Beachlands Chartered Club celebrates 75th Jubilee



The origins of the current Beachlands Chartered Club lie in the former Ex-Services Club, which opened in 1948.

The Beachlands Chartered Club is gearing up to celebrate its 75th birthday in style this month.

The club was formed pre-1948, initially operating from a shed where Ambrosia restaurant currently sits. Known as the Ex-Services Club, the land and building were donated by one of the seven founding members. In 1948 the main hall was built and the club became officially incorporated. Organisers of the 75th jubilee say details of exactly who donated the land

and building have sadly been lost over time, along with other parts of the club's history.

The club has always been governed by a committee and managed until more recent years by volunteers.

Legend has it that in its early days, while the early closing

Guest editorial by Franklin Ward councillor Andrew Baker

I was hoping to have been able to write this following a decision by Council in regard to the Future Development Strategy whereby I was either going to be unhappy, slightly happy or happy with the outcome. I was anticipating that I was going to be unhappy or frustrated however the item was removed at the last moment from the Committee agenda which has left me hopeful that I will be able to continue to fight for the changes I want to see from the draft that went out for public consultation.

The strategy is required by the Government's National Policy Statement Urban Development (NPSUD) and provides guidance as to where and when urban development should occur in Auckland. The NPSUD has a number of goals including ensuring growth is achieved by developing both 'up' and 'out', and that rules are not unnecessarily constraining that growth.

Despite the Unitary Plan creating the future urban zone which was determined by well qualified and experienced independent commissioners, the draft Future Development Strategy was focussed on intensification of existing urban areas including what are referred to as brown field areas (those areas already developed but able to accommodate changes to the type of development) whilst placing limitations on green field future urban zone and rural areas around existing towns and villages such as Beachlands and Waiuku.

Beachlands in particular has become very much a dormitory area where there are very limited employment opportunities, requiring people to travel to work and as we know, to things like secondary school. This has created the issues we all know and residents experience with the likes of congestion and the lack of scale needed to justify investment in the things needed to potentially improve things. My view is that needs to change and I voted against the draft FDS some months ago as I

was unhappy at the way the authors had or had not considered the bigger picture for areas not only in Franklin but the likes of Rodney as well.

There is a need for specific consideration for rural areas to ensure development is considered in a far more holistic way than what is a very narrow vision. The Unitary Plan was adopted after a massive and inclusive process and my fear is the FDS is seeking to turn that plan on its head using a far less robust process. I am not sure when it will be on the agenda or the exact reasons it was pulled last minute from the agenda but I guess it gives me more time to influence some changes.

As an Auckland Transport Board member, I get the opportunity to go behind the scenes, experience and talk to those delivering things we take for granted. Recently I spent time in what is known as ATOC. Located on the North Shore this is the centre where the huge network of CCTV where urban centres, local roads and motorways are monitored along with traffic volumes etc allowing real time notifications about issues and incidents. Agencies like NZTA, AT and the Police are there 24/7 so not much is missed.

Another visit I made was to the drivers cab in one of the trains as I did my daily commute between Papakura and Britomart. It was invaluable not only

seeing things from a completely different perspective but gaining an understanding of the issues the drivers have to deal with and the real lack of control they, the train manager and AT overall have in regard to keeping on time. Whether it be one of the many temporary speed limits on sections of track due to condition or works happening or trying to look after late arriving passengers believing the delay they cause is irrelevant, the cumulative effect of these holdups makes it incredibly hard to stay on time and the impact that has on the management of a network where there is limited ability for flexibility with the track system being shared by all our passenger trains as well as freight. The sense of responsibility associated with driving such a large, fast train, full of passengers especially as they charge through level crossings should not be underestimated and I have even more respect for these wonderful people.

A brush with Mother Nature: seaside mural impresses locals

The carpark area at the western end of Maraetai beach is looking brighter these days, thanks to local artist Natasha Fitzpatrick.

Natasha was one of ten artists from around the country to win a mural competition run by Keep New Zealand Beautiful. The Paint New Zealand Beautiful competition tasked entrants with designing a mural with an environmental message for a wall in their neighbourhood. Each winning artist received a \$750 Resene paint voucher, drop cloths, high vis vests and a \$1,000 commission upon completion of the mural.

The win came as a surprise to Natasha. "I didn't expect to get chosen," she says.

The resulting mural, called 'Protect Us' has added much needed colour to the previously grey wall at the Maraetai beach toilet block, as well as sending an environmental message.

Bees and flowers brighten the mural while a humpback whale, orca and snapper connect the mural to the ocean just a few metres away.

"I've had lots of cool feedback about the mural," says Natasha.

"People are asking if I'll do another one on the other piece of wall nearby."

