

# New bus route connects residents to ferry

This spring will see the introduction of a new bus service between Beachlands, Maraetai and Pine Harbour, providing a long-awaited connection for Pine Harbour ferry users.

The new 738 bus route is separate to the existing 739 bus route which runs between Maraetai, Beachlands and Botany town centre. The new route will see two buses an hour operating at peak commuting times on weekdays and hourly outside of these times. The timetable is yet to be finalised, but the last bus is expected to be at about 8:30pm with two later trips to meet later ferries on Fridays and Saturdays.

Auckland Transport is installing a number of new bus stops and shelters as it works towards the service (see schedule on page 3).

Work on the new bus route began in 2024, but AT says it then came to their attention that while they had consulted about 800 residents, some members of the community did not receive its communications about the new 738 bus route improvements.

In mid-December 2024 AT decided to put the construction project on hold until further consultation with the community had taken place. Earlier this year more than 1870 letters were sent out to the community for this consultation to ensure everyone affected received the information and had an opportunity to share their views.

AT says a site visit was undertaken for all proposed locations on 30 May 2024 to understand the individual sites and constraints to be managed and designed around. A bus operator also completed a trial run, which ruled out the option of locating a bus stop within the Pine Harbour ferry

### terminal car park.

Responding to feedback about loss of car parking on the new bus route, AT says that when planning bus routes there are a number of factors that need to be taken into account. These include where they will be of the greatest benefit and where there is sufficient space for buses to operate safely.

"Auckland Transport acknowledges that this proposal will result in a loss of some on street parking spaces. We know that the removal of on-street parking can be inconvenient but multiple alternative locations have been considered during the investigation stage of this proposal, none of which were compliant with current Auckland Transport design standards for new bus stops ... on-street parking is only permitted when there is not an activity of greater priority that requires the use of the space. As such the establishment of bus stops takes priority over the use of this area for parking," said AT in a response to community feedback.

Design and construction of the new bus route is expected to cost about \$1.6M.

## New bus stop construction plans

### A. Beachlands Road

- New bus shelter at the existing stop at 129A Beachlands Road
- Relocate the existing bus stop at 138 to 144 Beachlands Road to improve visibility.

## B. Constellation Park and Liberty Park

AT is working through an updated design and will carry out separate community engagement

### C. Constellation Avenue

- New bus stops with road marking and signage at 47 and 64 Constellation Avenue.
- Install new refuge islands at 53 Constellation Avenue to provide safer access to bus stops.
- Upgrade the existing crossing area on Intrepid Cresent with new pedestrian tactile pavers.
- Install new broken yellow lines between 47 and 64 Constellation Avenue and outside 92 Intrepid Crescent to allow for safer pedestrian visibility at the existing crossing area.
- Removal of two trees to facilitate the new bus stop at 64 Constellation Avenue and the crossing at 53 Constellation Avenue, replacement planting will be carried out.

### D. Constellation Avenue and Third View Avenue Tracking

- Installing broken yellow lines at the intersection of Constellation Avenue and Third View Avenue to provide better visibility for vehicles and improve bus manoeuvrability.
- Installing broken yellow lines from 125R (the reserve area) to 118 Third View Avenue.

### E. Third View Avenue

- New bus stop and shelter at 97 Third View Avenue including road marking and signage
- New bus stop, road marking and signage at 106 Third View Avenue including a new footpath area
- Install new side island buildouts at 101 Third View Avenue to provide safer access to bus stops.
- Install new broken yellow lines between 98 and 108 Third View Avenue to improve visibility and bus manoeuvrability.

## F. Second View Avenue / Pohutukawa Road

- New bus shelter at 133 Second View Avenue
- New bus stop, road marking and signage at 2 Pohutukawa Road (on Second View Avenue) including new footpath areas
- Install new refuge islands and pram crossings at 2 Pohutukawa Road (on Second View Avenue) and 68 Shelly Beach Road (on Second View Avenue) to provide safer access to bus stops.
- Install new broken yellow lines between on Second View Avenue and Shelly Bay Road to improve visibility and bus manoeuvrability.

