

All the gear, no site clear - two Menz Shed groups seek sheds

Plans are progressing to establish a Menz Shed on the Pōhutukawa Coast. Based along similar lines to the popular Menz Shed programme, which now boasts 1300 locations throughout Australia and growing numbers in New Zealand, the Pōhutukawa Coast version will allow all ages and genders to get together to work on projects, share ideas, tools and skills and connect socially.

Following an initial discussion attended by 17 people (both men and women) earlier this year, a founding committee of 9 members has been established and the group has had expressions of interest from about 50 others in the community who would like to be involved.

The group has registered itself as an incorporated society, and has already received a \$5,000 grant from Rotary Club of Pōhutukawa Coast to purchase a storage container.

The group's main challenge now is finding a suitable site,

large enough to accommodate a tool workshop and workspace area. President Paul McGuire says the group is still looking for a space that might be suitable for long term use.

Similar plans are afoot in Clevedon, where local resident Mark Synnott is leading the charge to create a space for the community to work together on projects. The Clevedon community shed idea was first floated earlier this year, and since then Mark has worked with other residents to try and secure a suitable location.

Conmara Estate representative Cameron Ross generously offered to donate a section and building within Stage 2 of

Auckland Transport progresses plans for footpath, kerb and channeling

During September and October Auckland Transport plans to seek public feedback about proposals to install a footpath, kerb and channeling in Beachlands.

At a workshop held by the Franklin Local Board last month AT discussed design options for kerb and channel work within First View Ave in Beachlands.

The proposal would see new kerb and channel constructed on both sides of First View Ave between Bell Road and Pōhutukawa Road, and a footpath built on the northern side of the same stretch of road.

After reviewing three possible layout options for the footpath, Auckland Transport and the Franklin Local Board chose a design with a curved alignment to avoid steep driveways and prevent the removal of some protected trees. Franklin Local Board has said it wishes to retain trees where possible and for replanting to occur as needed.

The latest projected cost for the First View Ave stage is \$1.2M - almost double the cost since the work was first scoped in 2019.

The project is subject to resource consent for removal of some protected trees. Subject to public engagement outcomes and Franklin Local Board endorsement, AT hopes to begin construction in May-June 2026.



AT is finalising plans to install a footpath, kerb and chanelling on First View Ave, Beachlands in 2026.

If any cost savings are achieved, these will be put towards two further projects:

• Kerb and channel on Karaka Road (on the northern side of the road, alongside Beachlands Domain).

 Kerb and channel on Second View Ave (on the southern side of the road, between Cherrie Road and Sunkist Bay Road).

Potholes cause grief for motorists on Whitford Maraeti Road

Potholes have caused grief for motorists using Whitford Maraetai Road over the past month.

Two large potholes, located near 751 and 746 Whitford Maraetai Road, have resulted in damage to a number of vehicles. One evening a local resident reported seeing three cars with blown tyres stranded on the side of the road, and on social media a number of other residents reported damaged or blown tyres.

A resident who contacted the *PC Times* said it had cost them \$600 to repair and replace a tyre after they ran into one of the potholes.

Auckland Transport's General Manager Road Asset Maintenance & Renewals, Alan Wallace, says AT is aware of the issues on Whitford Maraetai Road and acknowledges they are frustrating for road users.

"The fixes to date are holding repairs until we can undertake more permanent repairs," says Wallace.

"We don't yet have a firm time frame to make these permanent repairs which will be when weather improves."









Beachlands rugby player named top scorer in Counties Manukau

Despite a string of painful injuries and missed games, local rugby player Sam McKee has emerged as the top points scorer in the Counties Manukau/Waikato Under 85kg competition for the 2025 season - a remarkable feat achieved in just seven matches.

Sam has played for Beachlands Maraetai Rugby Club's 'Sharks' Under 85kg team for the past five years. He began his career in the front row as hooker, but soon transitioned to first five-eighth, wearing the coveted number 10 jersey and establishing himself as the team's go-to goal kicker.

