Trail will deliver economic benefits, says board



Local business owners gather at Hallertau Clevedon to discuss potential opportunities arising from the Hunua Trail, which is expected to be operational by the end of the year.

Could it be New Zealand's next big cycling trail? Franklin Local Board chair Andy Baker thinks so. Andy says the new Hunua Trail, which could potentially open as soon as October this year, is "incredibly exciting, it's one of the coolest things we have been involved with."

Business owners from Clevedon and the surrounding areas gathered at Hallertau Clevedon last Monday evening at a meeting organised by the Clevedon Community and Business Association (CCBA), to find out more about potential opportunities arising from the new 45km walking and cycling trail from Clevedon to Kaiua through the Hunua Ranges.

Auckland Regional Parks manager Rachel Kelleher told meeting attendees that the trail has been given 'Heartland' status; a term given to a trail that takes people into heartland New Zealand, and literally gets their hearts pumping.

The trail takes advantage of existing Watercare tracks and other infrastructure such as toilets and camping facilities. While the trail is an easily-navigated gravel road, its 800m elevation means that it will provide a more challenging alternative to other well-known cycling trails in New Zealand such as the Otago Rail Trail.

Past chair of the CCBA trails committee, Josephine Elwor-

thy, talked at the meeting about how the Clevedon Village Design Framework can support the trail, by linking it with other proposed trails through Clevedon Village. Josephine said that planning needs to be done now to ensure Clevedon infrastructure can cope with the influx of visitors the trail will bring.

Franklin Local Board deputy chair Angela Fulljames agreed, saying that the board's conversations with the Hauraki Rail Trail group showed that their community had not expected their trail to be so successful. "Their advice was to ensure enough toilets and parking." Angela says the project has tremendous potential for educational and economic opportunity.

Potential business opportunities including bike or e-bike hire, shuttle transport, accommodation and catering are all possibilities open to entrepreneurial locals.

Business owners were asked to give feedback about what they think needs to happen to make the most of the opportunity.

The public is invited to find out more and give feedback at an information session to be held at the Clevedon District Centre on Saturday 14 March, from 11am-2pm.

Picture this: Two people stand on a sidewalk pointing from different directions at a figure drawn in front of them. "It's a 'six'", says one. "It's a 'nine'", says the other. Which is right? Or are they both?

This meme popped up on my internet the other day and was intended to show, among other things, that interpretation of facts and truth can be a very relative process. The ensuing debate in the comments section developed threads of discussion quoting principles of philosophy and famous philosophers, ancient and modern.

Unsurprisingly, there was also stark opinion. Most often commented, however, was the idea that the meaning or identity of the "number" on the pavement would be most strongly influenced by the intentionally missing relevant other information and circumstance. Were there buildings nearby with other numbers to give a clue? Anyone to ask about the figure? Someone standing out of shot with a dripping paintbrush or lump of chalk in their hand? Was it, indeed, an uncompleted number 'eight'?!

My take on the cartoon (and there are many interpretations, obviously, and wider potential conversations regarding what is reality) was that without any further information neither person could be seen as being completely correct. Declaring an

opinion based on limited detail furthered the understanding of the situation for both individuals not a single, solitary bit.

So...What?

It's election year. Over the course of the next six to seven months we will be inundated with "sixes" and "nines" from all manner of perspectives through all manner of media.

The downside is that it seems incumbent of some that the information chosen to present to us - the voting public - is often incomplete and from only one particular perspective.

How do we know if we are being shown a "six", a "nine" an incomplete "eight" or perhaps even a lowercase "G" without being given all the detail.

As I mentioned, the meme-post did also suggest that rather than stand ignorantly pointing at the "number" the individuals would benefit from additional input enhancing their knowledge.

My suggestion then, given we are about to be assaulted with less than the full story on all the issues facing us over the course of the election campaign, is not to passively accept that initial interpretation but to do just that little bit more research. No matter your political colour surely we all profit from informed debate.

I'm not proposing you abandon your card-carrying Whig or Tory status. However, proclaiming that status as the

only right one is no better than shouting "Six!" or "Nine!". Whispering or shouting makes no never-mind, either.

I need more info, please.