Natasha says she would be keen to do more, if Auckland Council gives her permission.

hours brought about by the temperance movement were still in force, the club's caretaker was well known for storing alcohol in a nearby shed for consumption by club patrons during 'lock in' sessions after the club itself had closed at the regulatory time.

In 1948 the main hall was built when the club became incorporated. The room now known as the pool room was added many years later, before a restaurant was added (currently occupied by Ambrosia) about 20 years ago.

The club jubilee organisers say they are delighted the club has reached its 75th birthday and remains popular at a time when many RSAs and similar clubs are struggling to survive.

The 75th celebrations will start with a dance party on Sunday 22 October (Labour weekend) featuring the Tuarangi Road Band who are themselves celebrating many years in the entertainment industry. The Tuarangi Road Band features some of Australasia's top musical talent including Rick Ball from Hello Sailor and Ron Brown from The Clevedonaires and promises to rekindle memories of classic rock songs from the 50s, 60s, 70s and 80s plus a few originals.

The Beachlands Chartered Club will also commemorate its past with a memorial day on Monday 23 October. The club's



doors will be open from 3pm onwards, so that locals can come along to get some insight into the club's historical connection with the local community.

Anyone is welcome to attend.

"The club and its members have always been, and are very much still, about supporting Beachlands and the surrounding suburb locals. Annual events have always been held in support of local schools, fire services, fishing and other community groups," says the organising committee.