His progress hit a major hurdle in April 2023 when he suffered a broken collarbone during a match. The injury required surgery to install a titanium plate, sidelining him for the remainder of the season. Rather than stepping away, Sam continued to support his teammates from the sidelines.

In 2024, in an effort to reduce the physical toll, Sam switched to halfback - a position he believed would be less impact-heavy. That assumption quickly proved optimistic.

Throughout the season, he played through a series of injuries, including a fractured finger, a torn bicep, and a fractured ankle. Despite the toll on his body and missing three matches due to injury, Sam still managed to score 5 tries, 16 conversions, and 11 penalties, amassing an impressive 90 points in just seven appearances.

Sam's individual brilliance has been a bright spot in a tough year for the Sharks, who have battled a spate of injuries across the squad, from broken legs and thumbs to dislocated shoulders and ruptured tendons. Despite frequently fielding a makeshift team, often with a backline composed of forwards, the Sharks defied the odds to reach this year's semifinals.

While silverware may have eluded them this season, there are plenty of moon boots and casts to display!

Further cause for celebration came with the announcement that Sam's teammates Calab Bailey, Zane Evans and Jaeden Lack have been selected as part of the Counties Manukau Under 85kg representative team.



Being a telltale is when someone does something that does not harm anything or anyone. When you are being an upstander, you tell someone off because they did something that actually hurt someone.


The word hurt means when someone is injured or someone hurts their feelings; it means anything along those lines.

Updated rules for dogs and cemeteries

Auckland Council has updated rules for dogs and council cemeteries in Auckland. Changes to rules for dogs clarify council's approach to keeping dogs as a positive part of life of Aucklanders and update dog access rules to reflect how shared public spaces are now

New limits on walking multiple dogs in council-controlled public places (such as parks) come into force on 1 January 2026. A limit of four dogs will apply to the general public, with no more than two dogs allowed off-leash at any time. A person with approval from council may walk up to 12 dogs, subject to conditions.

Changes and clarifications to where dogs can be taken come into force on 1 August 2025 as follows:

- · changes at Auckland Botanic Gardens, Hunua Ranges, Long Bay, Mahurangi, Pākiri, Shakespear, Tāpapakanga, Waitawa and Whakanewha Regional Parks
- clarifications (with no rule change) at Ambury, Muriwai, Tāwharanui and Wenderholm
- changes at Gooseberry Flat, Pah Beach and Sandhills Reserve (Aotea/Great Barrier); designated dog exercise areas and Kawakawa Bay Beach (Franklin); Howick Historical Village in Lloyd Elsmore Park (Howick); Sulphur Beach Reserve, Gold Hole Reserve, Kauri Glen Reserve, Kauri Park, Kauri Point Domain, Muriel Fisher Reserve, Soldiers Bay, Søren G Christensen Reserve, 54 Tonar Street and Te Ara Awataha Greenway (Kaipātiki); Freeland Reserve, Monte Cecilia Park, Smallfield Reserve, Walmsley Park and Underwood Park (Puketāpapa); Parry Kauri Park, Snells Beach, Vera Reserve Baddeleys Road, Baddeleys Creek Reserve and Pigeon Place Accessway and Wonderview Road Esplanade (Rodney); Rosedale Park (Upper Harbour); Big Oneroa Beach and Blackpool Beach (Waiheke)
- clarifications (with no rule change) at Clevedon Showground Reserve, sports fields in former Franklin District, shell banks and coastal areas from Waiau Pa to Ellets Beach (Franklin Local Board area); Chelsea Bay, Fitzpatrick Bay, Tuff Crater foreshore and mangrove, the foreshore of Shoal Bay east of the motorway and north of the Tennyson Street pedestrian underpass, Little Shoal Bay (Kaipātiki Local Board area).

Changes to rules for council cemeteries to make the current rules easier to understand and administer come into force on 1 August 2025. Changes include consolidating and clarifying relevant rules in the Cemeteries and Crematoria Bylaw 2014 and revoking the Cemeteries and Crematoria Code of Practice 2014. These changes are structural, with no impact on the current use of council cemetery services.


