkers out utilising the limited access over the past few months, but this full opening is what we’ve been working towards for nine long years,” says Franklin Local Board chair and Wairoa Ward representative, Angela Fulljames, who has championed this project from its inception.

Angela says the feedback from riders to date has been terrific. “One rider described it as ‘the best gravel riding in Auckland Region’. With reviews like that we’re looking forward to welcoming riders from across the city.”

But with a cumulative elevation gain

of over 1100m, it’s not for the faint hearted. The Hūnua Traverse is classified as a Grade 4 ride suited to intermediate and experienced riders, reflecting the steep terrain, slippery gravel surfacing and off-camber corners and a shared road environment. An appropriate level of fitness and bike handling skills are essential.

Suited to mountain bikes, ebikes and gravel bikes, riders are encouraged to take a cautious approach to the ascents and descents.

“The roads within the Hūnua Traverse are live and unpredictable. While they might seem quiet we remind cyclists to share with care and keep left – you never know what’s going to be coming around the next corner,” cautions Angela.

The Watercare and Auckland Council Regional Parks teams have worked closely to provide safety signage and mirrors along the route. They’ve also signposted side roads that remain closed to riders.

In Clevedon, where the trail starts and ends, Clevedon Community and Business Association chair Victoria Richards, is looking forward to seeing more riders stopping in at local businesses.

“In our online survey, 76% of respondents said they stopped and spent money in our local community, whether it be for a sit-down meal, snacks and coffee to go or petrol. We’re hoping local businesses



will expand their offering to provide more cyclist-friendly services and facilities. Whether it be offering a bike stand for ride-in customers, a place to charge an e-bike or cell phone, or accommodation options for riders exploring our area. We encourage the residents of the Wairoa Valley to welcome cyclists to our corner of Auckland.”

The full Hūnua Traverse opening is supported by an informative new website which details information about the full end-to-end ride, as well as on-road loop connections, easy rides for novice riders and details about how you can stay overnight in the Hūnua Ranges Regional Park (bookings essential).

A note to weekday riders, Otāu Mountain

Road is used by logging trucks Monday to Friday. Cyclists are strongly advised to use this access road on weekends and public holidays only. Alternate access to the Hūnua Traverse is available from Moumoukai Hill Road, via Ness Valley.

Temporary closures of the Hūnua Traverse may be required at times to accommodate forestry operations, pest control, maintenance or on occasion to mitigate fire risk during the fire season. Riders should check the Hūnua Traverse website or Facebook page for up-to-date access information.

The Hūnua Traverse has been funded by the Franklin Local Board and is delivered in partnership with Watercare, Auckland Regional Parks and Ngā Haerenga NZCT.


