Coast resident claims national title at NZ Masters Track and Field Championships

Coast resident Robin Miller delivered impressive results at the 2025 New Zealand Masters Track and Field Championships, held from March 28-30 at Auckland's Mt Smart Stadium, setting personal bests to secure a national title in the 5000m event and silver in the 1500m race.

Competing in the M55 category, Robin claimed second place in the 1500m on Saturday, crossing the finish line in 4:48, an 8-second personal best. His performance surprised even himself - he wasn't ranked in the top three before the

"I planned to run it as a sharpener for my main event, the 5000m, on Sunday. I certainly wasn't ranked in the top 3 for the 1500m, so I planned just to run a steady race and see how it turned out. With 600m to go, I was feeling better than I thought I would, so I started picking off the runners ahead of me until, with 400m to go, I was sitting in third. When the bell went, I just ran as hard as I could for the final lap, ran down the second place runner with 250m to go, and just kept going. I was as surprised as the guys I beat to have crossed the line in second, and with that time."

The winner, Wim Luijpers, is the current M55 1500m and Mile NZ record holder.

On Sunday, Robin returned to the track for his priority event, the 5000m, where he dominated the field, winning in 17:24 — another personal best by 10 seconds. His strategy focused on pacing himself

Recently there has been a bit of coverage regarding the levels of the dams that provide water to Auckland, the largest of those in our patch up in the Hūnua Ranges. This past summer has been a very dry one as anyone with a water tank will attest. Watercare has asked those on town supply to restrict use as while we have enough water to get through, the knock on effect of low dam levels now will be potentially lower than normal levels next summer which will create supply issues.

A lot has been done over the past few years to create some resilience in our water supply. Recently the dam levels have been in the low 60% range with normal levels at this time of year mid 70s. So for those who use reticulated water, please be conservative with that use

Currently 58.8% of Auckland's water comes from our dams here and out west. 40.2% from the Waikato River and the balance from ground bores as we have in parts of Beachlands and also in places like Waiuku and Pukekohe. Water and wastewater are a couple of the more complex and challenging issues Councils have to grapple with. From creating and maintaining supply

and storage, ensuring the treatment meets standards set by Government or consents and finally having the infrastructure to get it to where it needs to be now, and in the future, to meet demand.

It was the reason a previous Government developed a concept known as Three Waters which at first seemed an appropriate thing to deal with some very real and concerning issues facing the country but that eventually would fall apart as they took their eye off the ball in my humble opinion. We now see the current Government moving the game along with a revised version which hopefully will result in councils being able to ensure their systems and supply are up to standard.

In Auckland, Watercare has split its balance sheet away from its parent entity Auckland Council which allows it to take on its own debt to fund much needed infrastructure. With their activities funded not by rates but by the charges they set for water in and water out as well as things like infrastructure growth charges for those wanting to make new connections to the existing network, it means they can try to get into a better position. Council will still

set expectations for Watercare because it remains a Council Controlled Organisation and thus the balance between fair and reasonable charges for users and apportioning growth cost to those creating the need will remain a focus.

As readers will know, the Pohutukawa Coast area is a mix of reticulated water and tank water which adds to the challenges. As we speak Watercare is in the midst of the consenting process for the Beachlands Wastewater Discharge Consent with the hearing either underway or about to be. These consents really test the balance between having the services we need and how they can operate in the most environmentally efficient way possible. I wonder how long it will be before we see us taking on what other countries are doing where we actually recycle our wastewater. Something that probably encourages me to stay in the country.

Auckland Transport has been working with the Franklin Local Board and the Clevedon Community and Business Association to select and prioritise locations in and around Clevedon Village to improve pedestrian safety.

"We are currently reviewing design proposals and later this year will share plans about these two sites with the wider community via a community engagement process."


The Beachlands Maraetai ANZAC Dawn Service will look a little different this year.

Coastal Playgroup offers extra session to cater for demand

Coastal Playgroup's popularity has skyrocketed since the group first began its sessions five years ago. When Term 2 begins on Monday 28 April, the group will increase the number of sessions it offers each week to cater for the extra demand.