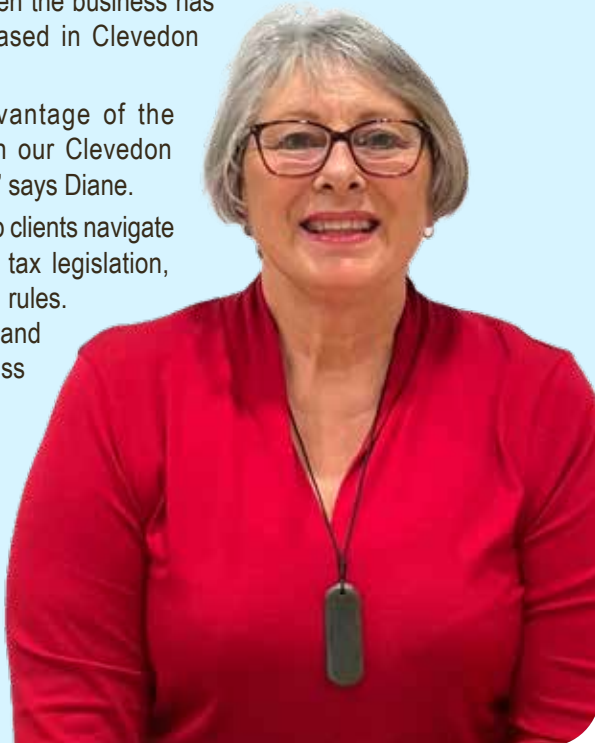

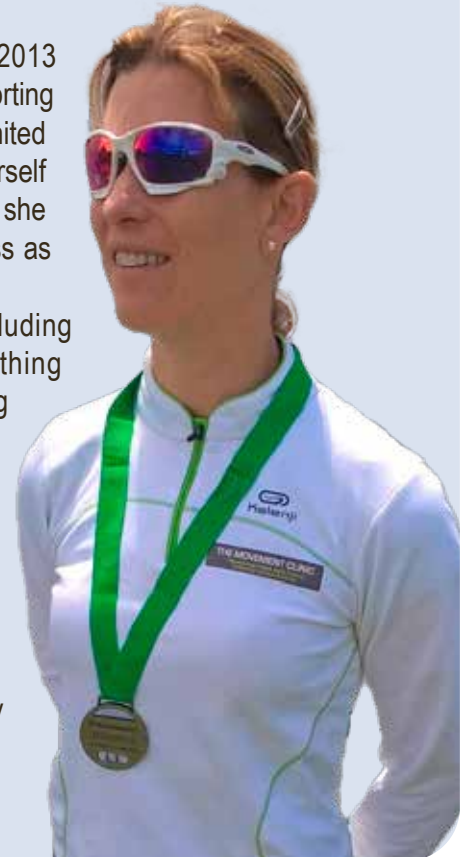

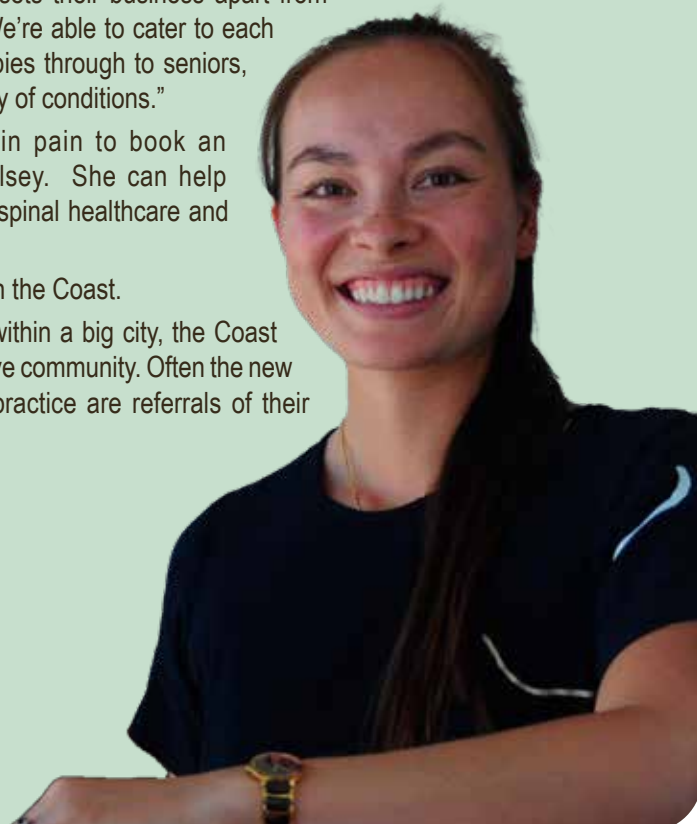
Chelsey Mokhtar says it’s hard to put your finger on it, but there is something special about living and working on the Pohutukawa Coast.

Cannellini Summer Bowl - by The Kai Box

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup white quinoa, rinsed
- 1 veg stock
- 1 tin cannellini beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 punnet cherry tomatoes, halved
- 1 avocado, diced

LEMON DILL DRESSING:

- 1-2 small cloves garlic, crushed
- juice of 1 ½ lemons
- zest of 1 lemon
- 1 Tbsp fresh chopped dill
- 2 tsp Dijon mustard
- 2 tsp olive oil
- 1 tsp maple syrup
- ½ tsp ground cumin
- dash of salt and pepper
- 1 bunch coriander
- 1-2 handfuls of baby spinach





INSTRUCTIONS:

1. In a small pot, bring 2 cups of water to boil, then add the quinoa and the vegetable stock. Simmer on medium heat for 20 mins with the lid on. Once water has cooked away, remove from heat and allow to steam, then fluff with a fork.
2. In a food processor, add the dressing ingredients. Process until the greens are finely diced. Season with salt and pepper.
3. In a large mixing bowl, add the cannellini beans, cherry tomatoes and avo.
4. Add the quinoa once cooled slightly.
5. Stir in the sauce and mix gently until well combined.
6. Serve chilled.

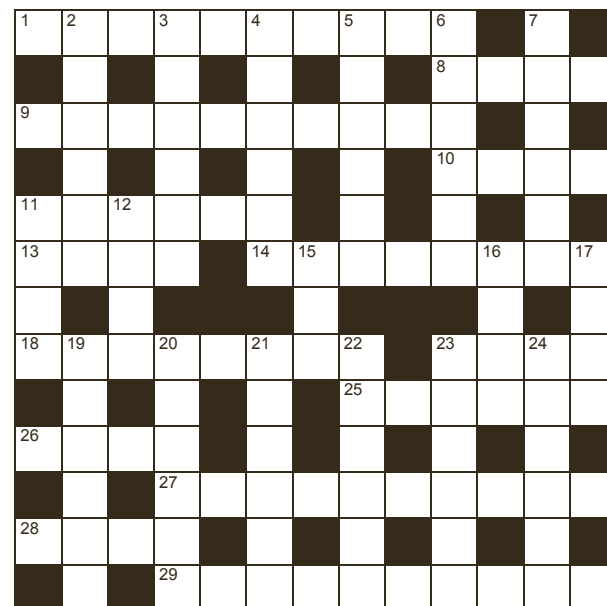

Communities await road repairs

Two long term issues with local roads are causing concern for locals, but Auckland Transport is unable to say when the problems will be fixed.

A large slump in a section of tarmac on Clevedon's Monument Road has been coned off since the heavy rains of January and February.

Auckland Transport says the under-slip on Monument Road is on its list of slips requiring repair. An AT spokesperson says: "Currently it's at the investigation and design stage, so there's no timeline yet for the works but we will keep you updated."

The Kawakawa Bay Community Association (KBCA) is

increasingly concerned about a progressive slip affecting the roadway beside the Kawakawa Bay Boat Club ramp. The slip has been there for over a year and has encroached on the coastal road, meaning traffic has to cross the centre line to avoid the slip, and the walkway on the seaward side of the bollards is completely gone.

"As we approach our busiest time of the year with lots of cars towing boats and people accessing our local beaches, it really is a safety issue if vehicles can't remain within their road lane and there is no longer a safe walkway for pedestrians," says KBCA Chair Rachel Cashmore.
