

## Guest Editorial by Mayor of Auckland Wayne Brown

It hasn't been the best start to the year with weather events affecting many communities across the country in recent weeks.

While our region held up well overall, my thoughts have been with communities north of Auckland, Thames-Coromandel, Tauranga and further south, that didn't fare as well. These events highlight once again, the important role of emergency management and I've appreciated the effort of emergency services that stood up to respond.

Coming back into the office, it's not lost on me that 2026 will be a big year for council, the Auckland region and the country.

We are continuing our work to build the physical resilience of our city region; the Making Space for Water programme is one of those, alongside transport reform and a new housing plan.

This year will see the opening of two major projects, the City Rail Link (CRL) and International Convention Centre (ICC), that have taken ages – and cost ratepayers and taxpayers a fortune – to complete. They were needed but could have been done cheaper.

As I've said before, I'm all about doing things better, cheaper and faster and while the CRL and ICC have been

complex, they're both among the most over-budget projects ever delivered in this country. On the bright side, they'll provide lots of lessons on how not to do big projects!

I'm also looking forward to council getting our hands on AT planning and turning AT's focus on to public transport because it's something they actually do well. The rest, like strategic decision making and long-term planning, will come back into council which will become a road controlling authority like every other council.

Make no mistake, it'll be a big challenge, but I've never been one to shy away from the big issues. After all, I was re-elected and given the mandate to finish the fix we started in my first term, like Get Auckland Moving and Stop Wasting Money.

This year is also a big year for a new partnership approach if agreement can be reached between government and the biggest council in the country. The first of the government's City Deals could signal a fundamental shift in the relationship between central and local government because we deserve to be treated as the genuine partner we are.

Finally, my updated manifesto will be published this year with a list of what we'll do and how government can help us deliver – namely, by being more

hands-off – so we can get on with lifting prosperity, building confidence, growing our tech economy and focusing on maximising benefit from the new southern link flights between China and South America, through Auckland.

There's plenty more on the list, but it'll be helpful for the government to be reminded that it's the Auckland region that will decide who will win the central government elections at the end of the year. Note. Red tape and a 'we know best' attitude won't be a vote winner.

Yes, it will be a big year. Let's get on with it.

## Auckland Transport takes step closer to Clevedon crossing

Auckland Transport (AT) has released the results of its public consultation regarding a pedestrian crossing in Clevedon, saying that after reviewing all feedback, they plan to have a crossing installed by mid 2026.

139 submissions were received, with 95 per cent of respondents saying the changes would benefit the community.

Most feedback showed support for AT's proposal, particularly the need for safer crossings for children, older people and families. Many people also highlighted the importance of improving walkability and slowing traffic through the village.

Concerns about potential impacts, including the loss of on-street parking and the need to ensure crossings are well located and clearly visible, were raised.

AT says these views helped inform refinements to the proposal.

Some suggestions - such as additional crossings, footpaths and speed management - were outside the scope of the current project and will be considered as part of future pedestrian safety improvements in Clevedon.

Auckland Transport's proposals include a new zebra crossing between the Hawthorn Munro building and the Clevedon Superette, as well as a new pedestrian refuge and footpath on the northern boundary of Clevedon School to improve safety for students and residents travelling between Clevedon School, the northern end of the village, and the Taita Stream walkway.

AT hopes to implement the changes by June 2026, subject to funding availability.

# Relief for rural communities as Ararimu fill site proposal withdrawn

Residents of Paparimu and Ararimu received welcome news late last week after Auckland Council confirmed that the applicant behind a large proposed managed fill site on Ararimu Road had withdrawn their resource consent application.

The proposal, located at the Paparimu end of Ararimu Road, had attracted strong opposition from the community. More than 500 submissions were lodged with Auckland Council in September opposing the plan, which involved dumping up to 1.3 million cubic metres of excavated material, including construction waste, on rural land over a 16-year period. With residents still waiting for a hearing date, news of the sudden withdrawal came as a surprise.