And keeping it all in perspective - in the backdrop to a national election event all the smaller local occasions continue unabated and need your patronage too! Herewith, my plug for the next Hunua Market Day - Saturday 21 March.

Former PM Mike Moore remembered fondly by Omana neighbour

Former New Zealand Prime Minister the Rt Hon Mike Moore ONZ, who passed away on 2 February aged 71, is remembered by an Omana Beach neighbour and close friend as a humble man who was kind, generous to a fault and very witty... with a craving for knowledge and a love of books.

Scott Williams and his family have lived alongside Mike and his wife Yvonne since the couple moved to Omana Esplanade in 2003, straight from Mike's tenure as director general of the World Trade Organisation. They became firm friends.

"He preferred to be called 'mate' than Mike – he was just one beautiful man

who honestly cared about everyone's lot and worked tirelessly with no thought of 'what's in it for me' – just genuine," says Scott. "He had absolute loyalty to Yvonne and an absolute passion to push New Zealand forward on the world stage, with the ultimate goal of improving the life of the average New Zealander.

"I knew Mike as a normal, average man not the international politician – few have had that privilege."

Scott says Omana is a very special place to Mike and Yvonne.

"Given a choice to live anywhere in the world, and plenty of opportunities had been offered to them both, he always chose Omana Beach to spend his remaining years."

About 1000 people attended Mike's funeral service held at Dilworth School, which was live screened on YouTube,

where Prime Minister Jacinda Adern paid tribute, describing him as a 'statesman, progressive, constant learner, ideas man, working-class hero, the quintessential battler'.

She said he believed deeply in fairness, social justice and equal opportunity.

Ms Adern had visited Mike and Yvonne at their Omana home the day before he died.

Born in Whakatane Mike grew up in the Far North and returned to Matauri Bay to spend his final summer, coming back to his Omana home shortly before he passed away.

He joined the Labour Party when he was 16 and at 23 was elected to the Auckland seat of Eden in 1972, making him New Zealand's youngest Member of Parliament. He battled cancer but went on to become the 11th leader of the New Zealand Labour Party and the country's 34th Prime Minister, leading the country from 4 September to 2 November in 1990, and continuing as leader of the opposition until 1993.

In 1999 Mike Moore was awarded the Order of New Zealand, the country's highest honour and became the third director general of the World Trade Organisation, the highest international role ever held by a New Zealander, serving from 1999 to 2002.

He was appointed New Zealand's ambassador to the United States in 2010, based in Washington DC, returning home in 2015

after suffering a stroke and heart problems. He had been in declining health since.

Auckland mayor Phil Goff described him "as one of the smartest and the most innovative thinkers that we had in parliament" with "a strong vision and commitment to a fairer and better New Zealand".

At home in Omana Scott says Mike was passionate about increasing the local monarch butterfly population, loved baking mouth-watering pork pies and pursuing his craving for knowledge and love of reading. He completed his biography the week before he died.

While Mike and Yvonne, his wife of close to 45 years, had no children of their own, they have a large adopted extended family/whanau and many friends.

Yvonne extends a special thanks for all the support she has received from the local community since Mike's passing.

Firefighters cycle length of the country to fundraise for I Am Hope

Two of Kawakawa Bay's volunteer firemen are cycling the length of the country in support of 'I Am Hope', the youth and community-focused support group.

Tim Dowden and Mike Carol began their self-supported journey, known as Tour Aotearoa, last week. Tour Aotearoa is touted as one of the world's great bike-packing trips, stretching 3,000 km from Cape Reinga to Bluff. The tour follows cycle trails, tracks, paths and lanes connected by the most enjoyable country roads available. The ride follows a set course, via 30 photo checkpoints, which must be completed between 10 and 30 days. Bikers must carry all their own gear, food and water, and are encouraged to use the ride to raise funds for charity.

Both Tim and Mike are long-term residents of Kawakawa Bay, and between them have racked up more than 30 years service to the local volunteer fire brigade. Neither of them have done any bike-packing before, and say their "bodies aren't getting any younger" so remaining fit throughout the trip will be one of their biggest challenges.

