## AT reacts to calls to fix dicey intersection

Last weekend the *PC Times* asked members of the Clevedon Kawakawa Bay Grapevine to indicate whether they had experienced any 'near misses' while navigating the Creightons/Tourist/Papakura Clevedon Road intersection during the past six weeks.

Forty eight people said yes.

Licensed (REAA 2008)

Auckland Transport (AT) has made recent changes to the intersection including:

- Shifting the Stop control limit line on Tourist Road past Creightons Road
- Installing new road markings and improving signage at the intersection
- Installing a new No Passing line road marking on Papakura-Clevedon Road


Changing the Give Way control on Creightons Road to a Stop control.

The changes have led to confusion for drivers. When the *PC Times* parked to observe the intersection last week, it took less than five minutes to see motorists' uncertainty about how to navigate the new road markings. Drivers approaching the intersection from Tourist Road were seen cautiously creeping across the centre of the intersection towards the relocated Stop sign, while drivers turning into the intersection from Papakura Clevedon Road were spotted triple-checking the way was clear before hesitantly moving across to Creightons

## Guest editorial by Friends of Te Wairoa

It's hard to describe the feelings that our committee are experiencing following the devastation of the recent cyclone. The Wairoa River broke its banks in most places, and there has been significant erosion, sending silt and debris out to sea. The Wairoa River is wider than it was at the beginning of the year.

Although we've had floods like this in the past, and we will continue to see them in the future, it is a great reminder of why we do what we do. Friends of Te Wairoa have been encouraging riparian planting since our inception, in order to see improved biodiversity, reduced silt and nutrient loading, and more robust river banks. A healthy awa reflects a healthy community community meaning all living things in the river catchment.

We've been talking about what we'd like to achieve this year. Feedback from the community was heavy on more free educational

workshops, which we're doing, with pest control hub days, pest plant workshops, seed collection and sowing, soil health and riparian planting workshops all go.

We're working on regular water quality testing to monitor over time, and we're keen to work on eradicating the willow trees along the banks of the Wairoa River. The nursery is back up and running, with monthly volunteer days being held and plants looking healthy.

We are working alongside Te Ara Hīkoi and their staff, funded by Jobs For Nature, to support properties in setting up their pest control network. Pest control has been a big part of what we've offered in the past few years, but now we can also offer free help to landowners on the ground thanks to DOC granting this funding.

It's been a difficult few years, but we're hitting the ground running in 2023.

We're loving seeing the difference we can make by supporting hundreds of properties across the catchment to put healthy environmental practises into action, and we intend to continue this support far into the future

## Committee of two seeks help organising Anzac Day services

Planning is underway for this year's Anzac Day commemorations on the Pōhutukawa Coast, but a lack of volunteers is making the task difficult for organisers, and is putting future services at risk.

Local residents Fred Wilkings and Margaret Sommerville are in the process of arranging this year's Dawn Service which will be held at the coastal end of Wakelin Road.

The Civic Service which usually follows the Dawn Parade has been cancelled this year due to a lack of manpower.

"Our key reason for cancelling this year's Civic Service is that Margaret is the sole person organising it," says Fred.

The committee of two say that it would be nice to have more people helping both on the committee, and on the day. There are many things to coordinate for the event, including arranging the Guard, music, technical aspects, poppy day collections, and setting up the Dawn Service area.

Fred says that helping on the committee is not onerous. It would only require about four hours work over the course of a month. "It just means that Margaret and I don't have to do it all," says Fred.

"It would be nice to have some fresh input. If we don't get people to help, it may not happen next year. The ball is in the community's court now," says Fred.

About 500 people attended the last Dawn Service, and Fred and Margaret think it would be a shame to see such a wellsupported remembrance event cancelled due to a lack of volunteers.

Margaret says she is happy to hand over all the information about arranging the Civic Service to anyone who is keen to see it continue.

"We have always felt comfortable in the Bay," says Lois.