## G. Second View Avenue / Bell Road

- New bus stop, road marking and signage at 96 Second View
- Upgrade the existing pram crossings at the Second View Avenue and Bell Road intersection to provide safer access to bus stops.

Install new broken yellow lines at the Second View Avenue and Bell Road intersection to improve visibility and bus manoeuvrability.

### H. Second View Avenue / Wakelin Road

- New bus stop, road marking and signage at 72 Second View Avenue.
- Upgrade the existing pedestrian crossing at 44 Wakelin Road with traffic islands and pedestrian tactile pavers to provide safer access to bus stops.
- Install new broken yellow lines at the Second View Avenue and Wakelin Road intersection to improve visibility and bus manoeuvrability.

### I. Second View Avenue and Sunkist Bay Road tracking

Installing broken yellow lines at the intersection of Second View Avenue and Sunkist Bay Road to provide better visibility for vehicles and improve bus manoeuvrability.

### J. Sunkist Bay Road

- New bus stops, road marking and signage at 3 and 4A Sunkist Bay Road
- New side island buildouts and pram crossings at 4 Sunkist Bay Road to provide safer access to bus stops
- Install new broken yellow lines between Fourth View Avenue and Beachlands Road to improve visibility and bus manoeuvrability.

### K. Karaka Road / Winterman Road

- New bus stop, road marking and signage at 92 Karaka Road (on Winterman Road)
- New bus stop, bus shelter, road marking and signage at 94 Karaka Road (on Winterman Road).
- New refuge islands, pram crossings at 2 Seventh View Avenue and 302 Jack Lachlan Drive (on Winterman Road) to provide safer access to bus stops
- New broken yellow lines between Jack Lachlan Drive and Karaka Road to improve visibility and bus manoeuvrability.
- New stop control road marking and signage at the Jack Lachlan Drive and Winterman Road intersection on Jack Lachlan Drive.
- Removal of two trees to facilitate the new crossing at 2 Seventh View Avenue and 302 Jack Lachlan Drive, replacement planting will be carried out.

## L. Ninth View Avenue / Jack Lachlan Drive

- New bus stop, road marking and signage at 51 Ninth View Avenue including 'no idling" signage
- Install new broken yellow lines along Jack Lachlan Drive near the new bus stop on Ninth View
- Avenue to improve visibility and improve bus manoeuvrability.

# AT consults on long-awaited pedestrian crossing for Clevedon main street

After a year of planning and stakeholder input, prompted by years of campaigning by Clevedon residents, Auckland Transport (AT) is seeking community feedback on two proposed pedestrian safety upgrades in Clevedon Village.

AT says it has listened to concerns from the community, and factored these into its proposal which it believes will meet the needs of Clevedon's growing population.

AT seeks feedback on two proposed pedestrian safety improvements.

## Site 1: 16 Papakura-Clevedon Road (main street pedestrian crossing)

AT proposes to:

- Install at grade (i.e. not raised)
   pedestrian crossing between the
   Hawthorn Munro building and the
   Superette which is identified as the
   busiest informal crossing point in
   the village.
- Provide a new footpath in front of Clevedon Dairy to guide pedestrians away from walking behind parked cars.
- Remove the existing planted pram crossing next to the cemetery to provide 2-3 additional parking spaces.
- Improve line marking, signage and lighting where needed to support pedestrian safety.
- Apply high friction surfacing on the approaches to the new crossing to improve safety.

• Apply the 10-minute parking (P10) rule outside the main street shops at 16 Papakura–Clevedon Road

No other changes are proposed to the existing on-street parking near the shops.

## Site 2: Safer connection on North

AT proposes to:

- Install a new pedestrian refuge and footpath on the northern boundary of Clevedon School to improve walkability and safety for students and residents travelling between Clevedon School, the northern end of the village, and the Taitaia Stream walkway
- Remove six on-street parking spaces outside 17 and 19 North Road as "no stopping at all times" zones, and marked with broken yellow lines, to enhance visibility.
- Remove the existing pram crossing and close the current cut-through near the North Road and Mark William Place intersection
- Enhance line marking, signage and lighting to further support pedestrian safety

AT says the proposed crossing points are sited where people naturally cross, making them safer and more convenient. The crossings will also be more visible.