Mike has ridden bikes all his life, and enjoys both road and mountain biking. One of his key reasons for taking part in Tour Aotearoa was to finally see his own country. Tim is also keen to see more of his own backyard and, having previously competed in Ironman events, he was keen for a new challenge.

Almost all of their training for the trip has been done locally, with short rides

from Kawakawa Bay to Kaiaua return, and long training rides taking in the sights of Clevedon, Hunua, Papakura and Miranda. "We are blessed with great bike rides here, and a great mixture of hills and flats," says Tim.

Many of their training runs have been done loaded up with all the gear they will need to carry on the trip - Mike's legs will contend with 23kg of gear, while Tim's gear weighs 25kg.

Knee injuries and saddle sores caused by cycling 10-12 hours per day are a real concern. Tim also admits he has only done a couple of off-road rides in the Hunua Ranges, so he could find the large off-road component of the ride challenging. "We are not sure where we will get to each day, so we will be faced with having to find places along the way to camp for the night," says Tim.

Tim and Mike are using the ride as a way to raise funds for mental health campaigner Mike King's 'I Am Hope' charity, which provides help and support to Kiwi kids facing mental health challenges.

"As volunteer firemen we come in touch with youth that haven't been fortunate enough to have adequate help and support needed to get them through the issues that they are unable to resolve by themselves," says Tim. "Everyone in New Zealand will be affected by youth mental illness in one way or another throughout their life." Tim and Mike say they owe a big thank you to Thomsons ITM for sponsorship of cycling clothes and their "extremely

Beachlands Maraetai Rugby wins CMRFU ‘Club of the Year’

Beachlands Maraetai Rugby Club was awarded the 2019 Club of the Year Shield at the Counties Manukau RFU Annual General Meeting last week. The award, presented by the JMB Committee, recognises both the growth of rugby within the community, and the sportsmanship displayed by club members throughout the season.

Club president Rob Fisher says the award is a tremendous milestone for the club. “It is the first time our club has received such an award, and it’s great

to be recognised for the sportsmanship we display, and the manner in which we compete. This award is proof that we’ve made real headway.”

Last year the Rugby Club registrations were around 215, which was up from 135 in 2017, and this year the Club is expecting total membership to possibly reach 250.

Calling doggie blood donors

Could your dog save another dog's life?

That is exactly what Summer the golden retriever did for Bella the Jack Russell when Bella swallowed rat bait and presented at our Pukekohe clinic a very unwell little dog.

We are looking for more dog blood donors for our Beachlands clinic that we can call on, should an emergency arise where we need blood.

There are various reasons why a dog may need a blood transfusion. Animals that are severely anaemic (have a low red blood cell count) need donated blood to keep their bodies running normally.

Pets can become anaemic due to trauma, like being hit by a car, or due to ruptured tumours, especially tumours on the spleen. A dog that has accidentally consumed rat poison like Bella could also need a transfusion.

In these situations, a transfusion is a clinical necessity. Without dog blood donors, our vets could not undertake important and often life-saving operations.

Help save a dog's life by registering your pet as a potential blood donor today.

Criteria apply:

- Over 1 year old
- Under 8 years old
- Not on any long-term medications
- Over 28kgs
- Local and available.

Please note that the majority of donor dogs require sedation, which may make them a bit sleepy or wobbly that night. There is a stand-down period of 3 months in between transfusions.

If you are keen, please ring to discuss with our vet nurse Amy on 09 538 0010 before meeting with one of our Beachlands vets for a FREE check to ensure your dog's suitability to join our donor dog team.

Honesty really is the best policy

It's comforting to know that when businesses sway away from the truth, we have legislation designed to protect us. Deceptive or misleading conduct is frowned upon by the courts, as well as the Commerce Commission - New Zealand's competition and consumer watchdog. It has responsibility for enforcing fair trading under the Fair Trading Act 1986 (FTA). The FTA has the objective of protecting consumers and, among other things, prohibits false, misleading or unsubstantiated representations. "If you can't back it up, don't say it," is their simple message, one which many have turned a blind eye to in the pursuit of profit over service. Recently, in what was the first prosecution under the FTA relating to offending involving inflation and review editing, holiday rental accommodation company Bachcare was fined \$117,000 for conduct liable to mislead consumers. Commerce Commission investigations found the company had not published negative online reviews posted by users of its accommodation services, and had withheld publication of reviews for properties given lower than a 3.5/5 rating. This conduct created an artificially positive impression of holiday accommodation being marketed on its website.

