Youth Parliament 2025

I am pleased to announce that Ryan Higgins from Opaheke has been appointed and confirmed as my youth Member of Parliament for this year. His tenure started on 28 April 2025 and it will end on 29 August 2025. He will spend three days in Youth Parliament in Wellington hosted by the Ministry of Youth Development.

Youth Parliament is an incredible opportunity and I know Ryan will make the most of his time at Parliament. One of the things I want to emphasise is that being an MP is first and foremost about being a representative. Ryan will be encouraged to engage with peers and others in our community and to find out their views particularly on the topics to be discussed at Youth Parliament 2025. Ryan will also get the opportunity to present a debate in the House on the final day.

Mill Road is back on track

I am very excited to report that I was with Minister of Transport Chris Bishop when he announced the launch of the Stage 1 plan for Mill Road at a low-key event near where the major upgrade will start in Redoubt Road. For me, this has been a 20-year journey and Mill Road is something I have advocated for strongly and it is wonderful that it is going ahead now.

Together with former Transport Minister Simeon Brown who began the Roads of National Significance (RoNS) programme and local Takaanini MP for National Rima Nakhle, we heard the welcome news for Auckland south. We were accompanied by Kathryn King Regional Manager System Design and Steve Mutton Director of Regional Relationships of New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA). Jointly, they are responsible for the planning and all the pre-contract work needed for the expansion of Mill Road in the three stages that are needed for this sizeable project.

The road is one of 17 RoNS this Government is progressing, and the NZTA Board's endorsement of the investment case and approval of design and consent funding for Stage 1, is a direct result of our Government's focus on streamlining the business case process and getting projects into delivery faster.

Mill Road will become a four lane (general traffic) corridor including a westbound bus lane at the northern end with two new and six upgraded intersections between SH1 interchange and Murphys Road. The design includes three new roundabouts and new bridges across Puhinui Creek and Cheesman's Bush.

The existing Mill Road, south of Redoubt Road, will become a shared path and property access road.

Once completion of the design and technical work based on previous planning for construction is done, the work should begin mid-2026.

Mill Road Stage 1 covers a range of different environments from highly urban, through to rural areas, as well as locations that require more technical assessments to determine the most appropriate design and construction methods.

Delivering Mill Road Stage 1 will provide substantial benefits to all vehicle drivers, including a 30 per cent reduction in congestion on the corridor, 25 per cent faster journey times and an over 60 per cent reduction in crashes causing deaths and serious injuries, by 2031.

In the Papakura electorate we acknowledge Richard Balcombe-Langridge of Brookby who received an ONZM for his services to business, transport, hospitality, environment restoration and support for community causes.

Mark says that the school's demographic has changed over the past few decades. Previously a rural school for farming families, the school roll is now filled by a combination of local residents, lifestyle block owners and students who travel from Papakura.

The welcoming of Papakura students has led to the school forming a closer relationship with Papakura Marae, which will be involved in the celebrations. along with local iwi Ngāti Tamaoho.

The 150th event is being organised by half a dozen local volunteers, led by Richard Nelson, who are meeting monthly to progress plans. They will soon be asking people to register their attendance, so they can get an idea of numbers.

Leave nesting birds alone, says park neighbour

A family living near Constellation Park on Intrepid Crescent, Beachlands has issued a plea to children visiting the park.

Every year the same family of plover birds nest in the grass at the park, with the female sitting on her nesting patch on the grass and the male standing guard like a watch dog.

"Kids being kids love to run towards the female and wait for the male to attack them," says the resident (name withheld).

While this behaviour is frightening to the birds, there could also be risks to the children, the resident says.

"With constant aggravation they can easily take an eye out."

Parents are encouraged to speak to their children about the importance of leaving the birds alone while they are nesting.

Knots of trouble: rope debris concerns locals

Over the past few years Orere Point residents have noticed pieces of black nylon knitted rope washing ashore on their beach, and now they believe the level of debris may be escalating.

Over the past six weeks Orere Point Dotterels group members collected over 150 bits of knotted rope, as well as a bucket full of nylon rope in varying degrees of degradation, often entangled in recreational fishing line and seaweed.