# Your views will be needed again

Consultation on Auckland Council's annual budget closed on 28 March after a good turnout across the Wairoa subdivision at Have Your Say events, with others contributing online.

Franklin Local Board chair Angela Fulljames says the extent of the cuts proposed, and their likely impact on the community, may have surprised many.

"There was a trend in that people who had discussions at events tended to give different feedback than those who engaged online.

"It could be that those at events had access to support information, board members, and to staff, who were able to explain the likely effects of some proposals."

The next step is considering feedback and creating a draft budget that is ultimately considered by the governing body, made up of the city's councillors.

Fulljames says the next round of consultations will be for the Franklin Local Board Plan. All boards must create a plan in the year after being elected.



"We are concerned residents suffer from consultation fatigue, but a Local Board Plan is vital to setting a course over a three-year term.

"Boards deliver local services, fund things like pools, libraries, community halls and grants, and there are also plans to give boards wider decision-making powers. But if a strategic direction isn't in our plan, it's hard to get a non-related project into a work programme.

"This year's plan will be one of the most important in some time, given the obvious budget constrains we will be under.

"We will be relying on people to tell us what they support at a local level, where our investment should be, how we prioritise things and how we shape our work programme."

She says Franklin has unique challenges. "We are dealing with rapid growth yet remain, with Rodney, a critical part of the agricultural and horticultural fabric of the city.

"The needs of those in Beachlands can be different from those of people in Puni or along the Awhitu Peninsula. That's also true in the Wairoa subdivision, which encompasses urban and rural areas, lifestyle block holders and holiday homes.

"It's critical we hear from a crosssection of our people."

Draft plans are being prepared and will be released for consultation later this year, with details of events and ways to contribute posted on the board's Facebook page.

## Franklin escapes worst of flooding



Adverse weather events have complicated Auckland's financial position, with \$20 million in recovery funding now proposed as part of the annual budget process.

Franklin Local Board chair Angela Fulljames says Franklin suffered less than other parts of the city during the floods.

"But they were still a reminder of the power of the weather, and when it's your road that is washed away or had a slip, there's no comfort in that.

"While it can be frustrating to see the effects of flooding, and believe issues could be quickly fixed, there are good reasons things take time," she says.

"Almost always there are safety issues, and in events such as the flooding, damage is so widespread priorities are put in place.

"That can mean jobs appear half done, staff making a site safe but surname@aucklandcouncil.govt.nz

leaving other work to later."

And Cyclone Gabrielle has hit the Hūnua Traverse, with a launch delayed by several Ngā Haerenga Heartland Ride roads being damaged. The team is working towards a date this season, but the route won't now open as the intended Kaiaua-Clevedon link.

"We expect a website detailing the route and the anticipated opening dates will be made live shortly. You can visit hunuatraverse.co.nz for more information," Fulljames says.

## **Keeping waterways clear**



People with waterways flowing through their properties are being urged to keep them clear.

Franklin Ward Councillor Andy Baker says it's not a matter of Auckland Council passing the buck, but of people doing what they are required to.

"When people have waterways, they are required to keep them clear, to stop pollutants entering them, and to keep grates and the like free of obstruction.

"During the flooding and Cyclone Gabrielle the poor state of some waterways added to the problems experienced across the city."

He says council has obligations too. "Flooding must be a lesson to all of us. We have obligations to make sure waterways that make up a stormwater network operate effectively.

"A lot of people work hard to do that, particularly when they've seen previous floods and know the problems doing nothing causes, but there are those who won't take action, who create illegal ponds, dams, weirs and crossings that look nice but create issues."

Baker says another challenge is staff trying to access properties being denied access, impacting others along the waterway.

People with a waterway must ensure:

- litter and pollutants do not enter the water
- there are no flow obstructions or impediments
- grates and outlets are kept clear
- any work done complies with stormwater bylaws
- earthworks comply with Auckland Council's Unitary Plan.