Improved accessibility will also be provided via upgraded footpaths and shorter crossing distances to better support people using prams, wheelchairs and mobility aids.

AT believes the changes to parking and footpaths will make it easier to walk between shops, services, and community spaces and have been designed to support Clevedon's future growth.

## Police praise bystander following water rescue

Police are commending the selfless actions of a member of the public following an incident in Pine Harbour on Sunday afternoon, which narrowly avoided a tragic outcome.

Police were called to the Pine Harbour Marina at about 4.20pm following a report of a woman in distress in the water.

Relieving Counties Manukau East Area Commander, Inspector Nga-Wati Chaplow, says the Police Air Support Unit, Deodar and Coastguard were dispatched.

"Prior to their arrival a member of the public has come to the woman's aid, wading into the water to assist before emergency services arrived.


"This person hasn't hesitated to help another person in their time of need.

"I would like to acknowledge their actions; for seeing something and doing something about it, they potentially saved a life."

Inspector Chaplow says once officers arrived, they too jumped into the water to help.

"Again and again we see Police officers putting themselves in harm's way to help others and keep our communities safe. I am extremely proud and humbled of the actions of this member of the public and my team."

The woman was transported to hospital.



### **Prevention is Kev**

When it comes to keeping your property safe, one of the best things you can do is stand outside and take a good look — not as the owner, but as a potential thief. Ask yourself: How easy would it be to get in here without being noticed? Are the gates locked? Is there a ladder leaning against the side of the house? Are valuables visible through windows? Overgrown trees, dark corners, and unsecured sheds are all things offenders look for.

Taking a few minutes to assess your home or business with fresh eyes can highlight easy fixes that make a big difference.

Another key step is recording the serial numbers of your valuable items. Bikes, power tools, electronics — if it has a serial number, write it down and take a photo of the item. If it ever goes missing, this information can be vital in helping Police identify and return stolen property. This information will also help with insurance claims.

### **Boy Racers**

Police are aware that vehicles are gathering to do burnouts, race, or cause noise and disruption in the area. This behaviour can be intimidating, dangerous, and a real nuisance for residents. If you see this happening, don't hesitate to call 111 — especially if it's happening now. If you're reporting it after the fact or have

footage or information that may help, use 105 or head to police.govt.nz/105.

### **Community Cam**

If you have CCTV or a doorbell camera, consider registering your system on Community Cam (www.communitycam. co.nz). This free, secure platform allows Police to know who in the area has cameras, which can be crucial when trying to identify offenders or vehicles of interest. You stay in control of your footage, but we know who to contact if something happens nearby – and that can make all the difference.

### **Community Response Team**

You may have seen various notices about getting involved with the Clevedon Community Response Team. They are hosting an information evening on Thursday 21 August 2025 at the Clevedon Community Hall 5:30pm-7:30pm. Even if you are not sure how exactly you can assist, you are more than welcome to come along. It's a great opportunity to ask questions, learn more about opportunities, and find out how you can help your area in times of need.

Let's work together to stay safe, stay alert, and stay connected.

# Application Of Sodium Fluoroacetate (1080)

### Hūnua Ranges Pest Management Programme

Auckland Council plans to apply 1080 (sodium fluoroacetate) to the public and private land in the Hūnua Ranges area between **early August and late September 2025.** 

Treatment areas include Hūnua Ranges, Waharau and Whakatīwai regional parks and the Department of Conservation (DOC) administered Mataitai Conservation Area, Paparimu Conservation Area, Mangatawhiri Forest Conservation Area, Vining Scenic Reserve and some private land

Application will be by helicopter and will be carried out in two blocks –the project is weather dependent.

The regional parklands and DOC walking tracks will be closed to the public during both the non-toxic pre-feed and toxic bait application. The parklands will reopen once a comprehensive track clearance programme has been completed.

### Safety information:

- Watch children at all times
- Do not touch bait
- The 1080 toxin is deadly to dogs. Dog owners should take extreme to supervise dogs and prevent scavenging, during the operation and the caution period that follows
- Do not eat animals from this area


