

World land speed record attempt hangs in the balance

Clevedon resident Reg Cook is with his motor racing team in Bolivia, hoping to attempt to set a world land speed record of 550 miles per hour this month. But tensions are high as obstacles mount.

This month 78-year-old Reg and his team at Cook Motor Racing plan to contest a number of world land speed records on the Bolivia salt flats, including the world land speed record for a piston-driven engine in a specially modified vehicle called 'Wairua 2'.

Reg believes the vehicle built in his Clevedon shed is up to the task, and his unwavering faith in success has helped his team clear a number of hurdles over the past two years, including aborting the mission in 2024 due to last minute tyre failure.

This week the record attempt looks to be in jeopardy again, with three of Cook Motor Racing's shipping containers delayed at a Chilean port, with no word of when they will be transported to the salt flats. A fourth shipping container was lost, and later tracked to a location in Chile but whether it will arrive in the right place at the right time is uncertain.

To make matters worse, the team's world record scrutineer became unwell and was unable to fly to Bolivia, necessitating a lot of admin to arrange a stand-

Reg says the team "are sitting on a knife edge hoping that containers arrive this week". They have managed to delay the world record attempt by a few days, but "the logistics of delaying the event with everyone's travel etc is a nightmare," says Reg.

As always, he looks on the bright side, saying the team have used the extra time to make technical improvements.

"Also it has been good that everyone has had a chance to acclimatise and build connections. For many this is the first time we're meeting in person."

The team is optimistic about their chances of setting a new world record - but it will all depend on whether their gear arrives in time.

The team's motto of "never ever give up" has never ever been more apt.

Turning the first sod for new courthouse for Papakura

During August I was with the Minister for Justice Hon Paul Goldsmith and the Minister for Courts Hon Nicole McKee, at the turning of the first sod for the new Papakura Courthouse to be built on the site of the former RSA building in Elliot Street.

With consents in hand and plans well advanced, the new building will be purpose-built and largely completed in a factory before delivery to the site. This will allow the new building to be open for business in early 2027.

Inside Government - Auckland Council plan changes stopped

The Government has announced it will stop councils "wasting their officers' time and their ratepayers' money" on plan changes in advance of the new planning system coming into force.

RMA Reform Minister Chris Bishop says the Resource Management Act (RMA) has crippled New Zealand and the Government's new planning system reforms are set to make it easier to get things built in New Zealand.

Parliament has passed the Fast-track Approvals Act to speed up the consenting process for projects with regional or nationally significant benefits.

introduce two new Acts to replace the RMA – one Act to focus on land-use planning and the second to focus on the natural environment. Mr Bishop said the new system will provide a framework humanitarian aid and in-kind support that makes it easier to plan and deliver infrastructure as well as protect the environment.

The changes to be made have been carefully considered and based on recommendations from an Expert Advisory Group (EAG). The Government will assume some of the workload of Councils.

The big project for Papakura is Mill Road and it is set to benefit from these RMA changes.

Anyone with current issues around building and resource consents is reminded that Auckland Council or your local Councillor should be consulted.

> I also visited Poland and met Deputy Foreign Minister Władysław Teofil Bartoszewski and Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of National Defence Władysław Kosiniak-Kamysz.

> Poland remains one of our most trusted partners in Central and Eastern Europe due to shared values and strategic interests that underpin our close relationship.

> My trip concluded with a visit to the United Kingdom where UK Secretary of State for Defence John Healey and I signed the 2025 Joint Statement on Defence Cooperation between the UK and New Zealand in London.

> I am focussed on keeping New Zealand's profile in Defence visible and relevant with our overseas friends, as it also enhances our reputation with them in other foreign affairs dealings and interactions.

Local filmmaker wins top honours

A feature film created by Beachlands minutes run-time 'in the can' each day. resident Peter Webster and filmed at locations around the Pohutukawa Coast has taken out Best NZ Feature Film at the New Zealand Independent Film Festival.