"It was so unexpected," says Hunua Ararimu Paparimu Valley Residents Association (HAPVRA) co-chair Geraldine Schnauer. "One minute we were gearing up for more fundraising to pay for experts to present at the hearing and the next we were cheering because it was all over."

"We're so pleased for the neighbours who were directly impacted by the noise and dust of the operation as well as the many small rural communities who would have suffered up to 120 truck movements a day, six days per week."

HAPVRA's campaign was supported

by the Ararimu Residents & Ratepayers Association, which helped with fundraising and hosted drop-in sessions to guide residents through the submission process.

"We couldn't have done it without them", says Geraldine. "Our combined skills and energy really made a difference."

While the Ararimu Road proposal has been withdrawn, HAPVRA is now preparing for another significant challenge - the upcoming Jones Road, Hunua managed fill resource consent hearing. The hearing was scheduled to take place at Auckland Council offices in Manukau from 25–27 February, however this week submitters received notification from Auckland Council that the hearing had been postponed while the applicant sought further information.

A public meeting scheduled for 13 February has subsequently been postponed.

The Jones Road proposal would see a fill site roughly the size of Wellington's Cake Tin stadium, with up to 192 truck movements per day travelling through the narrow, winding Hunua Gorge.

Opponents have received some encouragement, with an Auckland Council planner recommending the application be refused due to traffic safety concerns and impacts on rural character.

Concerns remain about potential risks to

the Hays Creek Dam catchment. "We are horrified that a proposed fill could be built so close to an essential water supply and we hope Watercare's experts will be able to provide a robust opposition."

Geraldine expects strong community support to continue. "We may be small, but we are a determined, highly organised community. We're looking forward to our time at the hearing to show rural

voices do matter, and we're expecting that our Ararimu and Paparimu friends will now join this fight too. There is only one Hunua Ranges in the whole world, and we are determined to keep it beautiful."



# Ardmore School prepares for 150th birthday celebration

Ardmore School is marking a significant milestone this year, celebrating 150 years since students first entered its doors.

The 150th celebrations will begin on Friday 6 March with a pōwhiri and welcome at 2.30pm, followed by registration and afternoon tea.

On Saturday 7 March, the hall and classrooms will open to visitors, followed by a ceremony at 12.30pm which will include cutting of a cake, tree planting, and a time capsule display. From 1.30-3pm, decade photographs will be taken, before dinner at The Blacksmith in Takaanini for those aged 18+.

Established in 1876, Ardmore School was originally founded to serve the small but thriving rural settlement that grew alongside the Papakura Clevedon Road. The school was named Ardmore as a tribute to local farmer Mr Henry Burnside and the town of Ardmore in Ireland, where he was born.

From its earliest days, the school has been connected to the land and the families who have shaped the area.

As the community grew, so did the school, with building extensions increasing the school's footprint by more than 20 per cent. By the 1930s and 1940s, the school had become a two-teacher school, with three classrooms added during the war years. These classrooms were later

relocated around the school grounds and, after being reworked, are still in use today.

Ardmore School is also notable for its role in teacher training.

The first calf club day, now known as Agricultural Day, was held in November 1947 and remains a highlight of the school calendar. In 1948, Ardmore School was designated a model country school and was adopted by Papakura Normal School and the Teachers Training College. Trainee teachers regularly visited to observe rural teaching practice, and Ardmore teachers themselves played a key role in supporting and mentoring new educators.

Over the decades that followed, the school continued to evolve. A school windmill was constructed in 1957, followed by significant upgrades to facilities. In 1980, Ardmore School installed a new swimming pool, complete with changing and administration blocks, and a tennis and netball court. The introduction of "Tomorrow's Schools" brought further change, raising expectations from "high levels" to "Ad Ardua – Aim High", a motto that continues to guide the school's values. Ardmore School was also recognised nationally, receiving the School DX Award and the first "For Two" grant.

