

From policing to publishing: candid memoir captures effects of life on the front line



Gerard Bourdillon has spent the past two years sitting at the same table at Maraetai's Beach Cafe, penning a book about his experiences in the police force and the resulting impact on his mental health.

Former police officer Gerard Bourdillon (Maraetai) has documented his two-decade career in his cleverly-titled debut book, *Out of the Blue*. Written as a way to process traumatic experiences, the book offers a behind-the-scenes look at the realities of life on the UK frontline during the 1990s and early 2000s, with stories capturing both high-stakes operations and the personal toll of the job.

Gerard initially began journaling to cope with mental health struggles resulting from his time in the force.

"I didn't set out to necessarily write a book," he says.

"The stories flowed easily, and the more I wrote, the more I realised that others might benefit from reading them."

What began as personal therapy evolved into a candid portrayal of his life in policing. During his career, Gerard worked both in uniform and plain clothes operations, escorted Royal carriages, patrolled in Armed Response Vehicles and protected high-profile figures like prime ministers and members of the Royal Family. His also worked as a mounted officer tackling football hooligans, and as a counter-terrorist search officer planning security for major events like Royal Ascot and the London Olympics.

When we started back in 2019, we had a simple goal: to support and connect our local community, especially those who might be struggling. Little did we know how much we'd be needed in the years to come!

Our op shop, Coastal Treasures, has been the beating heart of our operations. It's amazing to see how the generous donations of clothing, household goods, and children's toys from our community have transformed into real support for our neighbours in need. Every item sold helps fund our various initiatives, from youth programmes to senior support groups.

Speaking of which, our Youth Project has been going gangbusters! We've been working hard to provide activities and opportunities for our young people, giving them a chance to connect, learn, and grow. And let's not forget our Silver Tones group for the over-60s – it's been a joy to see our seniors coming together, sharing stories, and supporting

each other. But perhaps our most crucial service has been our Foodbank. In the past 18 months, we've seen a significant increase in demand, now providing between 25 to 30 food parcels every week to families in our community who are doing it tough. It's heartbreaking to see the need, but also incredibly rewarding to be able to help.

The Log Cabin in Beachlands has become our community hub, thanks to the support of the Franklin Local Board. Our partnership with local organisations has been crucial. We've received funding from events like the Rotary Coastal Run, which has allowed us to expand our services and reach even more people in need.

But here's the thing, whānau — we couldn't do any of this without you. Your donations, your volunteer hours, your support in so many ways has made all of this possible. You've shown what it truly means to be a community, to look out for each other, especially when times are tough. As we look to the future, we're excited about the possibilities, but



Donald's Farm hosts gumboot crusade to support youth mental health

Rates of youth in need of mental health support remain high, so a local farmer is doing his bit to help - by walking for 24 hours in gumboots.

Sam Waugh is the manager of Donald's Farm in Brookby, which provides hands-on farm experience and conservation education for young people. Last year Sam teamed with Nature's Den Forest & Farm School director Alex Sherie (which runs its programme at Donald's Farm) to walk for 24 hours in gumboots in support of mental health charity I Am Hope's fundraiser, Gumboot Friday.

Last year's event was a success, but this year the pair are determined to make it even bigger. The 2024 Gumboot Crusade is locked in for Friday 29 and Saturday 30 November, and both Sam and Alex are calling on the community to get involved.

"We want to raise more money and awareness this year," says Alex. "To make this event a real success, we need people."

Participants will also have the opportunity to join Sam and his team on the night walk, ensuring they don't have to walk alone through the night - a symbolic gesture that reflects the importance of I Am Hope's mission to provide young people with quick access to support when they are struggling.

Volunteers are essential to the success of the Gumboot Crusade, and the farm is eager to involve anyone who wants to support the cause, whether by helping on the day or assisting with event planning and securing sponsorship.

Alex says a number of children attending the Nature's Den programme have benefited from receiving counselling funded by Gumboot Friday.

"We see firsthand the importance of this support," says Alex.

Statistics reported by mentalhealth. org.nz show that in 2021/22, nearly one in four young people aged 15–24 years experienced high or very high levels of psychological distress, up from 11 per cent in 2020. Māori and Pasifika youth groups are often more vulnerable.

