





## Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki farewells larger than life rangatira, James Brown

Ka kōrihi, ka tangi Ka tangi, ka kōrihi Ka korokī ko Ngāti Tai Ko Ngāi Tai ka korokī

Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki was deeply saddened to share the news of the sudden passing of our longtime rangatira, lead negotiator and loveable rogue, James Brown.

Born and raised at Mātaitai and Waitarata, James went to school locally, played rugby locally, likely got into mischief locally and upon his return from Australia nearly 30 years ago, dedicated his life to upholding the mana of Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki both locally and across the country.

Locals would have seen him driving his larger than life utes through the Clevedon village or surrounding areas, in the forest or out on the coast. Or would have heard him either laughing loudly or shouttalking into his phone while walking down the road on his way to Clevedon Seafoods.

James' personality was big and bold, and the James you experienced was determined by how you came into the meeting with him, and how you'd engaged with Ngāi Tai. He was a warrior when he needed to be, and also one of the kindest humans you could be lucky enough to

know

His whānau knew that James was well connected throughout the country, but seeing everyone arrive over the weekend of 25-26 August to pay their respects was deeply moving.

We would like to acknowledge and thank everyone's kind wishes and support as we arranged his tangihanga at Umupuia marae, particularly those who supported our traffic management notifications (but maybe not Gavin...) and everyone who contributed to what was a beautifully fitting send off for one of the leading characters in the Ngāi Tai story.

James leaves us with many great ideas to implement, and many successful business streams that Ngāi Tai is determined to see through to ensure his legacy.

Ko ngā whetū ki te rangi,





## Clevedon Venturers model resilience at beleaguered World Scout Jamboree

Seven teenage Clevedon Venturers had their resilience tested by a heatwave, unsanitary conditions and then a typhoon during a recent visit to South Korea for the World Scout Jamboree.

The Clevedon Venturers plus 4 leaders joined 92 others from New Zealand at the jamboree, which hosted about 43,000 participants from more than 150 countries at the event held in Saemangeum.

It wasn't quite the trip the 14-18 year olds and their leaders had anticipated, but Clevedon Scouts representative Andrew Fisher says it was still a great experience to mix with adults and venturers from other countries who had all come together to enjoy their time and make it an event to remember.

The jamboree was plagued by problems from the time of its opening on 1 August when temperatures at the 9 square-kilometre campsite soared well above 30 degrees Celsius. Organisers had provided little shade or water, and with no contingency plan for the extreme weather, a number of participants suffered from heat exhaustion.

"The heat wave proved a challenge, as it went on for over 8 days and it really highlighted how both Kiwis and Aussies, along with our Pacific Island friends, understand heat and the need to be proactive. It was about consuming 5-7 litres of fluid a day, not just a bottle. It was relentless, we had to hunt for shade and be proactive in managing exposure," says Andrew.

Fortunately the Kiwi contingent arrived 7 days prior to the jamboree, and were able to acclimatise.

"In addition to this all the Kiwis had previously attended the New Zealand Jamboree at Mystery Creek, and had experience in large events, plus over 50 nights camping experience, which gave immediate context along with the ability to support each other. We were prepared," says Andrew.

The campsite, built on reclaimed land near the coast, had flooded just prior to the event. Jamboree organisers therefore took the precaution of pitching the sea of tents atop wooden pallets to get them off the damp ground. Poor sanitation was

one of the biggest problems faced by the venturers. Andrew says the portable toilets were the major issue, serviced by only 70 cleaners and a few trucks, which was not enough to support over 42,000 event participants. "This was increased to over 570 on day four and a fleet of vacuum loader trucks, but still many were red stickered." A shortage of soap and toilet paper added to the campers woes.

The food supplied by the jamboree organisers was initially both insufficient and bland, which forced the Korean Government to step in on day four and increase rations significantly. Andrew says the supplied lunches consisted of a muesli bar, packaged plain roll and a can of fizzy water - nowhere near enough energy to sustain active teenagers, who had to top up their energy levels by purchasing additional food. The Kiwi contingent purchased extra food to ensure availability.

Andrew says that one of the biggest issues was that some children lost their appetite in the heat, and needed to be encouraged to eat.

Scouts UK decamped from the jamboree early on, with chief executive Matt Hyde saying the conditions were "simply not safe for our young people".

In typical Kiwi fashion though, the Clevedon Venturers made the most of their stay, escaping the heat with regular visits throughout the day to their rented air conditioned bus, and by taking part in night-time activities when the air was cooler.

Andrew says the event was a "huge let down" by the Korean organisers, but not reflective of the country or local community. "And definity not comparable to the very successful Jamboree in the USA in 2019 or the much anticipated 2027 World Jamboree in Poland, which has already hosted a successful Euro Jamboree. But the Kiwis hung on and made the best of a bad situation."

The Kiwis eventually made the decision to leave the site three days earlier than planned due to an incoming typhoon, which eventually forced a mass evacuation of all attendees, with over 1000 buses supporting the operation.

"We were prepared for all of this," says Andrew. "Insurance kicked in, and we were able to move to our hotel accommodation in Seoul a few days earlier than scheduled."

The venturers then visited a waterpark, cultural and historic sites and a pop concert before attending the jamboree closing ceremony held at a football stadium in Seoul.

Despite the less than ideal conditions,

Andrew says the Clevedon team still enjoyed the experience, rating it "an 11 out of 10".

"We will never forget it and will compare everything in the future with it. It's called type 2 fun, at the time not so much fun, however upon reflection so many great stories, memories and friendships. Bring on Poland 2027, 26th World Scout Jamboree!"





## Work begins on concept plans for Clevedon's community spaces

Is the playground by the Clevedon Hall in the best location? How can we better utilise the little reserve in the centre of the village? How do equestrian users, dog walkers and sports groups best share the Clevedon Showgrounds? What happens when our population grows to 4000 residents? Where will everyone park?!

These questions - and more - are being addressed by the Community Heart Plan and an updated Showgrounds Masterplan, initiated by the Clevedon Community and Business Association (CBA), Franklin Local Board and Auckland Council Parks and Community Facilities.

The Community Heart Plan is a concept plan for Clevedon Village's public spaces, including the hall, playground, the residential site on the corner of North and Twilight Roads, the District Centre and the reserve next to the cemetery. The aim is to better accommodate the needs of Clevedon's growing population and visitor numbers.

The impetus for this project was when Franklin Local Board set aside funds to renew the playground several years ago. The Clevedon CBA suggested that the playground may be better sited elsewhere, and that before Council spent valuable

funds renewing it that the best place for the playground first be determined.

"We also highlighted to Franklin Local Board that, given the population growth on the horizon, consideration should be given to how all the Council-owned sites in Clevedon Village could best function," says Clevedon CBA Chair Victoria Richards.

Concurrently, the various user groups at the Clevedon Showgrounds were having similar discussions. With increasing demand anticipated across all sporting codes, increasing 'passive' recreation such as walking or cycling, and some well-articulated aspirations that include improved drainage and lighting, the Showgrounds User Group was formally re-established in 2022. Auckland Council committed to updating the masterplan for

the site and amalgamated the two projects.

"We're delighted that Franklin Local Board is taking a whole-of-village strategic approach," says Victoria. "And we're also thrilled to be able to pull our community-driven Clevedon Village Design Framework back off the shelf to kick-start this exciting project."

Design firm Isthmus has been appointed to produce a concept plan for both the public spaces in the Village and the Showgrounds and to generate a programme for implementation. Work began late last month with a site visit by Isthmus and the next steps are workshops with key stakeholders.

Once a concept plan is adopted, it will be used to help guide Auckland Council's development and funding in the area.