The roll has grown from just 21 pupils and one teacher in its opening year to

around 360 students, supported by more than 30 staff, a committed Board of Trustees, and a strong parent and whānau community.

Despite the growth of nearby Papakura and Takaanini, Ardmore School has retained its strong rural character. Most students live locally, and many families have attended the school across generations.

Ardmore School is one of three schools in the area to celebrate 150 years, with Hūnua School also planning its 150th anniversary event on 27-28 March, and Brookby School which celebrated its 150th birthday last November.

'this is my problem,' and he sees it as an opportunity and finds a solution," says Nikki.

The finished kitchen is a standout feature of the home, blending beautifully with its natural surroundings while delivering outstanding functionality. Deep green-grey thermoform cabinetry complements the tree-clad hillside and sweeping Hauraki Gulf views beyond the kitchen window. A thoughtful mix of fluted and traditional cabinetry fronts, textured wall tiles, engineered stone benchtops, and warm timber accents creates a soft, inviting space.

But it's the practicality that really impresses Derek. Clever storage solutions are built in throughout, right down to the kitchen island cupboards that open onto the living space and discreetly store toys for visiting grandchildren. A generous walk-in scullery adds valuable appliance storage and doubles as a laundry – complete with what Derek calls his "drinks fridge".

Importantly, the project was delivered with minimal disruption. "We actually enjoyed the process," Nikki says. "We were able to keep living in the house while the kitchen was done. Everything came in on time and on budget, and the result is stunning."


The impact has been transformative. "It's changed the way we live," says

## Data busts myth that property values always double over a decade

Does property double in a decade? Not in the last cycle, new data shows.

National average asking price increased by 55.1% in past 10 years

Auckland's average asking price increases only 23.5%

The regions take the cake for delivering the biggest returns with seven doubling in price since 2015

Gisborne reports 145% increase from \$284,134 in 2015 to \$697,527 in 2025

Lore tells us that property prices double every 10 years, but the latest data from [realestate.co.nz](http://realestate.co.nz) shows this wasn't the case nationally in the last decade. Between 2015 and 2025 New Zealand's national average asking price only increased by 55.1%, from \$556,931 to \$863,747.

While the highly sought-after doubling in value milestone may not have occurred nationally, seven of New Zealand's 19 regions did achieve the coveted accolade.

Gisborne topped the chart with a 145.5% increase in its asking price from \$284,134 in 2015 to \$697,527 in 2025. Manawatu/Whanganui followed with a 121.5% increase from \$274,032 in 2015 to \$606,985 in 2025 and Central North Island recorded the third highest increase of 119.2% from \$348,659 in 2015 to \$764,316 in 2025.

Of the major centres, Auckland delivered the least value increase in the last decade with a 23.5% increase from \$846,730 in 2015 to \$1,045,328 in 2025. Waikato was the standout performer with a 95.9% increase in average asking price over the decade, from \$405,770 in 2015 to \$795,097 in 2025.

[Realestate.co.nz](http://realestate.co.nz) spokesperson Vanessa Williams says while it may be true for some, the last decade has debunked the notion as a general rule. "The idea that property always doubles in value every 10 years is a simplification that doesn't reflect how the market really

works," says Williams. "Property moves in cycles – we have peaks, plateaus, and periods of correction, so doubling in value isn't a guarantee and it will always depend on individual properties and locations as well."

"Over the past decade, we've seen significant regional variation and, in many areas, growth has fallen well short of that aspirational 'doubling in value' benchmark. While prices generally rise over time, growth is rarely linear and depends heavily on when in the cycle you buy and sell."

Which regions fetched returns for homeowners?

Southland (111.3%), Hawke's Bay (105.0%), Wairarapa (100.7%) and Coromandel (100.1%) were the four remaining regions that more than doubled their average asking price during the past decade.