This case provides a healthy reminder to all traders to act honestly in ALL spaces. Compromising the interests of consumers, fair competition and an environment in which consumers and businesses participate confidently, can end in hefty fines - up to \$600,000 for companies, per charge. In 2017, Nurofen's penalty was approximately \$1 million for false marketing of four different types of pain medication that contained the same ingredients. The same year, Fujitsu was fined \$310,000 for making unsubstantiated claims about the energy efficiency of its heat pumps. The circumstances giving rise to reliance on the FTA are wide-ranging; from the purchase of property or business, to sophisticated commercial transactions. It's not only the Commerce Commission that flexes its muscles when consumer law has been breached. Parties often bring their own civil claims following misleading or deceptive conduct by traders. If you or your business has suffered a financial loss as a result of misleading information provided by another party in trade, you may have a legitimate basis for bringing a claim under the FTA, as well as other legal remedies available to you. 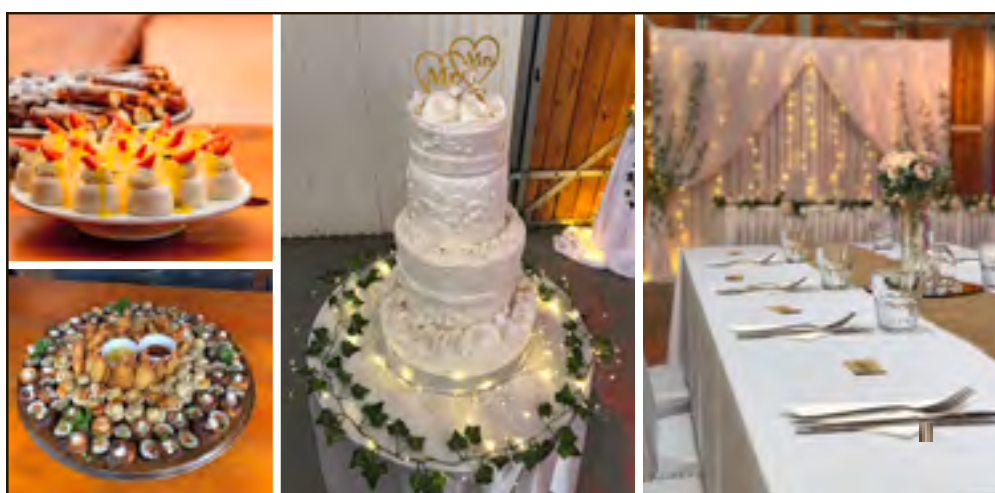

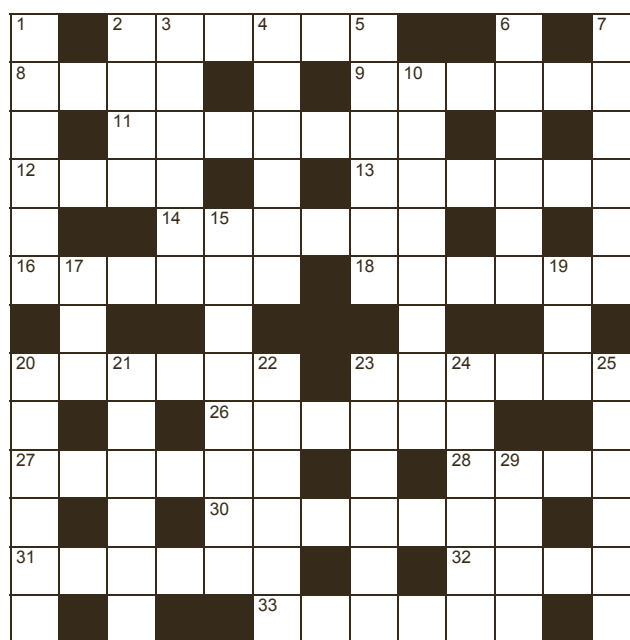
