Marina begins work on housing development

Pine Harbour Marina Ltd (PHML) has commenced civil works as it prepares to construct 26 apartment-style townhouses adjacent the marina.

PHML says the new development, called The Waterfront, will consist of five buildings containing a total of 26 homes fronting the existing marina.

Civil works have begun and should be completed during the first half of next year, with construction of the first stage of the development to begin shortly after.

In June 2018 PHML was granted resource consent to construct 28 apartments within four three-storey buildings, plus commercial premises including restaurants and shops at Pine Harbour. The resource consent process attracted 40 submissions opposing the

plans, with five in support and three neutral.

The 2018 resource consent was approved on the back of a consent granted by Auckland Council in 2017 for a solely commercial development of the same size.

Since the 2018 resource consent was approved, there have been two requests (in 2023 and 2024) by Pine Harbour Marina to change the conditions of consent. Auckland Council says both requests were for changes that were considered as refinements to the design and to be still within scope of the original resource consent decision, and were therefore approved.

PHML says it will begin marketing the properties next year.

Voting closes for local body elections this Saturday

Saturday 11 October at midday is the cut-off for voting in the Auckland Council elections.

As of Friday 3 October, voting results showed that 19,929 people had voted in the Franklin Local Board’s Wairoa area which includes Beachlands, Maraetai, Whitford, Hūnua, Clevedon, Kawakawa Bay and surrounding areas. The figure represents just 21 per cent of the population, but was still the third-highest voting population within the supercity, behind Rodney (Warkworth) and Waiheke.

As soon as the clock strikes 12pm this Saturday, vote boxes across Tāmaki Makaurau will be sealed shut. These last-minute ballots will be taken to the vote processing centre, where votes are counted.

120,000 visitors expected to create hive of activity at Clevedon Farmers' Market

An extra 120,000 visitors to this weekend's Clevedon Farmers' Market will create quite the buzz.

On Sunday 12 October local beekeeper James Green, from Clevedon-based business Hidden Honey, will bee-gin a road trip from Auckland to Wellington in the country's first mobile hive. The first stop is the Clevedon Farmers' Market, where the specially converted Volkswagen ID. Buzz named "Polly" will give marketgoers a chance to learn about pollination, taste a range of honey, and take home some bee-friendly wildflower seeds to plant in their gardens.

The 'Pollination Tour' follows the natural honey flow from the top of Te Ika-a-Māui/ North Island down to Pōneke/Wellington, with bees doing their vital pollination work along the way. Polly houses fully functioning mobile beehives in a climate-controlled "beecosystem" powered by the van's infotainment system.

Transporting bees isn't a simple task, says James. The hives must be carefully ventilated and temperature-controlled to keep the bees safe and calm. Two special hatches allow bees to leave the van through tubes during the day, before returning to their hive at night when Polly hits the road again.

The bees have spent time acclimatising at Hidden Honey's Clevedon farm, and James says the Farmers' Market was a

natural place to stop first. "It felt right to begin in a place where we've built strong relationships. The local farming community has supported us from the very beginning. And since the road trip follows the honey flow, Clevedon was the perfect starting point to align with nature's rhythm and kick off the journey."

From Clevedon, Polly will travel to the Whanganui Market on 18 October and

the Wellington Harbourside Market on 26 October.


Hidden Honey is a family-run operation based in Clevedon and South Taranaki, managing over 700 hives in remote, pesticide-free bush.

"It's just me, my brothers and close friends, working together to harvest small batches of raw Mānuka honey the way it's always been done: sustainably

and with care," says James. "For us, it's not just about honey, it's about protecting pollinators, preserving our native ecosystems, and sharing the healing goodness of New Zealand honey with people everywhere."

At the end of the tour, the travelling hives will be relocated to a permanent site, where the bees will continue their important work.

Coasters urged to spread some Christmas cheer by creating Boxes of Love

The lead up to Christmas is a busy time for everyone, but the Pickering family from Beachlands are probably busier than most as they begin coordinating ‘Boxes of Love’ for over 200 families.

Boxes of Love are gift-wrapped shoeboxes containing an assortment of gifts for children, or pamper packs for caregivers, valued at around \$25-30. This will be the eighth year the family has run the initiative.

Come Christmas-time, the boxes are gifted to local families through the Takutai Food Bank, and to Mangere families via the Living and Learning Foundation.

“The Boxes of Love we give become more and more essential every year,” says Sarah. “Everything is expensive thesedays, even buying the essentials is difficult for so many sadly. A few toys given at Christmas can really make a child and their family feel so loved and special.”

Boxes of Love creators are matched with a child or adult to tailor their gift to. Sarah is also happy to receive donations of money and toys if people would rather help in that way, especially if they don’t want to commit to making a full box.

Donations for the Boxes of Love can be as large or small as people can manage. “Even just donating a single item is great - all the single things add up, or can be used to top up boxes,” says Sarah.

Once all the children have been matched up with Boxes of Love creators, Sarah says they often find themselves with more locals wanting to help.

“We will then ask for some baby items and pamper goodies for a young mums’ group. We also make up a few adult hampers as requested by these two organisations for those who really need some extra love at Christmas, maybe they are going through a very difficult time or are raising grandchildren,” she says.

Watercare opens the gates to Beachlands Wastewater Treatment Plant

Watercare is inviting Beachlands and Maraetai residents to step behind the gates and explore the Beachlands Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The free event will be held on Saturday 18 October from 10am to 2pm at 100 Okaroro Drive. Locals will have the chance to tour the plant, learn about the wastewater treatment process, and discover how Watercare is planning for future growth in the area.

Watercare southern wastewater production manager Rohan Bhatia says the open day comes at a pivotal time for the region, which is undergoing steady urban development under the Auckland Unitary Plan.

“The open day is a great opportunity for locals to gain a better understanding of their current infrastructure, learn about the challenges we’re facing, and see what we’re doing behind the scenes to plan for the future.

“It builds on our ongoing efforts to actively engage with the community to discuss future wastewater servicing options for the area.

Bhatia says the event is also an opportunity for Coasters to be among the first Aucklanders to experience Watercare’s new Wonder Wai travelling discovery centre.