Until now, Coastal Playgroup has run each Tuesday and Wednesday within term time at the Pōhutukawa Coast Prebyterian Church, 5 Jacobs Way, Maraetai. From 28 April, people will also be able to attend Monday sessions at the church.

Group facilitator Sarah Metcalfe says: "The community has increased so much over the last few years and after doing an internal survey last year the playgroup families would love to have an extra day."

The sessions offer a warm and safe environment for preschoolers (0-5yrs) to enjoy and a place for adults young and old to connect.

Numbers fluctuate at each get-together, with anywhere between 20 to 40 children attending.

to challenge the Auckland M55 record, set by legendary runner Barry Magee in 1990. While he maintained record pace for over 8.5 laps, fatigue from the previous day's effort saw him slow slightly in the final four laps, although he maintained his lead to secure the national title - his first since 1989.

For many masters athletes, balancing training, recovery, and injury prevention is a constant challenge, although scientific developments have made running training,

shoes, and wearable tech more accessible. Robin thinks he has read every endurance running book and tried all sorts of plans in the last 3 years, though he says the key to his approach lies in advice from Olympian Robbie Johnston: "Work out how to run every day without getting injured, then run every day."

"It took me a year to fully understand that the key to longevity in running is consistency without pushing too hard. If anyone asks me for advice, I always say: run little, but often."

A talented athlete in his youth, Robin

was the New Zealand record holder for race walking at the age of 18-19. Then a supposed career-ending injury only months out from the 1990 Commonwealth games prevented him from competing in them.

"I was only 20 at the time and thought my life was going to be all about athletics at that stage. However after a few failed attempts to overcome that injury I chucked it in and did nothing until late 2022 when due to a few health issues I thought I'd better get out and do some exercise. I will never forget my first run back, it was around our block, about 1.2kms, and I was completely ruined by the end of it."

He wasn't discouraged though. The next day he woke up and researched when the next NZ Athletics Champs were being held, joined a running club, bought a new pair of running shoes and shorts and slowly got going.

"Its not easy, and when you get injured it really tests you, but the rewards of getting out and doing a bit are well worth it I think."

It has been worth the effort - this season Robin won the M55 Auckland Athletics Champs in 1500m, 3000m, and 5000m distances.

He says his competitive drive keeps him motivated. Having represented New Zealand at the 2023 World Cross Country Championships, where he placed 12th in his age group, he is eager to qualify for another national team and improve his performance.

His upcoming goals include the NZ 5000m Road Championships in Rotorua in May, the NZ Half Marathon Championships in Wellington in June (where he aims to challenge the M55 record of 1:17.01), and the Oceania Masters Games in September, where he hopes to represent New Zealand.

"So there is plenty of motivation to get the shoes on each day," he says.

Transpower's CommunityCare Fund offers \$15k grants

Transpower is encouraging local community groups from Whitford to Pakūranga in the vicinity of Transpower's cable repair project to apply for the next round of its CommunityCare Fund.

The fund offers grants up to \$15,000 for community-based projects in areas where the company operates.

Roy Noble, Project Director on Transpower's Brownhill to Pakūranga cable repair project, invites local community groups, schools, sports clubs, and non-profit organisations to apply for the fund.

"We're aware that our Brownhill to Pakuranga cable repair project will cause some disruption as we begin work at more sites in Whitford, Dannemora and East Tamaki.

Mr Noble said the fund specifically targets initiatives that deliver long-term benefits to communities affected by Transpower's assets or projects.

Previous recipients have used grants for environmental restoration projects, community facility upgrades, and educational initiatives.

Work to continue until 2026

Mr Noble said the Brownhill to Pakūranga cable repair project will ensure a reliable power supply for Auckland and Northland and will be completed in 2026.

"Unfortunately, traffic will be impacted for several months at the sites as most of the work takes place in the road, with an excavation area about the size of two buses."

"We also appreciate the disruption the work will cause to businesses and residents nearby."

The next phase of work will get underway in Point View Drive, Dunvegan Rise, Armov Drive, Brownhill Road, and Whitford Park Road.

At this point, Transpower anticipates Point View Road will be closed to nonresidential traffic from November 2025 to May 2026 (approximately), and Armoy