"Fighting the effects of weather events is a team effort. All landowners can play a part to prevent blockages and poorly maintained areas creating issues for others." Baker says.

## Auckland Transport reacts to calls to fix dicey intersection

Road. When four cars approached the intersection from different directions, all stopped and hesitated to proceed.

Cycle coach Janet Stark says: "These roads are very popular with cyclists. This intersection is a nightmare for safety when crossing from or into. It's hard to see and you have to creep carefully further out into the intersection to be able to see if it's all good to cross or turn. I fortunately haven't had a near miss experience but I am sure other cyclists will have."

Clevedon resident Catriona Hitchman uses the intersection every day while travelling to work, and on 22 February narrowly escaped a head-on collision.

"As I came down Tourist towards the intersection I slowed down before the area where the old Stop sign used to be as is my 'new normal' practice so I can check traffic coming from my right down Papakura/Clevedon Rd from Clevedon before crossing the intersection to the new stop sign. Normally I would expect issues to come from cars coming from the right hand side and wanting to exit Papakura Clevedon Road on to Creightons Rd.

"A truck was already stopped at the new Creightons Stop sign and waiting for me - that was all good.

"I checked nothing was coming from my right, the truck was stationary, all was clear and went to proceed straight towards the new Stop [sign] when a ute came flying off the main road at speed from the Papakura side on to Tourist Rd and on my side of the road! This guy's vehicle went over the Stop sign layout right in front of me, he had barely checked his speed when negotiating the turn off the main road and then last minute corrected back to his side of the road as he flew past me.

"If I had been any further through the intersection, even by mere metres, he would have come straight into me head on. Even the truck driver was stunned, his eyes were like saucers and he sat there shaking his head in disbelief."

Catriona says the incident "scared the absolute crap out of me". She subsequently logged a complaint with Auckland Transport about the new road layout.

Other local residents have been vocal with their feedback following the changes to the intersection, leading to a meeting on-site with Auckland Transport. AT says feedback from the Franklin Local Board was taken on board too, and further changes are now planned.

"We are also aware of the road closure on Monument Road due to extensive damages caused by the recent weather event which has resulted in a large volume of traffic diverting via this intersection and the road closure is likely to be in place for several months while investigation and repair work is carried out," says AT spokesperson Natalie Polley.

"As such, we are intending to reinstate the Stop control on Tourist Road to its original format to ensure that the intersection has a more familiar layout and familiar priority control for motorists."

AT is also proposing to improve some other roadmarkings, including:

- Reshaping the hatched island adjacent to the southbound left turn lane into Creightons and Tourist Road to ensure that the Give-way control is clearly understandable to motorists
- Realigning the centreline on Creightons Road to better accommodate vehicle tracking requirements
- Painting a hatched island on Tourist Road to provide additional separation between opposing movements
- Slightly shift the limit lines forward and prune back the vegetation on the corner to improve driver visibility of oncoming traffic.

"It is expected that these changes will improve the use of the intersection and adapt to the local driving patterns more appropriately. These changes will address the main and common concerns we have received from the community and other stakeholders," says Polley.

"Once changes are made we will undertake a period of monitoring and

evaluation to ensure the intersection is working as anticipated."

AT says the proposed works are a short-term measure to address safety concerns raised by road users, with a long term solution (such as a roundabout or other intersection upgrade, yet to be investigated) being subject to both funding and priority challenges. Polley says it will require major physical works and may also require land acquisition.

The intersection site has been included as a proposed project in the Road Safety Programme for funding under the National Land Transport Plan 2024-27.

Waka Kotahi's (NZTA's) Crash Analysis System shows a total of six crashes at the intersection between 2018-2023. Four of these resulted in minor injuries and the other two were non-injuries.

Four crashes involved vehicles turning via Tourist Road or Creightons Road. One crash was a failure to stop at the intersection and the other crash was a rear-end crash.