Green Angels, written and directed by Peter, stars well-known Kiwi actors Siobhan Marshall, Johny Morell, and Hannah Koumakis. The drama tells the story of an over-achiever driven by a need to overcome a deprived childhood - a character inspired by people Webster has encountered over the years.

Decades of involvement in local theatre. particularly Howick Little Theatre, prompted Peter's decision to take on the project. He says he had enjoyed acting many lead roles on stage and reached a point where he needed to apply this experience to filmmaking.

"I planned to write a drama strong on conflict yet real and relatable."

While he initially envisaged shooting the entire film on the Pohutukawa Coast, tight deadlines meant most of it was filmed at Eastern Beach. Still, many Coast locations feature prominently, including The Wharf Café and the gardens at Pōhutukawa Landing. Even the Pohutukawa Coast Crime Patrol joined in for a scene.

"I was rapt that so many locals were happy to provide perfect locations," says Peter.

Working to a micro-budget, the biggest challenge was planning to complete 10

"I had to limit filming to just eight days to contain costs," says Peter. "After filming each scene this necessitated transferring from one location to the next, without any delay. The film has 47 scenes in six locations. We achieved our goal, one reason for this is that we needed very few takes, as actors had rehearsed thoroughly in the weeks before filming, which is my theatre background coming to the fore!"

Despite the tight production, the result struck a chord with film festival judges.

"I continue to be delighted about winning the award. I was surprised for sure, though many had commented that the film was well cast with superb acting."

Peter says actor Siobhan Marshall felt the script was a key factor in her accepting the lead role.

"I am fortunate that local resident Martin Evans, our executive producer, meant we could hire music composer Joel Haines and engage other professionals for colour grading and post-production audio."

Peter hopes audiences will connect with the central character and recognise her struggles in people they know. "There will be smiles as the story unfolds, and I know audiences will leave the cinema feeling uplifted," he says.

Green Angels will screen at Northcote's Bridgeway Cinema for one week from 8 October.

Beachlands spared from development under new Auckland Council plan

Government has told Auckland Council it must find a way to build up to two million additional homes in the coming decades and beyond, but Beachlands looks to have been mostly spared from development thanks to its limited transport connections, water and wastewater constrictions, and precinct rules.

Until last week, under proposed Plan Change 78, residential sections in Beachlands could potentially have built three dwellings, 3 stories high without resource consent once those limitations were addressed.

But last week Auckland Council voted to approve a new housing intensification plan which will instead allow 10-15 storey high rises to be built around public transport hubs.

On Wednesday 24 September, Auckland Councillors voted 18-5 in favour of replacing Plan Change 78 with Plan Change 120, which concentrates housing development around public transport and infrastructure. The change in direction came about because parts of the city potentially zoned for development under Plan Change 78 were vulnerable to flood hazards.

Council's decision to pursue Plan Change 120 means that development in Beachlands will remain as it is under the Auckland Unitary Plan.

Pine Harbour Marina is zoned differently. As a mixed-use 'marina' precinct with commercial, retail, and residential elements already permitted, it is able to build higher density residential property which is not subject to the same infrastructure constraints that apply to most of Beachlands.

Likewise Beachlands South Limited Partnership's development of the land current occupied by Formosa (and beyond) has been permitted by its own plan change (Plan Change 88) to construct some higher density dwellings.

Residential development in Maraetai, Whitford, Clevedon, Kawakawa Bay, Hunua, Brookby, Ardmore and Ōrere Point will remain unaffected by the changes adopted by council last week.

While the public had limited opportunity to provide feedback on whether Council should choose either Plan Change 78 or Plan Change 120 due to Government timeframes, people will have an opportunity to make submissions on the new plan change before it is reviewed by an independent hearing panel.

Franklin Ward Councillor Andrew Baker believes last week's decision was a good result for Franklin, saying: "It allows our communities to provide their thoughts on what is needing to change in the future."