"We never really thought about the mussel farms being the source," says an Örere Point Dotterels spokesperson. "But northerly swells are bringing more rope into our area, and it has raised concern about practices aboard the mussel barges while harvesting and cutting these ropes. We would hate to think about how many more are on our marine seabed. It's very sad for our ecosystem and shorebirds."

The group says Orere locals work hard to keep their beach clean and safe for various species of shorebirds and marine animals, and that they would like to see assurance from mussel farms that better practices will be used in future.

Ponui Aquaculture, which farms mussels in Tīkapa Moana/the Hauraki Gulf, says it is aware says it is aware of debris from fishing and marine farming practices across Tīkapa Moana, and that it can be carried by currents from all over the moana.

"Weather permitting, the farms are inspected frequently and regularly, and only extreme weather events have caused floats to be lost and subsequently retrieved

More environmentally sustainable mussel farming practices are on the horizon, she says.

"As part of the iwi-led mussel reef restoration work we are undertaking in partnership with Revive our Gulf, we are researching natural fibres for taura, as well as recycled or sustainable products."

Hayley will take up a new role as head coach at Ardmore Pony Club next season. She will also continue showjumping her thoroughbred ex-racehorse and training





Franklin Vets: Cash's cruciate surgery



Earlier this year, Cash came to us with a sore hind leg and a noticeable limp. After some time on pain relief, it became clear that antiinflammatory medication alone wasn't enough to resolve the issue. His dedicated owners opted to investigate further, and Cash spent a day with us in the hospital for X-rays under sedation.

Our vet diagnosed a torn cruciate ligament in his knee - an injury that causes instability and significant pain. To fix this, Cash needed a specialised procedure called a TPLO, performed by Dr. Paul Eason at our Pukekohe clinic. Rather than replacing the torn ligament, this surgery stabilises the knee by altering the shape and angle of the tibia bone.





Mysteries and Marvels of Ancient Egypt

I will dive into the facts about Pharaohs, a female queen you all will know, the disgustingly interesting process of mummification and the pyramids which house golden riches. Why it's important to tackle pest plants

[Over the coming months the PC Times will publish a series of articles focusing on local environmental issues, written by Year 10 student Eleanor Vogel who is undertaking this project as part of her Duke of Edinburgh qualifications.]

In New Zealand, we love our flora and fauna. But are we doing enough to protect it? While it is very important to trap pest animals, there is also another growing threat: pest plants.

Pest plants are non-native, invasive species that grow aggressively and spread quickly, often overwhelming native plants while disrupting ecosystems. Pest plants include all types; climbing/smothering plants, groundcover/shrubs, trees and coastal invasive plants.

When pest plants are introduced to an ecosystem, they will harm the native plants either by smothering or by soaking up nitrogen, phosphorus, and other essential nutrients from the soil and starving the native plants around them to death. We can even see the impact of this in our gardens - for example, moth plants. They will smother feijoa trees, young manuka, flax and more.

These pest plants don't only affect others of their kind though - they also affect native animals in the area. As they replace the vegetation, they are also replacing homes for weta, geckos and birds, leaving these species very little time to adapt. Piwakawaka rely on dense native shrubs to nest, but without these they are left exposed to predators and the weather. With little time to change their habits, they are often left without a home.

So, what can we do? To start, we can learn to identify pest plants. Once we know this, we can remove them from our gardens to help stop them spreading and encourage the growth of native plants. We can also join local weeding days to help stop them in the forests. Websites like weedbusters.org.nz provide great guides for beginners. Every pest plant we remove is one step closer to protecting New Zealand's unique natural environment.

A common pest plant in New Zealand backyards is the moth plant. Here is a step-by-step guide on how to get rid of it. You don't have to take the entire weed out, which is a common misconception, all you need to do is follow these simple steps:

Find the tap root (main root of the plant), and snip

Remove all seed pods (if any), place them in a plastic bag and throw them in the rubbish. Paint the tap-root cut with weed gel to ensure that