Williams says despite an ever-changing landscape, the value of

property continues to increase over the long term.

"Over the past 10 years, we've seen the New Zealand property market navigate some of the most dramatic economic shifts in recent history, from a pandemic-fuelled boom to a sharp market reset. In the same period, we've seen significant regulatory change, with the introduction of loan-to-value (LVR) restrictions, the bright-line test, and more recently, debt-to-income (DTI) ratios.

Through it all, property has remained a national conversation and a first-choice of investment for many Kiwis."

The good news? Hold on for another five years and your price may double

There's better news for homeowners who bought 15 years ago – the national average asking price has come close to doubling over this period, increasing by 91.9% since 2010, from \$450,014 to \$863,747 in 2025.

## First home buyers make hay as record market share caps strong finish to 2025

First home buyers have cemented their position as the most active buyer group<sup>[1]</sup> in New Zealand's housing market, reaching a record share of purchases across the December quarter of 2025.

Cotality's latest data shows first home buyers (FHBs) accounted for 28.8 per cent of property purchases in December and 28.4 per cent for the quarter overall - the highest on record, with the number of completed deals also remaining solid.

Despite national property values ending 2025 broadly flat, underlying conditions have become increasingly favourable for aspiring homeowners.

Easing mortgage rates, access to KiwiSaver funds, and the ability to utilise

banks' low-deposit lending allowances have all supported a surge in FHB activity.

Some households are also now finding that the cost of servicing a mortgage is comparable to - or even lower than - paying rent.

Cotality Chief Property Economist Kelvin Davidson said the alignment of improved affordability, more flexible deposit pathways, and competitive lending conditions had created a unique window of opportunity for first home buyers.

"First home buyers are making the most of current market conditions."

"With property values off their highs, mortgage rates easing, and support from KiwiSaver and low-deposit lending,

this group is well placed to take advantage of opportunities. For many, the gap between renting and buying has narrowed, making home ownership more achievable," Mr Davidson said.

While first home buyers dominated late-2025 activity, Mr Davidson said the broader buyer landscape was more uneven.

"Mortgaged multiple property owners, including smaller and newer investors, continued to re-engage cautiously with the market."

"Lower mortgage rates and reduced cashflow top-ups on rental properties have helped investors targeting lower-priced or existing dwellings."

"However, the lurking influence of debt-to-income (DTI) ratio limits in

2026 is expected to be an important consideration for investors over the coming year. The weakness of rents is an added challenge for investors, albeit great for tenants."

"Meanwhile, relocating owner-occupiers, or 'movers', remained quieter than usual with many households continuing to adopt a wait-and-see approach due to the cost and disruption of trading up in an uncertain economic environment," he said.

## Take lunch to the next level with air fryer stuffed bagel bites

Stuck on what to make for lunch? Try these easy 5 ingredient, hot, fluffy, creamy bagel bites that only take 10 minutes in the air fryer!

Makes: 6 bagel bites

**Ingredients:**

½ cup unsweetened greek yoghurt  
½ cup all purpose flour  
1 tsp baking soda  
6 loaded tsp cream cheese  
Everything but the bagel seasoning, or sesame seeds

1. In a bowl combine the yoghurt, flour and baking soda until a sticky dough forms. Divide this dough into 6 even portions.
2. Sprinkle flour onto a clean surface, grab one portion of the dough and flatten it out until about 5mm thick. Place a loaded teaspoon of cream cheese into the centre, then fold the edges up so that the cream cheese is fully encased and ball shaped. Repeat this step with all 6 portions.
3. Pour a layer of the 'Everything



but the Bagel' seasoning into a small bowl. Take each ball and lightly wet it with water so that the seasoning can stick to it

4. Place all 6 balls into the airfryer and bake at 200C for 10 minutes

easily. Roll each ball in the bowl of seasoning until fully coated. rolling them over half way through. They should be golden brown and smell delicious! Enjoy!