The day to day operations of both Donald's Farm and Nature's Den provide opportunities for young people to improve their mental health, by giving them a chance to connect with nature and be physically active.

Donald's Farm was gifted to NZ Young Farmers in 2018 by the estate of the late Donald Pearson. The working dairy farm regularly hosts school groups, showcasing agriculture and letting them get hands-on with all aspects of farming. It also partners with Trees for Survival and Nature's Den.



Local heroes help family rebuild following house fire

'Thank you' is easily said but, with so many people to recognise, it can prove a lengthy exercise! However, extending their appreciation is a project Maraetai's Kate and Glen Quinn are especially pleased to undertake.

The couple found no shortage of assistance throughout the local community after they lost their house to fire on 27 May 2023.

"We were emotionally destroyed and it was a really tough year," Kate says. "[Rebuilding] was not a normal project for anyone, but having amazing people working on our project made all the difference and showed that, while we thought the world had ended for a bit, it simply hadn't. It [provided] the strength we needed to carry on."

As reported in the Pōhutukawa Coast Times (June 23, 2023) the electrical fire sparked devastation for the family. Beginning in their garage, the blaze quickly spread through their 1960s Maraetai Drive wooden home leaving little time for Kate, Glen, their children and dogs to escape.

Although the family was left homeless and distressed, fundraising efforts by schools and community groups saw donations pour in with assistance from friends and family proving invaluable. Then, the exertions began in earnest.

"Zane, John, Cam and the team at Randle House Removals were wonderful and worked really hard," says Kate. "Don and Suzanne from On Road Transport (Glen's employers) were so incredibly understanding - they provided transport gear and made sure that we were doing okay throughout this process. Without their time and gear we would have hit some serious hurdles."

Another local business also waded into

"Sue and Donald (who are close family friends) from Wet Azz Water have been incredible at helping with any of our water needs – and there have been a couple of emergencies as we have settled in. They provided a top notch service. Also, Josh, James and the team from JMA Builders never shied away from our project and were totally committed to getting us into our top quality new home as quickly as possible."

Fittingly, one of the most impressive features of the Quinn's new Maraetai Drive home is a sign in the front yard listing all those who pitched in.

"There have been so many people to thank, hence our sign. The hard work paid off in more ways than we could ever have imagined. We had, mostly, local people working on our home, people we trusted

positive future."

The family is now keen to put past trauma behind them and move on. Kate, who was working towards a bachelor of education at Waikato University when the fire turned her life upside down, is now giving back to her community having recently taken on a new challenge, educating young locals at Beachlands School.

"We have settled incredibly well," she adds. "We have a beautiful family home, the kids are doing well and Glen and I are loving our work. It truly feels amazing to be here after the year we have had.



The final chapter of his book is set in Maraetai. Gerard says he moved to the Pōhutukawa Coast to escape to a new life in paradise, away from the stress and trauma.

Gerard hopes his story will remind readers that police officers are ordinary people with their own vulnerabilities.


"Police officers are just like everyone else — fallible human beings with their own problems, deserving of empathy and grace," he says.

The book's development was a threeyear process, with Gerard dedicating Mondays and Tuesdays to writing. After handwriting his stories over the first year, he spent another year typing and structuring the book, adding chapters to fill in the gaps. It took a further six months to complete editing, add photos and prepare for publication.

"It was a real labour of love."

Gerard's partner Gretchen, a local physiotherapist, played a crucial role in bringing the project to life, encouraging him from the outset and offering feedback on every chapter.

"She convinced me to start writing, bought me my first notebook and sent me off to a café to write!" says Gerard.

Gerard will launch his self-published book on Friday 1 November at 7.30pm at the Maraetai Bowling Club, where guests will receive a signed copy of the book and a glass of bubbly.

He hopes the book might make a good Christmas present for those who enjoy books on policing or Special Forces, crime stories, mental health and trauma. "However, it very definitely isn't a macho, alpha-male type of book. It is full of humour and honesty and it has been very well received by both female and male readers," he says.

Out of the Blue will be available in print and electronic formats on Gerard's website (www.outoftheblue-books.com) and on Amazon from 1 November. He also hopes to stock it in local independent bookstores.






